


DAILY VOCAB DOSE

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Exceptional words of English vocabulary from the newspaper 'The Hindu' are listed here. 1.HERALD (verb): सूचना देना

Pronunciation: heh·ruhld

Meaning: be a sign that (something) is about to happen.

Synonyms: signal, indicate, announce

Antonyms: hide, keep secret

Sentence: The speech heralded a change in policy.

2.DEBACLE (noun) : पराजय

Pronunciation: duh·baa·kl

Meaning: a sudden and ignominious failure; a fiasco.

Synonyms: fiasco, failure, catastrophe

Antonyms: success, winner

Sentence: The economic debacle that became known as the Great Depression.

3.PERTURB (verb) : घबड़ा देना

Pronunciation: puh·tuhb

Meaning: make (someone) anxious or unsettled.

Synonyms: anxious, trouble, nervous

Antonyms: calm, compose, quiet

Sentence: News of the arrest perturbed her greatly.

4.SPATE (noun) : झोंक

Pronunciation: spayt

Meaning: a large number of similar things or events appearing or occurring in quick succession.

Synonyms: series, succession

Antonyms: little, mite, bit

Sentence: The bombing was the latest in a spate of terrorist attacks.

5.GARB (noun) : पोशाक

Pronunciation: gaab

Meaning: clothing or dress, especially of a distinctive or special kind.

Synonyms: clothes, clothing, garments

Antonyms: strip, disarray, undress

Sentence: In that garb, he'd make a better spectator than anything else.

6.INTRICATE (adj.) : जटिल

Pronunciation: in·truh·kuht

Meaning: very complicated or detailed.

Synonyms: complex, complicated, convoluted

Antonyms: plain, simple, uncomplicated

Sentence: Police officers uncovered an intricate web of deceit.

7.PROPITIOUS (adj.) : अनुकूल

Pronunciation: pruh·pi·shuhs

Meaning: giving or indicating a good chance of success; favorable.

Synonyms: favorable, auspicious, promising

Antonyms: bleak, unlikely, unpropitious

Sentence: It was not a propitious time to start a new business.

8.DEEM (verb) : समझना

Pronunciation: deem

Meaning: regard or consider in a specified way.

Synonyms: regard as, consider, judge

Antonyms: distrust, doubt, mistrust

Sentence: I deem it advisable to buy property now.

9.UNEQUALED (adj.) : अप्रतिम

Pronunciation: uhn·ee·kvld

Meaning: superior to all others in performance or extent.

Synonyms: unbeaten, unmatched, matchless

Antonyms: inferior, lesser, common

Sentence: His power as a popular street-corner orator was probably unequaled in that generation

10.RELINQUISHED (verb) : त्याग कर दिया

Pronunciation: ruh·ling·kvuhsht

Meaning: voluntarily cease to keep or claim; give up.

Synonyms: renounce, give up, part with

Antonyms: kept, retained, withheld

Sentence: He relinquished his managerial role to become chief executive.

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
