**Pronunciation:**feeuhhs

**Meaning:** angry, aggressive and frightening.

**Synonyms:**vicious, savage, fell

**Antonyms:** gentle,mild, tame

**Sentence:**Fierce storms lashed the country.

### 2.UNFETTER(VERB): निरंकुश

**Pronunciation:**uhn•feh•tuhd

**Meaning:** unrestrained or uninhibited.

**Synonyms:** unchain, unbind, free

**Antonyms:** bind, bound, eclosed

**Sentence:**The guards unfetter the prisoners.

### 3.CUTTING-EDGE (ADJECTIVE): अग्रणी

**Pronunciation:**kuht•uhng-ej

**Meaning:** the most recent, advanced stage in the development of something.

**Synonyms:** innovative, pioneering, advanced

**Antonyms:** conventional, customary, traditional

**Sentence:**The company succeeded as it uses cutting-edge technology.

### 4.IMPROBABLE(ADJECTIVE): असंभव

**Pronunciation:**im•praw•buh•bl

**Meaning:** not likely to be true or to happen.

**Synonyms:**doubtful, dubious, odd

**Antonyms:** believable, probable, possible

**Sentence:**The characters have improbable names.

### 5.DEFIANT(ADJECTIVE): उपेक्षापूर्ण

**Pronunciation:**duh•fai•uhnt

**Meaning:** showing open refusal to obey somebody/something.

**Synonyms:** resistant, obstinate, uncooperative

**Antonyms:** obedient, docile, amiable

**Sentence:** He showed a defiant gesture.

## 6.STACK(VERB): ढेर

**Pronunciation:** stak

**Meaning:** a tidy pile of something.

**Synonyms:** loads, ton, pile

**Antonyms:** handful, spot, taste

**Sentence:** He spent most of the time stacking shelves.

## 7.BRIDGE(VERB): पुल

**Pronunciation:** brij

**Meaning:** a structure that carries a road or railway across a river, valley, road or railway.

**Synonyms:** link, connect

**Antonyms:** divide

**Sentence:** New initiatives were needed to bridge the great abyss of class.

## 8.RELENTLESS(ADJECTIVE): दयाहीन

**Pronunciation:** ruh•lent•luhs

**Meaning:** not stopping or changing.

**Synonyms:** continuing, constant, non-stop

**Antonyms:** short-lived, irresolute, intermittent

**Sentence:** We bore the relentless heat of the desert.

## 9.TENUOUS(ADJECTIVE): तुच्छ

**Pronunciation:** teh•nyoo•uhs

**Meaning:** very weak or uncertain.

**Synonyms:** flimsy, insubstantial, slight

**Antonyms:** convincing, substantial, solid

**Sentence:** The link between interest rates and investment is tenuous in my firm.

## 10.AGITATION(NOUN): घबराहट

**Pronunciation:** a•juh•tay•shn

**Meaning:** worry and anxiety.

**Synonyms:** perturbation, disquiet, distress


**Antonyms:** calmness, calm, still
