NATIONAL NEWS

India Launches National Biobank for Health Research

- Launch and Purpose: The National Biobank was launched on July 6, 2025, by Union Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh at the CSIR-Institute of Genomics and Integrative Biology (IGIB) in New Delhi.
- **Personalized Healthcare**: The biobank aims to enable personalized healthcare by generating high-resolution data that can power AI-driven diagnostics and gene-guided therapies. This will help doctors tailor treatments to an individual's genetic makeup, lifestyle, and environment.
- **India-Specific Health Challenges**: The biobank will help decode complex diseases like diabetes, cancer, and cardiovascular conditions, which are prevalent in India.
- **Technologies Used:** The biobank will utilize advanced technologies like genomic sequencing, CRISPR-based genome editing, AI, and machine learning to analyze data and identify genetic variants linked to diseases.

India's Ranks 3rd Globals in FinTech Startup Funding

- **Global Top 3 Position**: India consistently holds the third position globally in FinTech startup funding, trailing only the United States and the United Kingdom.
- **Significant Funding Despite Decline**: While the overall funding in the Indian FinTech sector saw a decline (e.g., \$1.9 billion in 2024, down 33% from 2023, and \$889 million in H1 2025, down from H2 2024), its global ranking has remained strong.
- **Bengaluru as a Hub**: Bengaluru continues to be the leading city for FinTech funding in India, accounting for a significant portion of the total investments.
- **Dominance of Digital Lending**: Digital lending solutions have consistently attracted the largest share of FinTech funding in India, indicating a strong focus on financial inclusion and access to credit.

Telangana Launches TGDeX India's First AI Data Infrastructure

- India's First State-Led AI Digital Public Infrastructure: Telangana has pioneered the launch of the Telangana Data Exchange (TGDeX), making it the first state in India to establish a state-led digital public infrastructure specifically for Artificial Intelligence.
- Aims to Boost AI Innovation: TGDeX is designed to address key challenges in AI development, such as limited access to clean, usable datasets, the need for subsidized compute infrastructure (including GPU resources), and pathways to scale AI solutions beyond proof-of-concept.
- **Collaborative Ecosystem**: The platform fosters collaboration between government departments, startups, industry players, research institutions, and academia. It will provide a secure, scalable environment for accessing high-quality, "AI-ready" datasets and open-source AI/ML models.



• **Strategic Partnerships**: Developed by the Emerging Technologies Wing of Telangana's ITE&C department, TGDeX has received strategic and technical support from the Japan International Cooperation Agency

INTERNATIONAL NEWS

Jennifer Geerlings-Simons Becomes Suriname's First Woman President

- **Historic Election**: Jennifer Geerlings-Simons was elected as Suriname's first woman president on July 6, 2025, marking a significant milestone in the country's history. She will be sworn into office on July 16.
- **Party Affiliation**: Geerlings-Simons represents the National Democratic Party (NDP), which won 18 of the 51 seats in the National Assembly. The party formed an alliance with five other parties, securing a two-thirds majority needed to claim the presidency. Background: The 71-year-old former opposition leader and doctor has previously served as the chairperson of the National Assembly.

Russia 1st Country to officially Recognise Taliban Govt in Afghanistan

- **First Official Recognition**: Russia has become the first nation to formally recognize the Taliban's leadership in Afghanistan since their takeover in August 2021.
- **Removal from Banned List**: This recognition follows Moscow's decision in April 2025 to remove the Taliban from its list of banned organizations.
- **Diplomatic Credentials Accepted**: The Russian Foreign Ministry confirmed receiving credentials from Afghanistan's new Ambassador Gul Hassan Hassan, signifying official acceptance of the Taliban's diplomatic representation.
- **Strategic & Economic Interests**: The move is largely driven by Russia's strategic interests in Afghanistan's stability, counter-terrorism efforts (particularly against ISIS-K), and potential economic cooperation in areas like energy and trade.

