## NATIONAL NEWS

### India's first AI- powered traffic system goes live on Dwarka expressway

- **India's inaugural AI-driven ATMS launched:** The Advanced Traffic Management System (ATMS), India's first AI-powered smart traffic system, was rolled out on the 56.46 km stretch of the Dwarka Expressway and an adjacent portion of NH-48
- **Intelligent violation detection:** Equipped with 110 high-definition PTZ cameras and a Video Incident Detection & Enforcement System (VIDES), the system can detect around 14 types of offences—including overspeeding, seatbelt non-use, and triple riding—and automatically trigger e-challans via the NIC portal
- **Driver awareness and speed control:** Vehicle Actuated Speed Displays (VASD) alert drivers of their speed in real time, while Variable Message Signboards (VMS) provide alerts on traffic, safety advisories, and other important updates
- **National benchmark for smart highways:** Developed by Indian Highways Management Company Ltd (IHMCL) and implemented under NHAI's 2023 smart highway guidelines, the ATMS on Dwarka Expressway is positioned as a national model for intelligent traffic governance and road safety

### Sarbananda inaugurates India's first maritime non-banking financial company

- **Historic Launch of Maritime NBFC:** On June 26, 2025, Sarbananda Sonowal inaugurated SMFCL—formerly Sagarmala Development Company Ltd—making it India's first RBI-registered NBFC dedicated solely to the maritime sector
- **Sector-Specific Financing Solutions:** SMFCL is structured to provide customized financial support—short, medium, and long term—to port authorities, shipping firms, maritime MSMEs, startups, and education/training institutions
- **Strategic Capital Backing:** Classified as a Mini-Ratna Category-I PSU, SMFCL has a strong Tier-1 capital base of approximately ₹680 crore, with borrowing capacity up to ₹3,400 crore to fund diverse maritime initiatives
- **Alignment with Maritime Vision 2047:** The new NBFC supports “Maritime Amrit Kaal Vision 2047” by bridging financing gaps and enhancing India's capabilities in shipbuilding, port modernization, renewable energy, cruise tourism, and maritime education
- **Boost to Blue Economy Growth:** SMFCL is poised to catalyze sustainable growth in India's maritime sector by enabling easier access to capital, fostering innovation in shipbuilding and cruise infrastructure, and supporting educational and startup ecosystems

### Shubhanshu Shukla becomes 1st Indian to set foot on ISS

- **Historic Crew Dragon Launch & Docking:** Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla launched aboard SpaceX's Crew Dragon on Axiom Mission 4 (Ax-4) from NASA's

Kennedy Space Center on June 25, 2025, and docked with the ISS around 4:01 PM IST on June 26, 2025

- **A Milestone for India:** He made history as the first Indian astronaut to enter the ISS, and only the second Indian in space after Rakesh Sharma (1984), marking India's return to human spaceflight after 41 years
- **Esteemed Background & Training:** Shukla, an IAF test pilot and ISRO astronaut selected in 2019, trained at Russia's Yuri Gagarin Cosmonaut Center and later with NASA, showcasing India's rising capabilities in international space collaborations
- **Warm Welcome & Emotional Entry:** Upon docking, he received hugs and a warm welcome from ISS crew members, completed safety briefings, and shared a heartfelt message to Indians, proudly stating his astronaut number 634 and expressing confidence in the next 14 days of research
- **Scientific Research & Cultural Touch:** He will spend two weeks on the ISS conducting over 60 scientific experiments, including life science, microgravity, and earth observation. Notably, he carried Indian halwas and mango nectar, blending cultural heritage with scientific discovery

### **Dangeti Jahnvi Becomes First Indian to Complete NASA's Space Program**

- **Completed NASA Program:** Jahnvi Dangeti has become the first Indian to successfully complete NASA's prestigious International Air and Space Program, showcasing her potential as a future astronaut.
- **Space Mission Selection:** She has been selected as an Astronaut Candidate (Ascan) for Titans Space's very first orbital mission, scheduled for March 2029, where she will travel to space and orbit the Earth twice.
- **STEM Education and Outreach:** Jahnvi is a strong advocate for STEM education and space outreach, having delivered talks for ISRO's educational programs and addressed students at National Institutes of Technology (NITs) across India.
- **Astronaut Training:** Starting in 2026, Jahnvi will undergo intensive astronaut training over the next three years through Titan Space's ASCAN program, which includes flight simulations, spacecraft operations, survival training, and comprehensive medical and psychological evaluations.
- **Achievements and Awards:** Jahnvi has received notable awards, including the People's Choice Award at the NASA Space Apps Challenge and the ISRO World Space Week Young Achiever Award, recognizing her contributions to space science and education.

