1. CLINCH (verb) : पुष्टि करना

Pronunciation: klinchMeaning: confirm or settle (a contract or bargain).Synonyms: decide, settle, assureAntonyms: confuse, unsettleSentence: The rain clinched the matter, we would have the party indoors.

2. JOVIAL (adj.) : उल्लासपूर्ण

Pronunciation: joh.vee.uhl **Meaning:** cheerful and friendly. **Synonyms:** cheerful, jolly, happy **Antonyms:** glum, melancholy, sad **Sentence:** The trip to the amusement park put everyone in a jovial mood.

3.TERSE (adj.) : संक्षिप्त

Pronunciation: tuhsMeaning: marked by the use of few words to convey much information or meaning.Synonyms: concise, brief, summaryAntonyms: verbose, prolix, wordySentence: Derek's terse reply ended the conversation.

4. PENCHANT (noun) : लगन

Pronunciation: pawn shawn
Meaning: a habitual attraction to some activity or thing.
Synonyms: tendency, aptitude, inclination
Antonyms: aversion, distaste, dislike
Sentence: She has a penchant for Indian food.

5. DOTARD (noun) : बूढ़ा

Pronunciation: *dotard*

Meaning: an old person, especially one who has become physically weak or whose mental faculties have declined.

Synonyms: geriatric, oldster, senior citizen



Antonyms: youth, youngster, adolescent **Sentence:** You are a real <u>dotard</u> to have forgotten it so easily.

6. ANIMADVERSION (noun) : निन्दा

Pronunciation: a·nuh·mad·vuh·shn
Meaning: criticism or censure.
Synonyms: critique, reprimand, condemnation
Antonyms: commendation, endorsement
Sentence: Their <u>animadversion</u> is caused by the deep pain, disappointment, and sorrow of western civilization.

7. DEVOUT (adj.) : धार्मिक

Pronunciation: duh·vawt
Meaning: having or showing deep religious feeling or commitment.
Synonyms: religious, reverent, holy
Antonyms: faithless, godless, impious
Sentence: Louis became an extremely <u>devout</u> and ascetic man.

8. MACABRE (adj.) : भरंकर

Pronunciation: muh·kaa·bruh
Meaning: disturbing and horrifying because of involvement with or depiction of death and injury.
Synonyms: gruesome, grisly, ghastly
Antonyms: delightful, pleasant, appealing
Sentence: Even the police were horrified at the macabre nature of the killings.

9. APPORTIONMENT (noun) : विभाजन

Pronunciation: uh paw shuhn muhnt
Meaning: the action or result of apportioning something.
Synonyms: redistribution, division, reallocation
Antonyms: juncture, unity, whole
Sentence: <u>Apportionment</u> of seats in the House of Representatives and state legislatures is based on census data.

10. PROPOUNDED (verb) : प्रतिपादन करना

Pronunciation: pruh·**pawnd**·uhd

Meaning: put forward (an idea, theory, or point of view) for consideration by others. **Synonyms:** put forward, proposed, suggested **Antonyms:** answer, deny, disapprove



Sentence: The theory of natural selection was first propounded by Charles Darwin.
