**1.RECONCILER (noun):** सुलहकर्ता

**Pronunciation :** ri·kuhn·sile

**Meaning:** a person who brings about peace, especially by reconciling adversaries.

**Synonyms:** conciliator, peacemaker, arbitrator

**Antonyms:** rabble-rousers, protesters, agitators

**Sentence:** He is the great reconciler and harmonizer.

**2.FULMINATION (noun):** निंदा

**Pronunciation :** fuhl·muh·nay·shn

**Meaning:** an expression of vehement protest.

**Synonyms:** protest, objection, complaint

**Antonyms:** acclaim, applause, commendation

**Sentence:** Players were told they had a right to be spared the foul-mouthed fulmination of the hockey coach.

**3.RUBBLE (noun):** मलबा

**Pronunciation :** ruh·bl

**Meaning:** waste or rough fragments of stone, brick, concrete, etc., especially as the debris from the demolition of buildings.

**Synonyms:** debris, remains, ruins

**Antonyms:** booty, find, pickings, salvage

**Sentence:** Thousands of bodies are still buried under the rubble.

**4.DISSENSION (noun):** मतभेद

**Pronunciation :** duh·sen·shn

**Meaning:** disagreement that leads to discord.

**Synonyms:** disagreement, dispute, dissent

**Antonyms:** accord, agreement, concord

**Sentence:** There are signs of dissension within the ruling political party.

**5.STAVE OFF (verb):** स्थगित करना

**Pronunciation :** STAVE OFF

**Meaning:** to assign to a later time

**Synonyms:** defer, delay, suspend

**Antonyms:** act, deal (with), work (on)

**Sentence:** We were hoping to stave off these difficult decisions until September.

**6.FLEECE (verb):** फ़ायदा उठाना**Pronunciation :** flees**Meaning:** obtain a great deal of money from (someone), typically by overcharging or swindling them.**Synonyms:** swindle, cheat, defraud**Antonyms:** save someone's bacon**Sentence:** Swindlers who use the telephone to fleece senior citizens out of their savings.**7.TRANQUILLITY (noun):** शांति**Pronunciation :** trang·kvil·uh·tee**Meaning:** the quality or state of being tranquil; calm.**Synonyms:** peace, calm, placidity**Antonyms:** bustle, commotion, hubbub**Sentence:** He enjoyed the tranquillity of village life.**8.VAMOOSE (verb):** जल्दी से निकल जाना**Pronunciation :** va·moos**Meaning:** depart hurriedly.**Synonyms:** depart, exit, walkout**Antonyms:** arrive, come**Sentence:** We'd better vamoose before we're caught.**9.JEOPARDY (noun):** ख़तरा**Pronunciation :** jeep·ard·y**Meaning:** danger of loss, harm, or failure.**Synonyms:** danger, peril, at risk**Antonyms:** safety, security**Sentence:** Michael's job was not in jeopardy.**10.SCUFFLE (noun):** हाथापाई**Pronunciation :** skuh·fl**Meaning:** a short, confused fight or struggle at close quarters.**Synonyms:** fight, struggle, tussle**Antonyms:** truce**Sentence:** He was involved in a scuffle with a photographer.