### **India's First Butterfly Sanctuary Inaugurated in Kerala's Aralam Forest**

- **Location and Size:** The Aralam Butterfly Sanctuary is located in Kannur district, Kerala, within the Western Ghats, and spans 55 square kilometers of tropical and semi-evergreen forests.

- **Butterfly Diversity:** The sanctuary is home to over 266 species of butterflies, accounting for more than 80% of Kerala's butterfly diversity, including rare and endangered species like the Common Albatross and Danaine species.
- **Seasonal Migration:** The sanctuary witnesses a significant butterfly migration between December and February, with hundreds of butterflies traveling down from the hills, following rivers and sunlight, creating a spectacular display of colors.
- **Conservation Efforts:** The sanctuary's designation is the result of 25 years of conservation efforts, surveys, and advocacy by researchers, forest officials, and environmental groups, aiming to provide a protected habitat for butterflies and promote eco-tourism and research.

## INTERNATIONAL NEWS

### Maaya Rajeshwaran Wins ITF J200 Title in Germany

- **Tournament Performance:** Maaya dominated the tournament, winning all her matches convincingly, including a 6-2, 6-1 win over third seed Daphnee Mpetshi Perricard of France in the semifinals.
- **Ranking and Recognition:** Currently ranked No. 79 in the ITF Junior Rankings and No. 646 in WTA, Maaya's win is expected to boost her rankings and strengthen her case for direct entries into top-tier junior events.
- **Future Prospects:** This win demonstrates Maaya's potential to compete in higher-grade tournaments, including J300 and Junior Grand Slams, and may lead to more consistent participation in the ITF Women's Circuit.
- **Versatility:** Maaya has shown adaptability across different surfaces, and this win on European clay adds another dimension to her junior résumé, which already includes victories at J100 and J300 events.

### K Paul Thomas elected chairman of Sa-Dhan

- **Election:** K Paul Thomas, MD & CEO of ESAF Small Finance Bank, has been elected as chairman of Sa-Dhan, a self-regulatory organization (SRO) for microfinance institutions recognized by the RBI.
- **Background:** Thomas has over 32 years of experience in management, with more than 25 years in the microfinance sector, and previously worked with Indian Farmers Fertilizers Co-operative Ltd (IFFCO) for 18 years.
- **Sa-Dhan Role:** As chairman, Thomas will lead Sa-Dhan's efforts to promote innovation, financial inclusion, and sustainable development through microfinance, with a focus on addressing current challenges with long-term solutions.
- **Board Reconstitution:** The Sa-Dhan board has been reconstituted with Thomas as chairperson, along with Sadaf Sayeed (MD & CEO, Muthoot Microfin) and Mukul

Jaiswal (MD, Cashphor) as co-chairs, and Vivekananda Salimath (Chair, IDF) as treasurer.

- **Objectives:** Under Thomas' leadership, Sa-Dhan aims to develop, promote, and support ecosystems of impact financing institutions that enable inclusive growth, equity, gender equality, and sustainable development in society.

### Sanjeev Kumar Singla accredited as next Ambassador of India to the Principality of Monaco

- **Appointment as Ambassador:** Sanjeev Kumar Singla has been appointed as India's Ambassador to France and the Principality of Monaco, showcasing India's diplomatic efforts to strengthen ties with European nations.
- **Experience and Expertise:** Singla is a seasoned diplomat from the 1997 batch of the Indian Foreign Service (IFS), with extensive experience in handling complex diplomatic situations, including his previous role as Ambassador to Israel.
- **Previous Roles:** He served as Private Secretary to Prime Minister Narendra Modi from 2014 to 2019 and has worked in various capacities at Indian Missions in Paris, Dhaka, Geneva, and Tel Aviv, demonstrating his broad understanding of global affairs.
- **Diplomatic Tenure in Israel:** Singla played a significant role in maintaining strong and balanced relations between India and Israel during his tenure from 2019 to 2024, earning him recognition as an "expert on Israel".

