1. ADMONISHMENT (noun) – चेतावनी

Pronunciation: ud-monish-munt

Meaning: a firm warning or a formal expression of disapproval

Synonyms: injunction, directive, command, instruction; rebuke, reproof, admonition, reproach, reproval, scolding

Antonyms: praise, commendation

Usage: After listening to his grandmother's admonishment, the young boy felt horrible about stealing the candy from the store.

2. MAGNANIMITY (noun) - उदारता, दरियादिली

Pronunciation: mag-nun-imiti

Meaning: the fact or condition of being forgiving, especially towards an opponent or less powerful person

Synonyms: generosity, benevolence **Antonyms:** meanness, selfishness

Usage: She accepted the criticism with magnanimity.

3. EXCULPATE (verb) – दोषमुक्त करना

Pronunciation: ek-skul-peit

Meaning: to remove blame from someone **Synonyms:** exonerate, absolve, acquit

Antonym: convict, charge

Usage: The pilot of the aircraft will surely be exculpated when all the facts are known.

4. INTERNECINE (adjective) – परस्पर-विध्वंसी

Pronunciation: intuh-nee-sain

Meaning: destructive to both sides in a conflict

Synonyms: deadly, bloody, violent, fierce, destructive, ruinous

Usage: The parents did not understand how much their internecine divorce battle was destroying their children's future.

5. PRESENTIMENT (noun) – पूर्वाभाव, पूर्वबोध

Pronunciation: pri-zenti-munt / pri-senti-munt

Meaning: an intuitive feeling about the future, especially that something bad will happen

Synonyms: premonition, foreboding, intuition, hunch

Usage: He had a presentiment of disaster.

6. BARGE (verb) – अतिक्रमण

Pronunciation: baaj

Meaning: intrude or interrupt rudely or awkwardly

Synonyms: break in, butt in, cut in, interrupt, intervene, intrude, encroach, gatecrash

Usage:

- Students tried to barge into the secretariat buildings.
- Don't barge into the conversation.

7. BARBED (adjective) – दिल दुखाने वाला

Pronunciation: baabd

Meaning: (of a remark or joke) deliberately hurtful

Synonyms: hurtful, wounding, cutting, biting, stinging, mean, spiteful

Antonyms: kindly, generous

Usage: She made some barbed comments about my lifestyle.

8. VALETUDINARIAN (noun, adjective) - वहमी; स्वास्थ्य को लेकर चिंतित

Pronunciation: valityoo-di-ne-ri-un

Meaning: a person who is unduly anxious about their health; showing undue concern about one's health

Synonyms: hypochondriac, neurotic, invalid, valetudinary; self-obsessed, sickly, ailing, poorly

Usage:

• Often valetudinarians are more likely to get sick. (noun)

• The valetudinarian man purchased a large bottle of hand sanitizer from the grocery store. (adjective)

9. FROWZY (adjective) – मैला-कुचैला

Pronunciation: frauzi

Meaning: not attractive; dirty

Synonyms: scruffy, unkempt, untidy, sloppy, messy, dishevelled, slovenly

Antonym: tidy

Usage: The frowzy street was disgusting.

10. HARROW (verb) – दु:ख देना, कष्ट देना

Pronunciation: haro

Meaning: cause distress to someone

Synonyms: trouble, afflict, grieve, torment, torture, crucify

Antonyms: calm, comfort, heartening

Usage: Her heart was deeply harrowed by his criticizing comments.