Indonesia will host Artistic Gymnastics World Championships 2025

- **Historic First**: Indonesia will make history by becoming the first Southeast Asian nation to host the Artistic Gymnastics World Championships.
- **Dates and Venue**: The 53rd edition of the championships will take place from October 19 to 25, 2025, at the Indonesia Arena in Senayan, Jakarta.
- **Record Participation**: The event is set to be the largest to date, with a record 86 countries and regions already registered, surpassing the usual attendance of around 70.



- **Individual Focus**: As a post-Olympic year championship, the event will focus on individual competitions across ten apparatus titles (six for men and four for women), crowning new men's and women's All-Around champions.
- **Catalyst for Development**: Hosting this prestigious event is seen as a significant opportunity for Indonesia to boost the development of gymnastics within the country and inspire a new generation of athletes.



Sabih Khan Appointed as Apple's Next COO

- **Successor to Jeff Williams**: Sabih Khan has been officially appointed as Apple's new Chief Operating Officer, taking over from the outgoing Jeff Williams as part of a long-planned succession.
- Long-standing Apple Veteran: Khan has been with Apple for three decades, joining in 1995. He has steadily risen through the ranks, most recently serving as Senior Vice President of Operations since 2019.
- **Master of Supply Chain**: He is widely recognized as a central architect of Apple's global supply chain, overseeing critical functions like planning, procurement, manufacturing, logistics, and product fulfillment.

India Becomes World's 4th Largest Biofuel Consumer in 2024

- **Significant Jump in Consumption**: India's biofuel consumption saw a substantial 40% year-on-year increase in 2024, reaching 77 thousand barrels of oil equivalent per day (kbbloe/d).
- **Surpassing China**: For the second consecutive year, India outpaced China in biofuel consumption, becoming the fourth-largest user globally, as per the Statistical Review of World Energy 2025.
- **Policy Driven Growth**: This growth is largely attributed to the Indian government's supportive policies, particularly the Ethanol Blending Programme (EBP), which aims for 20% ethanol blending in petrol by 2025-26.



• Energy Security & Environmental Benefits: The increased adoption of biofuels is a key part of India's strategy to enhance energy security by reducing reliance on crude oil imports and to mitigate climate change by lowering greenhouse gas emissions.

Trump appoints transport secretary Sean Duffy as interim Nasa Chief

- Interim Appointment: Sean Duffy, who currently serves as the Secretary of Transportation, has been named the interim administrator of NASA.
- Withdrawal of Previous Nominee: This appointment follows Trump's withdrawal of his earlier choice for NASA chief, tech billionaire Jared Isaacman, in late May. The withdrawal was reportedly due to Isaacman's "prior associations" and close ties to Elon Musk.
- **Praise from President Trump**: Trump praised Duffy's work in transportation, highlighting his efforts in improving air traffic control systems and rebuilding roads and bridges, stating he will be a "fantastic leader" for NASA.

BANKING NEWS

World Bank ranks India 4th among the world's Most Equal Societies

- **Ranking and Gini Index**: India has secured the 4th position globally in terms of income equality, with a Gini Index score of 25.5. This places India behind only the Slovak Republic, Slovenia, and Belarus.
- **Significant Progress**: India's Gini Index score has improved from 28.8 in 2011 to 25.5, indicating a notable reduction in income inequality over the years. This progress is attributed to the government's focus on poverty reduction, financial inclusion, and direct welfare support.
- **Poverty Reduction**: Between 2011 and 2023, India lifted 171 million people out of extreme poverty, resulting in a significant decline in the national poverty rate from 16.2% to 2.3%.
- **Comparison with Other Countries:** India's Gini Index score is better than that of many advanced economies, including China (35.7) and the United States (41.8), as well as all G7 and G20 nations.