### Carlos Alcaraz Clinches Second Queen's Club Title

- **Match Result:** Carlos Alcaraz defeated Jiri Lehecka with a score of 7-5, 6-7 (5/7), 6-2 in the final, showcasing his resilience and skill on grass courts.
- **Tournament Performance:** Alcaraz dropped just two sets throughout the tournament, demonstrating his dominance. He played a nearly flawless match against Lehecka, tallying 18 aces and only two double faults.
- **Winning Streak:** This victory marks Alcaraz's 18th consecutive match win, following his title successes in Rome and at the French Open. His last loss was to Holger Rune in the Barcelona final on April 20.
- **Grass Court Expertise:** Alcaraz has now won four grass court titles, tying Rafa Nadal's career total. He's developed into a formidable force on grass, evident from his wins at Queen's and Wimbledon in 2023.
- **Wimbledon Preparation:** Alcaraz eyes a historic three-peat at Wimbledon, which starts with June 30, riding high on his current form and recent French Open victory.

### South Korea appoints First Civilian Defence Minister in 64 Years

- **Appointment:** Ahn Gyu-back, a five-term liberal lawmaker from President Lee Jae Myung's Democratic Party, has been nominated as the country's first civilian Defence Minister since 1961.
- **Background:** Ahn has served on the National Assembly's defence committee and chaired a legislative panel that investigated former President Yoon Suk Yeol's martial law decree.
- **Breaking Tradition:** For 64 years, South Korea's defence ministers have come from the military, a trend that continued even after the country's democratization in the late 1980s.
- **Martial Law Crisis:** The appointment follows a failed martial law attempt by former President Yoon Suk Yeol, who was indicted on rebellion charges and removed from office.
- **Reforms and Relations with North Korea:** Ahn is expected to push for military reforms and support President Lee's efforts to improve relations with North Korea.

### Kirsty Coventry Becomes First Female & African President of the IOC

- **Historic Election:** Kirsty Coventry was elected as the 10th President of the IOC, succeeding Thomas Bach, who completed his 12-year tenure. She won the election with 49 out of 97 votes, defeating six other candidates.
- **First Female and African President:** Coventry made history by becoming the first woman and the first African to hold the presidency of the IOC. She expressed her commitment to harnessing the power of sport to unite, inspire, and create opportunities for all <sup>1</sup>.
- **Background and Experience:** A five-time Olympian and seven-time Olympic medalist, Coventry is currently the Minister of Sport, Art, and Recreation in Zimbabwe. She has also served as the Chair of the IOC Athletes' Commission and Vice President of the International Surfing Federation.
- **Term and Responsibilities:** Coventry will serve an eight-year term, eligible for re-election once for a four-year term. She will lead the IOC in navigating complex issues such as athlete rights, sustainability of the Games, and relations with global sports federations and sponsors.

### China's former Vice Finance Minister appointed AIIB prez

- **Appointment:** Zou Jiayi has been appointed as the new President of AIIB, succeeding Jin Liqun, the founding President of the bank. Her five-year term will begin on January 16, 2026.

- **Background:** Zou is a seasoned leader with over three decades of experience in global financial policy at the highest levels. She has been instrumental in China's engagement with major international financial institutions.
- **Experience:** Zou's expertise spans organizations such as the World Bank Group, Asian Development Bank, New Development Bank, and AIIB. As former Vice Finance Minister of China, she played a crucial role in shaping the country's participation in these institutions.
- **AIIB's Shareholders:** China is the largest shareholder of AIIB with 26.54% voting shares, followed by India with 7.58%, Russia with 5.9%, and Germany with 4.1%. This diverse shareholder base reflects the bank's global reach and influence.

### **Zou Jiayi appointed as New AIIB President, Succeeds Jin Lique**

- **Historic Leadership Change:** Zou Jiayi has been elected as the President of the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB), becoming the first female leader of the multilateral development bank. She will begin her five-year term on January 16, 2026, succeeding founding President Jin Lique
- **Distinguished Career:** Zou is a seasoned economist with over three decades of experience in global financial policy. Previously, she served as China's Vice Minister of Finance, held leadership roles in the CPPCC, and participated in major institutions like the World Bank and ADB
- **Strategic Transition:** The AIIB Board of Governors confirmed her appointment during its 10th annual meeting in Beijing, marking a carefully planned handover from Jin's decade-long leadership from 2016 to 2026
- **Continuity and Global Expansion:** Zou will lead AIIB into its next decade, focusing on climate finance, infrastructure projects, and expanding presence in major global financial centers like Hong Kong, London, and Singapore
- **Bank's Strong Foundation:** Under Jin Lique, AIIB grew from 57 to 110 member countries, financed over 322 projects totaling more than USD 60 billion, and earned AAA ratings. Zou inherits a robust institution positioned to deepen investments in sustainable infrastructure

