#### 1. ELUSIVE (adj) – हाथ न आनेवाला

**Pronunciation:** uh•loo•suhv **Meaning:** difficult to find, catch, or achieve. **Synonyms:** difficult to catch, evasive, slippery **Antonyms:** accessible, approachable, attainable **Sentence:** Success will become ever more <u>elusive</u>.

#### 2. CONTUMACIOUS (adj) – अवज्ञाकारी

Pronunciation: kawn•choo•may•shuhs
Meaning: (especially of a defendant's behavior) stubbornly or willfully disobedient to authority.
Synonyms: contrary, defiant, disobedient
Antonyms: amenable, biddable, obedient
Sentence: His refusal to make child support payments was <u>contumacious</u>.

#### 3. BIZARRE (adj) – विचित्र

Pronunciation: bi•zaa
Meaning: very strange or unusual, especially so as to cause interest or amusement.
Synonyms: strange, peculiar, odd
Antonyms: common, average, ordinary
Sentence: He gave a bizarre excuse for getting home so late.

#### 4. BATTER (verb) - मारना

Pronunciation: ba•tuhMeaning: strike repeatedly with hard blows.Synonyms: pummel, pound, beat upAntonyms: heal, aid, fixSentence: He was <u>battered</u> and falsely imprisoned by the officers.

#### 5. INSTIGATE (verb) – भड़काना

**Pronunciation:** in•stuh•gayt **Meaning:** bring about or initiate (an action or event). **Synonyms:** set in motion, put in motion, initiate **Antonyms:** calm, soothe, subdue **Sentence:** They <u>instigated</u> a reign of terror.



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#### 6. SLAY (verb) - मार डालना

Pronunciation: slā Meaning: kill (a person or animal) in a violent way. Synonyms: kill, murder, put to death Antonyms: animate, resuscitate, revive Sentence: St. George <u>slew</u> the dragon.

#### 7. FLING (verb) – फेंकना

Pronunciation: flingMeaning: throw or hurl forcefully.Synonyms: throw, toss, slingAntonyms: hold, keep, retainSentence: He picked up the debris and <u>flung</u> it away.

#### 8. TRIFLE (noun) – छोटी सी

Pronunciation: trai•flMeaning: a thing of little value or importance.Synonyms: trivial thing, unimportant thing, nothingAntonyms: importance, lotSentence: We needn't trouble the headmaster over such trifles.

#### 9. AMICABLE (adj) – मैत्रीपूर्ण

Pronunciation: a•muh•kuh•bl
Meaning: (of relations between people) having a spirit of friendliness; without serious disagreement or rancor.
Synonyms: friendly, good-natured, cordial
Antonyms: disagreeable, discordant, incompatible
Sentence: There will be an <u>amicable</u> settlement of the dispute.

#### 10. ACQUIESCE (verb) – संतुष्ट होना

Pronunciation: a•kvee•es
Meaning: accept something reluctantly but without protest.
Synonyms: permit, consent to, agree to
Antonyms: dissent, refuse, reject
Sentence: Apparently, the contractor expected me to <u>acquiesce</u> to my own fleecing.