Harvinder Singh Wins Gold in Recurve Men's Open at Asian Para-Archery Championships

- Double Gold Medalist: Harvinder Singh won two gold medals at the championships, one in the Recurve Men's Open and another in the Recurve Open Mixed Team event with teammate Bhawna.
- New Competition Record: Singh set a new competition record and personal best score of 663 points in the Recurve Men's qualifying round, showcasing his exceptional skill.
- Dominant Performance: In the Recurve Men's Open final, Singh outclassed Thailand's Hanreuchai Netsiri with a commanding 7-1 victory, demonstrating his dominance in the sport.
- India's Medal Haul: Singh's efforts contributed significantly to India's second-place finish in the overall medal standings, with a total of nine medals three gold, three silver, and three bronze.

India secures AFC Women's Asian Cup Qualification for the first time

- Historic Qualification: India qualified for the AFC Women's Asian Cup 2026 for the first time through the qualification route, marking a significant milestone in Indian women's football.
- Winning Performance: The Indian women's team defeated hosts Thailand 2-1 in the final group match, with Sangita Basfore scoring both goals, to top Group B with a perfect record of four wins from four matches.
- Perfect Record: India's campaign included impressive wins against Mongolia (13-0), Timor Leste (4-0), and Iraq (5-0), showcasing the team's growing strength in women's football.
- Tournament Details: The 2026 AFC Women's Asian Cup will be held in Australia, and India's qualification marks their first appearance since 2022, when they participated as hosts but withdrew due to a COVID-19 outbreak.

Boxer Sakshi Wins India's First Gold at Second World Boxing Cup

- First Gold for India: Sakshi secured India's inaugural gold medal at the Second World Boxing Cup in Astana, Kazakhstan.
- Dominant Performance: She achieved a unanimous 5-0 decision victory in the women's 54kg final against Yoseline Perez of the USA, showcasing her attacking style, speed, and sharp combinations.
- Two-Time Youth World Champion: Sakshi's win at the World Boxing Cup adds to her impressive record, as she is also a two-time youth world champion.

Aryaveer Dewan Won U17 Title at Asian Junior Squash Championships

- Ends 13-Year Drought: Aryaveer Dewan's victory in the U17 boys' category ended India's 13-year wait for a gold medal in this specific division at the Asian Junior Squash Championships.
- Dominant Final Performance: He defeated the defending champion, Nickhileswar Moganasundharam of Malaysia, in straight games (11-5, 11-8, 11-3), showcasing a strong and confident performance.
- Part of India's Strong Showing: His gold medal contributed significantly to India's bestever medal haul at the 32nd Asian Junior Individual Championships 2025, where India clinched two golds, two silvers, and three bronze medals.
- Team India's Success: Along with Aryaveer, Anahat Singh also secured a gold medal in the Girls Under 19 category, further highlighting India's rising talent in junior squash.

Magnus Carlsen Wins SuperUnited Chess 2025

- Dominant Victory: Magnus Carlsen won the SuperUnited Rapid & Blitz 2025 in Zagreb, Croatia, securing the title with a round to spare.
- Blitz Prowess: Despite starting the rapid section in third place, Carlsen showcased exceptional form in the blitz portion, ultimately clinching the overall victory.
- Consistency Pays Off: Carlsen finished with a total of 22.5/36 points, maintaining a significant lead over his competitors.
- Sixth Consecutive Win: This win marked Carlsen's sixth straight tournament victory in 2025 and his tenth Grand Chess Tour rapid and blitz title out of twelve appearances.
- Podium Finish for Gukesh: Indian World Champion D. Gukesh, who initially led the rapid section, finished impressively in third place overall.

India Finish 3rd At World Police and Fire Games 2025

- Impressive Overall Performance: India secured a remarkable third position in the overall medal tally at the World Police and Fire Games 2025 held in Birmingham, Alabama, USA.
- Significant Medal Haul: The Indian contingent amassed a total of 588 medals (some sources state 560), including 280 gold, 178 silver, and 130 bronze, showcasing exceptional athletic prowess across various disciplines.
- Key Contributors: Personnel from various Indian police and paramilitary forces, including the Border Security Force (BSF) and Central Industrial Security Force (CISF), and notably the Uttar Pradesh Police, were major contributors to the medal count.
- UP Police's Outstanding Contribution: The Uttar Pradesh Police contingent alone secured a record 95 medals, the highest by any Indian unit, including 45 gold, highlighting their strong performance in disciplines like athletics, swimming, wrestling, and more.