### **Gold Becomes World's Second-Largest Reserve Asset After U.S. Dollar**

- **Gold's Share in Global Reserves:** Gold now makes up 20% of global official reserves by market value, compared to the euro's 16%. This marks the highest prominence for gold in global reserves since the Bretton Woods era.

- **Central Bank Buying Spree:** Central banks have been on a gold-buying spree since 2022, accumulating over 1,000 tonnes per year—twice the average annual purchase rate of the previous decade. China, India, and Turkey have collectively added over 600 tonnes of gold since the end of 2021.
- **Price Surge:** Gold prices soared by 30% in 2024, followed by another 30% in early 2025, boosting the market value of gold held by central banks.
- **Desire for Diversification:** Central banks are looking to shield themselves from the weaponization and depreciation of the dollar, as well as US fiscal irresponsibility and the use of tariffs as a negotiating tool.
- **Impact on Dollar's Dominance:** The percentage of dollars held as a global reserve asset tumbled from 48.4% to 46.5% in 2024, while gold's share leapt from 18.1% to 19.6%.

### IFFCO to set up first overseas nano fertiliser plant in Brazil

- **Joint Venture:** IFFCO has partnered with Brazilian company NANOFERT to establish a 7:3 joint venture for manufacturing nano-soil nutrients in Curitiba, Parana province, Brazil.
- **Production Capacity:** The plant will produce 4.5 million liters of nano-fertilizers annually, catering to the demand for nano-fertilizers in Brazil and other countries.
- **Increased Market Presence:** The plant is expected to increase IFFCO's global market presence and reduce costs. IFFCO has already exported 0.5 million bottles of nano-soil nutrients to over 40 countries.
- **Crop Yield Increase:** Studies have shown that the use of nano-fertilizers can increase crop yields, with a 10% increase in corn and soybean yields and a 7% increase in sugarcane productivity.
- **Trial Production:** Trial production at the Brazil plant is expected to commence by the end of 2025. The plant's establishment is the first phase of the project, and IFFCO plans to expand production capacity in Brazil after assessing market demand.

### Neeraj Chopra Wins Gold at Paris Diamond League 2025

- **Gold Medal Win:** Neeraj Chopra won the gold medal in the men's javelin throw event at the Paris Diamond League 2025 with a throw of 88.16m.
- **First Throw Decided the Fate:** Chopra took the lead from his first throw and maintained it throughout the competition, showcasing his exceptional skill and consistency.

- **Julian Weber's Consistency:** Germany's Julian Weber finished second with a consistent series of throws but couldn't surpass Chopra's lead. Weber had six valid throws, while Chopra had only three.
- **Personal Satisfaction:** Chopra expressed satisfaction with his win but mentioned that he wasn't completely happy with his technique, particularly his run-up speed and control.
- **Season's Progress:** This win marks a significant achievement for Chopra in the 2025 season, following his 90m throw in Doha earlier in the year, where he finished second to Weber.

### Senthilkumar signs off with bronze medal in Asian Squash C'ships

- **Bronze Medal Win:** Velavan Senthilkumar from India won a bronze medal at the Asian Squash Championships held in Kuching, Malaysia.
- **Semifinal Loss:** Senthilkumar lost to second seed Alex Lau Tsz Kwan of Hong Kong in the semifinals with a score of 1-3 (9-11, 11-13, 11-5, 6-11).
- **Consecutive Medal:** This bronze medal marks Senthilkumar's second consecutive medal at the Asian Squash Championships, following a silver medal in the 2023 edition.
- **Match Duration:** The semifinal match lasted 65 minutes, showcasing the intense competition between Senthilkumar and Alex Lau Tsz Kwan.
- **India's Campaign End:** Senthilkumar's loss marked the end of India's campaign in the individual contest, but Indian players will participate in the doubles contest scheduled for next week.

