



1. Sakshi & Bartwal Wins for India in World Boxing Championships

- Sakshi's Dominant Win: Sakshi Chaudhary won her bout in the women's 54 kg category with a dominant RSC (Referee Stopped Contest) victory over Ukraine's Viktoriia Shkeul, winning the opening round 5-0.
- Pawan Bartwal's Hard-Fought Win: Pawan Bartwal secured a winning start for India in the men's 55 kg bout, defeating Brazil's Michael Douglas Trindade with a split decision (3:2).



- Contrasting Victories: Sakshi and Bartwal's wins were contrasting, with Sakshi dominating her opponent while Bartwal had to fight hard for his victory.
- Other Indian Boxers' Performance: Thokchom Sanamacha Chanu also won her bout in the 70 kg category, defeating Denmark's Ditte Frostholm 4-1. Other Indian boxers, including Lovlina Borgohain and Hitesh Gulia, received firstround byes.
- Championships Location and Significance: The World Boxing Championships are being held in Liverpool, UK, under the aegis of the World Boxing Council.

2. Dharmendra Pradhan releases India Rankings 2025

• Release of NIRF Rankings 2025: Union Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan released the National





Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) Rankings 2025, which evaluates India's higher education institutions across 17 categories.

- **Top Institutions**: The Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Madras retained its top spot in the overall category for the 7th consecutive year, while the Indian Institute of Science (IISc) Bengaluru ranked second, and IIT Bombay ranked third.
- **New Category Introduced**: A new category on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) was introduced in the NIRF 2025 rankings, evaluating institutions based on their performance in sustainability and contributions towards the UN's SDGs. IIT Madras topped this category.
- **Increased Participation**: A total of 14,163 higher education institutions participated in the NIRF rankings 2025, showcasing a significant increase in participation compared to previous years.



8. Anand V. Patil to Receive Prof. V.K. Gokak Award

• **Award Details**: Anand V. Patil will receive the Prof. V.K. Gokak Award on September 7, 2025, in Bengaluru for his significant contributions to Indian literature, particularly children's literature.



- Patil's Achievements: Anand V. Patil is a distinguished name in Indian literature, especially in children's literature, and has been honored with the Kendra Sahitya Akademi's Bal Sahitya Award for his impactful work.
