1. IMPRIMATUR (noun) – इजाज़त, अनुमति, आजा

Pronunciation: impri-mei-tuh / impri-maa-tuh **Meaning**: a person's authoritative approval **Synonyms**: sanction, permission, approval

Antonyms: disapproval, refusal, rejection, censure

Usage: During WWII, newspapers had to get an official imprimatur in order to publish specific content.

2. ECCLESIASTICAL (adjective) – ईसाई धर्म संबंधी

Pronunciation: ikleezi-astik(u)l

Meaning: relating to the Christian Church or its clergy

Synonyms: priestly, ministerial, clerical, ecclesiastic, prelatic, canonical, pastoral

Usage: The ecclesiastical history of our church was a topic of discussion during the morning service.

3. DAMSEL (noun) – युवती, कन्या, कुमारी

Pronunciation: dam-z(u)l

Meaning: a young unmarried woman

Synonyms: young lady, miss, girl, lass, lassie, colleen

Antonym: lad

Usage: No damsel was allowed to be a part of the government.

4. FAWN (verb) - चापलूसी करना

Pronunciation: fo-n

Meaning: (of a person) give a servile display of exaggerated flattery or affection, typically in order to gain favour

Synonyms: flatter, praise, eulogize, sweet-talk, soft-soap **Usage**: He was fawning over the President with soft words.

5. TUTELAGE (noun) – संरक्षकता, प्रतिपालकत्व, अभिभावकता

Pronunciation: tyoo-tilij

Meaning: protection of or authority over someone or something

Synonyms: guardianship, instruction, tuition

Usage:

The organizations remained under firm government tutelage. He felt privileged to be under the tutelage of an experienced actor.

6. ADAMANT (adjective) - अटल

Pronunciation: adum(u)nt

Meaning: unwilling to change an opinion or decision

Synonyms: unshakeable, immovable, inflexible, unwavering, uncompromising, resolute, resolved, determined, firm,

rigid, steadfast, unswerving, stubborn **Antonym**: unsure, unconfident

Usage: He was adamant in his determination to punish the corrupt officials.

7. FITFUL (adjective) - अनियमित, अस्थायी

Pronunciation: fit-ful **Meaning**: not regular

Synonyms: intermittent, sporadic, spasmodic

Antonym: constant

Usage: It was a cool day with fitful sunshine.

8. DAMNATION (noun) – नरकदण्डd, नरकवास

Pronunciation: dam-nei-sh(u)n

Meaning: the act of sending someone to hell or the state of being in hell

Synonyms: perdition, doom, hellfire, curse

Antonym: bless

Usage: They believe he will suffer damnation for his sins.

9. APPORTION (verb) – बांटना

Pronunciation: upo-sh(u)n

Meaning: divide up and share out

Synonyms: distribute, allot, assign, dispense

Antonyms: assemble, gather, collect

Usage: It was difficult to apportion the blame for the accident.

10. DIABOLICAL (adjective) – शैतानी, पैशाचिक

Pronunciation: dai-ub-olik(u)l

Meaning: characteristic of the Devil, or so evil as to be suggestive of the Devil

Synonyms: devilish, diabolic, fiendish, satanic

Antonyms: holy, godly, angelic

Usage: She exhibited signs of her former diabolical symptoms.