### India scripts historic finish at U23 Asian Wrestling Championships with double team titles

- **Double Team Champions:** India achieved an unprecedented success by winning the overall team championships in both Men's Freestyle and Women's Freestyle categories, showcasing a strong, all-around performance across different wrestling disciplines.
- **Men's Freestyle Dominance:** The men's freestyle team was particularly impressive, securing six gold medals and one silver. This dominant display ensured they clinched the team title in their category.
- **Women's Freestyle Excellence:** Indian women wrestlers also excelled, winning the team title by securing medals in all 10 categories. Their medal haul included four gold, five silver, and one bronze, demonstrating remarkable consistency and depth in talent.
- **Significant Medal Tally:** The combined performance across men's freestyle, women's freestyle, and even a gold and two bronzes in Greco- highlights India's growing prowess in wrestling.
- **Indicator of Future Talent:** This outstanding performance at the U23 level is a strong indicator of the emerging talent and a robust pipeline for Indian wrestling.

### Jasprit Bumrah Becomes First Asian to Claim 150 Test Wickets in SENA Countries

- **First Asian to 150 SENA Wickets:** This is the headline achievement. Traditionally, these pace-friendly conditions have been challenging for Asian bowlers. Bumrah's consistency and effectiveness across these nations mark a historic shift, surpassing legendary bowlers like Wasim Akram (146 wickets).
- **Dominance in Toughest Conditions:** SENA countries are considered the ultimate test for fast bowlers due to their seaming conditions, swing, and strong home batting line-ups.
- **Record-Breaking Five-Wicket Hauls:** Along with the 150 wickets, Bumrah also recorded his 10th five-wicket haul in SENA countries, becoming the first Indian bowler to achieve this feat.
- **Exceptional Average and Strike Rate:** Bumrah's wickets in SENA countries have come at an exceptional average of around 20.88. Among all bowlers with at least 150 SENA wickets in the 21st century, only Vernon Philander (20.84) has a better average.

### India won 27 Medals in Asian Para-Badminton Championship

- **Record-Breaking Medals:** India won 27 medals, its best-ever performance in the championship, surpassing its previous record of 13 medals in 2016.
- **Medal Breakdown:** The Indian contingent secured 4 gold, 10 silver, and 13 bronze medals in various categories, showcasing the country's growing dominance in para-badminton.
- **Top Performers:** Paralympic champion Nitesh Kumar led the charge with three gold medals in men's singles SL3, mixed doubles SL3-SU5, and men's doubles SL3-SL4. Manisha Ramadass added a gold in women's singles SU5.
- **Sweeping Medals:** India dominated the mixed doubles SL3-SU5 event, sweeping all three medals. Nitesh Kumar and Thulasimathi Murugesan took gold, Ruthick Raghupathi and Manasi Joshi won silver, and Chirag Baretha and Mandeep Kaur earned bronze.

### Lalit Upadhyay Bids Farewell to International Hockey After a Glorious Career

- **Final International Appearance:** Lalit Upadhyay's last match for the Indian men's hockey team was on June 15, 2025, against Australia in Antwerp, Belgium, during the FIH Pro League. India lost that match 2-3.
- **Part of the FIH Pro League Squad:** He was part of the Indian squad that played four matches in the European leg of the FIH Pro League 2024-25 season, leading up to his retirement announcement.
- **Announcement of Retirement:** Lalit Upadhyay officially announced his retirement from international hockey on Sunday, June 22, 2025, shortly after India's final match of the European leg of the FIH Pro League season against Belgium (though his last actual playing match was against Australia).
- **Two-time Olympic Medallist:** He retires as a two-time Olympic bronze medallist, having been a crucial part of the Indian teams that won bronze at the Tokyo 2020 Olympics and the Paris 2024 Olympics.

- **Extensive International Career:** Lalit Upadhyay played 183 matches for India at the senior international level, scoring 67 goals, showcasing his consistent presence and contribution to the team's forward line since his debut at the 2014 Hockey World Cup.

