





1. U Mumba crowned Ultimate Table Tennis champions 2025

- Championship Win: U Mumba defeated Jaipur Patriots 8-4 in the final to claim their first-ever Ultimate Table Tennis title.
- **Star Performance**: Bernadette Szocs, U Mumba's captain and World No. 12, was instrumental in the win, earning 5 points, including a 2-1 victory over





• MVP Awards: Bernadette Szocs was named the Female MVP of UTT Season 6, while Harmeet Desai of Dempo Goa Challengers was awarded the Male MVP.

2. India re-appoints Aliawati Longkumer as Ambassador to North Korea

 Appointment: Aliawati Longkumer, a 2008-batch Indian Foreign Service officer, has been appointed as India's Ambassador to North Korea, marking the country's return to diplomatic representation in Pyongyang after a fouryear gap.







- **Background**: Longkumer currently serves as Charge d'Affaires at the Indian Embassy in Asuncion, Paraguay, and is expected to assume his new role in Pyongyang shortly.
- **India-North Korea Relations**: Diplomatic relations between India and North Korea were established in 1973, with India maintaining a balanced relationship despite closer ties with South Korea and the US.
- Strategic Significance: The appointment highlights India's interest in maintaining open communication channels with North Korea, given the country's strategic alliances with China and Russia, and its nuclear capabilities.
- **Previous Ambassador**: Atul Malhari Gotsurve was the last Indian ambassador to North Korea before the embassy's closure in July 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, which has now been reopened in December 2024.

3. Puducherry became the 19th legislature to adopt the NeVA platform

- Adoption of NeVA: Puducherry has become the 19th legislature in India to adopt the National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) platform, a significant step towards digitalizing legislative functioning.
- Union Minister Dr. L. Murugan on June 9, 2025, in the presence of Lieutenant Governor K. Kailashnathan, Chief Minister N. Rangasamy, and Assembly Speaker R. Selvam.
- **Key Features**: NeVA is a workflow-based digital platform that provides real-time access to rules, notices, business lists, bills, bulletins, questions, and reports.
- **Benefits**: The adoption of NeVA is expected to save 3-5 tonnes of paper annually, promoting environmental sustainability and efficient governance. It also enhances transparency and citizen participation in the legislative process.

5. Yajik Hillang bags Gold medal at South Asian Bodybuilding & Physique

• Gold Medal Win: Yajik Hillang won a gold medal in the Women's Model Physique category (up to 155 cm) at the 15th South Asian Bodybuilding and Physique Sports Championships 2025 held in Thimphu, Bhutan.

• **Historic Achievement**: Hillang became the first female physique athlete from Arunachal Pradesh to win a gold



medal at an international event, marking a significant milestone for the state's sporting legacy.

6. Armand Duplantis Sets 12th World Record with 6.28m Vault

• **Record-Breaking Jump**: Duplantis achieved this feat on his first attempt, showcasing his exceptional skill and dominance in the sport. He had previously set the record at 6.27m in February 2025.



- **Historic Significance**: This record-breaking jump marks the 12th time Duplantis has surpassed his own world record, solidifying his position as a two-time Olympic champion and serial world record breaker.
- **Home Crowd Delight**: The event took place at Stockholm's 1912 Olympic Stadium, making it a special moment for Duplantis, who had family members in attendance cheering him on.
- **Future Prospects**: Duplantis has expressed his ambition to push the boundaries further, aiming for a jump of 6.30m. With his current form, it's likely he'll continue to dominate the sport.
- **Competition Highlights**: The Stockholm Diamond League meet saw other impressive performances, including Julien Alfred's win in the women's 100m with a time of 10.75 seconds and Femke Bol's victory in the women's 400m hurdles with a season's best time of 52.11 seconds.

7. MoU signed to introduce UPI services in Cyprus
