

1.ABASH (verb): लज्जित करना

Pronunciation: uh⋅bash
Meaning: make (someone) feel embarrassed, disconcerted, or ashamed.
Synonyms: embarrassed, ashamed, shamefaced
Antonyms: comfort, console, relieve
Sentence: The girl was <u>abashed</u> by the laughter of her classmates.

2.PERVERSE (adj.) : विकृत

Pronunciation: puh·vuhs
Meaning: (of a person or their actions) showing a deliberate and obstinate desire to behave in a way that is unreasonable or unacceptable, often in spite of the consequences.
Synonyms: awkward, contrary, difficult
Antonyms: affable, friendly, cordial
Sentence: This kind of reasoning is deeply perverse.

3.DISBURSE (verb) : चुकाना

Pronunciation: duhs buhs
Meaning: pay out (money from a fund).
Synonyms: pay out, spend, expend
Antonyms: acquire, earn, gain
Sentence: The funds were to be <u>disbursed</u> in two installments.

4.PONDEROUS (adj.) : भारी-भरकम

Pronunciation: pawn·duh·ruhsMeaning: slow and clumsy because of great weight.Synonyms: clumsy, slow, heavyAntonyms: lightweight, fluffySentence: Her footsteps were heavy and ponderous.

5.VARIEGATED (adj.) : तरह तरह का

Pronunciation: veuh·ruh·gayt·uhd **Meaning:** marked by a variety of usually vivid colors. **Synonyms:** colored, colorful



Antonyms: colorless, monochromatic **Sentence:** This plant has beautifully <u>variegated</u> leaves.

6.REPROACH (noun) : तिरस्कार

Pronunciation: re·proach **Meaning:** the expression of disapproval or disappointment. **Synonyms:** rebuke, admonishment, admonition **Antonyms:** praise, commendation **Sentence:** She gave me a look of <u>reproach</u>.

7.NIMBLE (adj.) : चतुर

Pronunciation: nim·bl
Meaning: quick and light in movement or action; agile.
Synonyms: agile, lithe, sprightly
Antonyms: clumsy, stiff, witless
Sentence: She showed some <u>nimble</u> footwork and looked a promising player.

8.WILE (noun) : छलबल

Pronunciation: vile
Meaning: devious or cunning stratagems employed in manipulating or persuading someone to do what one wants.
Synonyms: tricks, ruses, ploys
Antonyms: sincerity, candidness, candor
Sentence: Fox's wiles will never enter the lion's head.

9.WRETCHED (adj.) : मनह्स

Pronunciation: rech·uhd
Meaning: (of a person) in a very unhappy or unfortunate state.
Synonyms: miserable, unhappy, sad
Antonyms: great, marvellous, wonderful
Sentence: I felt so wretched because I thought I might never see you again.

10.RESCINDING (verb) : रद्द कर देना

Pronunciation: ruh·sind·uhng
Meaning: revoke, cancel, or repeal (a law, order, or agreement).
Synonyms: revoke, repeal, abrogate
Antonyms: enforce, enact
Sentence: Now I'm thinking of <u>rescinding</u> employee ownership, although there is some difficulty in doing that.