### Neeraj Chopra wins Ostrava Golden Spike Javelin title with 85.29m throw

- **Upcoming Event:** Neeraj Chopra was initially scheduled to participate in the Ostrava Golden Spike athletics meeting in the Czech Republic on June 24, but there's no confirmation on his participation or winning the title with an 85.29m throw.
- **Recent Performance:** Neeraj Chopra recently won the Paris Diamond League title with a throw of 88.16m, showcasing his exceptional skill and technique in javelin throw.
- **Competition Schedule:** After Paris, Chopra is reportedly set to participate in the Neeraj Chopra Classic in Bengaluru on July 5, a World Athletics category A event that he is hosting.
- **Training Focus:** Chopra aims to strengthen his core muscles for consistent 90m throws in international competitions, focusing on technique and power.
- **Season Highlights:** Chopra began his 2025 season with a win in South Africa, throwing 84.52m, and later achieved a personal best of 90.23m at the Doha Diamond League, becoming the first Indian to breach the 90m mark after a long wait.

### Rishabh Pant Becomes First Indian Keeper to hit centuries in both Test innings

- **Record-Breaking Feat:** Rishabh Pant became the second wicketkeeper globally to hit centuries in both innings of a Test match, after Zimbabwe's Andy Flower.
- **Centuries in Both Innings:** Pant scored 118 and 134 in the first and second innings, respectively, in the Leeds Test against England.
- **Multiple Records Broken:** Pant surpassed MS Dhoni's record for the most runs by an Indian wicketkeeper in a Test match and became the third Indian wicketkeeper to take 150 Test catches.
- **Historic Achievement:** Pant is the first Indian batter to score twin centuries in Test cricket in England and the seventh Indian to hit centuries in both innings of a Test match.
- **Exceptional Performance:** Pant's knock in the first innings helped India post a 400-plus total, while his second-innings century put India in a strong position, showcasing his exceptional batting skills.

### Khelo India University Games to be held in Jaipur in November

- **Event Details:** The fifth edition of the Khelo India University Games will take place in Jaipur, Rajasthan, in November 2025, featuring over 4,000 athletes from more than 200 universities across India.
- **Host Universities:** Poornima University and Rajasthan University will jointly host the event, which will include competitions in at least 20 disciplines.

- **Age Group:** The Games are designed for under-25 athletes, providing a national platform for young athletes to showcase their talent and attract attention from scouts and sports federations.
- **Previous Edition:** The 2024 edition of the Khelo India University Games was co-hosted by seven Northeastern states, with Chandigarh University emerging as the overall champion, followed by Lovely Professional University and Guru Nanak Dev University.
- **Expectations:** Sports Minister Mansukh Mandaviya expects high-quality performances from the athletes, stating that university students dominate multi-sport events worldwide, and Rajasthan will likely see some outstanding performances.

### Indian Junior Men's Hockey Team Defeats Australia 2-1 at Nations Tournament

- **Match Outcome:** The Indian junior men's hockey team defeated Australia 2-1 in the battle for third place at the 4 Nations Tournament held in Berlin, Germany.
- **Goalscorers:** Rohit scored the equalizer for India in the 45th minute following a penalty corner, while Ajeet Yadav sealed the win with a fourth-quarter goal in the 52nd minute. Toby Mallon had given Australia the lead with a field goal in the 40th minute.
- **Game Dynamics:** The first half saw a tense battle with neither team managing to score in the opening two quarters. Strong defensive structures and disciplined play kept the scores level heading into the third quarter.
- **Tournament Performance:** This win concludes India's campaign in the 4 Nations Tournament. Earlier, India had a 1-7 loss to hosts Germany, a 3-1 victory against Australia, and a 1-5 defeat against Spain in the pool stage.

### IPPB Bags Prestigious Digital Payments Award from Finance Ministry

- **Theme 2025:** The theme for 2025 is "Break the Cycle. #StopOrganizedCrime", emphasizing the need for focused long-term action to disrupt the link between drug trafficking and organized crime, and investing in prevention, including justice, education, health care, and alternative livelihoods.
- **Global Impact:** According to the UNODC World Drug Report, 292 million people used illicit drugs in 2022, a 20% increase over the previous decade. The global burden of drug use can cost up to 2% of a country's GDP, draining healthcare, legal, and social systems.