Lando Norris Steals The Win At British Grand Prix



- Home Soil Triumph: Lando Norris secured his first-ever win at his home race, the British Grand Prix, in front of a cheering Silverstone crowd, making a long-held dream come true.
- Dramatic Wet-Dry Conditions: The race was highly eventful, with mixed wet and dry conditions creating chaos, multiple safety car periods, and strategic challenges for all drivers.
- Capitalized on Opportunities: Norris, starting third, expertly navigated the changing conditions, taking advantage of a spin by Max Verstappen and a controversial 10-second penalty for his teammate Oscar Piastri to seize the lead.
- McLaren 1-2 Finish: The victory also marked a strong 1-2 finish for McLaren, with Oscar Piastri coming in second despite his penalty, showcasing the team's strong performance.
- Championship Gap Narrowed: Norris's win significantly narrowed the championship gap to his teammate Oscar Piastri, making the title fight even more intense with 12 races remaining in the season.

Spinner Deepti Sharma moves to 2nd spot in ICC Women's T20 ranking

- Career-Best Ranking: Deepti Sharma has climbed to her career-best second position in the ICC Women's T20I Bowling Rankings.
- Close to Top Spot: She is now just 8 rating points behind Pakistan's Sadia Iqbal, who holds the top spot, putting her on the cusp of becoming the world's No. 1 T20I bowler for the first time.
- Performance Against England: This significant rise comes after her impressive performance, including a three-wicket haul, in the ongoing five-match T20I series against England.
- Consistent Performer: Deepti has consistently been ranked within the top 10 T20I bowlers for most of the past six years, showcasing her reliability and skill.
- All-Rounder Impact: As a prominent all-rounder, her rise in bowling rankings further highlights her overall value to the Indian team in T20 Internationals.

Animesh Kujur breaks invisible barrier with new 100m record

- New National Record: Animesh Kujur set a new national record in the men's 100m, clocking an impressive 10.18 seconds.
- First Indian under 10.2s: This performance makes him the first Indian athlete to run the 100m sprint in under 10.2 seconds, breaking a significant "invisible barrier" in Indian athletics.
- Location of Achievement: The record was set at the Dromia International Sprint and Relays Meeting 2025 in Vari, Greece, on July 5, 2025.



- Triple National Record Holder: Kujur now holds national records in three events: the 100m (10.18s), 200m (20.32s), and is also part of the 4x100m relay national record team (38.69s).
- Future Aspirations: The 22-year-old sprinter is confident of further improving his timings, with his ultimate goal being to break the 10-second barrier in the 100m and the 20-second barrier in the 200m.

- He was widely known as the "merger magician" for spearheading major mergers and acquisitions during his tenure, significantly expanding HUL's portfolio.
- Datta oversaw the landmark merger of Tata Oil Mills Company (TOMCO) with HUL in 1994, and also led acquisitions of brands like Kissan, Brooke Bond, and Lipton, diversifying HUL into the foods segment.
- Datta served as Chairman of Hindustan Lever Limited (HLL, now HUL) and all Unilever companies in India and Nepal from 1990 to 1996, having started his career as a management trainee with HUL in 1956.

International Umpire Bismillah Jan Shinwari passed away

- International cricket umpire Bismillah Jan Shinwari, from Afghanistan, passed away on July 8, 2025, at the age of 41.
- Reports indicate he died due to complications following weight loss surgery he underwent in Pakistan.
- Shinwari was a respected member of the ICC International Panel of Umpires, having officiated in 25 One Day Internationals (ODIs) and 21 Twenty20 Internationals (T20Is) during his career.
- He made his international umpiring debut in December 2017 in a match between Afghanistan and Ireland in Sharjah.

Veteran Socialist Leader Charupara Ravi passed away

- **Emergency Resistance**: He actively opposed the Emergency period, leading to his arrest and four months of imprisonment, where he endured police brutality.
