

### 1.PORTEND(Verb) : संकेत मिलता

**Pronunciation:**paw·tend

**Meaning:** To be a sign that something bad is likely to happen in the future

**Synonyms :** Augur , Presage, warn of

**Antonyms :** describe, tell, relate

**Sentence:** Having a black cat pass your path is said to portend bad luck.

### 2.PENETRABLE(Adjective) : दिखाऊ

**Pronunciation:**peh·nuh·truh·bl

**Meaning:** Allowing things to pass through; permeable

**Synonyms :** Pervious, open, holey

**Antonyms :** impervious, impenetrable, dense

**Sentence:** The flashlights barely penetrated the gloom.

### 3.VOLATILITY(Noun) : अस्थिरता

**Pronunciation:**vaw·luh·ti·li·tee

**Meaning:** Likely to change suddenly and unexpectedly

**Synonyms :** Fickleness , Mutability, fickle

**Antonyms :** Certain , Constant, stable

**Sentence:** the children have been exposed to the full force of her volatility.

### 4.INDISCRIMINATE : अविवेकी

**Pronunciation:**in·duh·skri·muh·nuht

**Meaning:** done or acting without making sensible judgement or caring about the possible harmful effects.

**Synonyms :** Haphazard , Unplanned

**Antonyms :** Systematic , Definite

**Sentence:** Cancer is completely indiscriminate in whom it strikes.

### 5.MIGRANTS(Noun) : प्रवासियों

**Pronunciation:**mai·gruhnts

**Meaning:** A person who moves from place to place looking for work

**Synonyms :** Emigrant, incomer, expat

**Antonyms :** Resident, native, citizen

**Sentence:** The government revoked her husband's license to operate migrant labor crews.

### 6.INTEGRITY(Noun) : अखंडता

**Pronunciation:**in·tuh·gruh·tee

**Meaning:** Quality of being honest and having strong moral principles

**Synonyms :** Uprightness , Probity, honour

**Antonyms :** Dishonesty, evil, sin

**Sentence:** They are trying to preserve the cultural integrity of the community.

### 7.ERODING(Verb) : अपरदन

**Pronunciation:**uh·rode·uhng

**Meaning:** To diminish or destroy by degrees

**Synonyms :** Ruining , Collapsing, destroy

**Antonyms :** Restoring , Reviving, renew

**Sentence:** Wind and rain have eroded the statues into shapeless lumps of stone.

### 8.EXPLICABLE(ADJECTIVE): समझाने के योग्य

**Pronunciation:** uhk·spli·kuh·bl

**Meaning:**comprehensible

**Synonyms:** understandable

**Antonyms:** inexplicable

**Sentence:**Differences in schools were not explicable in terms of differences in intake.

### 9.SCEPTICISM(Noun): संदेहवाद

**Pronunciation:**skep·tuhs·i·zm

**Meaning:** Doubt that something is true or useful

**Synonyms :** Misbelief , Cynicism, doubt

**Antonyms :** Belief, confidence, trust

**Sentence:** First, you must rid yourself of self-doubt and skepticism.

### 10.RAMIFICATIONS(Noun) : असर

**Pronunciation:**ra·muh·fuh·kay·shnz

**Meaning:** Possible result of a decision or action

**Synonyms:** Consequence , Outcome, result

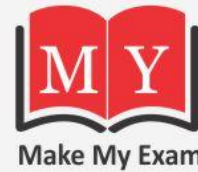
**Antonyms :** basis , consideration, factor