### Micro, Small & Medium SIZED Enterprises Day observed on 27th June

- **UN-designated observance:** June 27 was declared by the United Nations General Assembly in 2017 as Micro-, Small & Medium-Sized Enterprises Day, aimed at raising global awareness of MSMEs' vital contributions to economic growth and sustainable development
- **Economic significance:** MSMEs make up around 90 % of all businesses globally, contribute about 50 % of GDP, and provide over 70 % of employment, especially in developing economies
- **2025 theme** – “Business for MSMEs: Connecting the Entrepreneurs”: The 2025 theme emphasizes building networks between MSMEs, investors, policymakers, and tech providers to unlock growth, innovation, and international expansion
- **India's MSME landscape:** In India, the sector includes over 63 million enterprises, contributes roughly 30 % of GDP and more than 45 % of exports, and employs around 110 million people
- **Focus on resilience, digital tech & green growth:** Observance events spotlight MSMEs' adaptability, technology adoption, and role in sustainable development, while addressing challenges like finance access, digital maturity, and climate resilience.

### Padma Shri Awardee ‘Aranya Rishi’ Maruti Chitampalli passed away

- **Passed Away:** Maruti Chitampalli, fondly known as ‘Aranya Rishi’, passed away on June 18, 2025, at the age of 93 in Solapur, Maharashtra, due to age-related ailments.
- **Contribution:** He was a renowned environmentalist, wildlife expert, and author who dedicated his life to forest conservation and ecological literature, serving in the Forest Department for 36 years and traveling over 5 lakh kilometers across India.
- **Awards and Recognition:** Chitampalli received the Padma Shri award on April 30, 2025, for his lifetime contribution to environmental conservation and ecological literature, and was also a recipient of the Vinda Karandikar Jeevan Gaurav Puraskar in 2017.
- **Literary Works:** He authored several notable books, including ‘Pakshikosha’ (Encyclopedia of Birds), ‘Pashukosha’ (Encyclopedia of Animals), and ‘Matsyakosha’ (Encyclopedia of Fish), and wrote over 25 books on wildlife and conservation.
- **Legacy:** Chitampalli's work had a profound impact on environmental awareness and conservation in India, and he is remembered as a spiritual guardian of forests and a people's naturalist.

### Veteran actor-director Vivek Lagoo passed away

- **Career:** Lagoo was a prominent figure in Marathi theatre and cinema, with notable contributions to television and films like "Ugly" (2013), "What About Savarkar" (2015), and "31 Divas" (2018). He was known for his versatility and depth in his performances.
- **Personal Life:** Vivek was married to actress Reema Lagoo, with whom he shared a passion for theatre. Although they parted ways, they maintained mutual respect and understanding until Reema's passing in 2017. Their daughter, Mrunmayee Lagoo Waikul, is a writer and director who has worked on projects like "Thappad" and "Scoop".
- **Legacy:** Lagoo's demise has been met with condolences from the film industry, with Maharashtra's Cultural Affairs Minister, Ashish Shelar, praising his contributions to Marathi theatre and cinema. His legacy continues through his daughter Mrunmayee, who has carved a niche for herself in the industry.

### FedEx founder Fred Smith, pioneer of express delivery passed away

- **Early Life and Education:** Fred Smith was born on August 11, 1944, in Marks, Mississippi. He graduated from Yale University in 1966 with a degree in economics, where he conceptualized the idea for an integrated air-to-ground delivery system.
- **Military Service:** Smith served two tours in Vietnam as a Marine Corps officer, earning the Silver Star, Bronze Star, and two Purple Hearts. He left the military as a captain in 1970.

- **Founding of FedEx:** Smith founded FedEx in 1973 with a fleet of 14 aircraft, pioneering overnight shipping and revolutionizing logistics. He led the company to become a global powerhouse, handling 17 million shipments daily.
- **Leadership and Legacy:** Smith stepped down as CEO in 2022 but remained executive chairman. He was known for his leadership philosophy, rooted in the "People-Service-Profit" culture, and was widely respected for his vision and integrity.

### Former Indian left-arm spinner Dilip Doshi passed away

- **Legendary Career Stats:** Doshi represented India in 33 Test matches, taking 114 wickets (including six five-wicket hauls), alongside 22 wickets in 15 ODIs, showcasing his skill as a classical slow left-arm orthodox spinner
- **Passed Away in London:** He passed away at the age of 77 in London due to cardiac arrest, having been based there for several decades
- **Highly Respected by Cricketing Icons:** Cricket icons like Sachin Tendulkar and Ravi Shastri expressed sorrow at his passing, remembering him as a “warm-hearted soul” and “a gentleman to the core”


