

#### 1. ATTENUATE (verb) : कम करना

Pronunciation: at ten u ate
Meaning: reduce the force, effect, or value of.
Synonyms: weakened, reduced, lessened
Antonyms: enhance, mark up, upgrade
Sentence: Engineers began to attenuate the strength of signals at chosen frequencies

#### 2. IMPASSE (noun) : गतिरोध

Pronunciation: im·paas
Meaning: a situation in which no progress is possible, especially because of disagreement; a deadlock.
Synonyms: deadlock, dead end, stalemate
Antonyms: solution, boon, agreement
Sentence: The political process is at an impasse.

## 3. SLOVENLY (adj.) : गंदा

Pronunciation: sluh·vuhn·lee
Meaning: (especially of a person or their appearance) messy and dirty.
Synonyms: scruffy, untidy, messy
Antonyms: stainless, clean, tidy
Sentence: Their table manners perfectly reflect the <u>slovenly</u> appearance.

#### 4. SEAMLESS (adj.) : निरपराध

Pronunciation: seem · luhs
Meaning: being entirely without fault or flaw
Synonyms: absolute, faultless, flawless
Antonyms: censurable, defective, faulty
Sentence: The conductor's <u>seamless</u> interpretation of Mozart's Jupiter symphony was greeted with a standing ovation.

#### 5. SERMON (noun) : उपदेश

**Pronunciation:** suh·muhn



**Meaning:** a talk on a religious or moral subject, especially one given during a church service and based on a passage from the Bible.

Synonyms: homily, address, speech

Antonyms: commendation, pat on the back

Sentence: He delivered the <u>sermon</u> with a fiery passion.

## 6. ETIQUETTE (noun) : शिष्टाचार

**Pronunciation:** eh·tuh·kayt

**Meaning:** the customary code of polite behavior in society or among members of a particular profession or group.

Synonyms: polite behavior, good manners, manners

Antonyms: discourtesy, immorality, impoliteness.

**Sentence:** The couple exhibited poor <u>etiquette</u> when they left the party without saying goodbye to the host and hostess.

## 7. CAMARADERIE (noun) : भाई-चारा

Pronunciation: ka·muh·raa·duh·ree
Meaning: mutual trust and friendship among people who spend a lot of time together.
Synonyms: friendship, comradeship, fellowship
Antonyms: forlornness, loneliness, lonesomeness
Sentence: The <u>camaraderie</u> among fellow employees made the tedious work just bearable.

## 8. AVARICIOUS (adj.) : लालची

Pronunciation: a·vuh·rish·uhs
Meaning: having or showing extreme greed for wealth or material gain.
Synonyms: grasping, acquisitive, covetous
Antonyms: sated, satisfied, controlled
Sentence: An <u>avaricious</u> man is always needy.

### 9. CON (verb) : ठगना

Pronunciation: kawnMeaning: persuade (someone) to do or believe something, typically by use of deception.Synonyms: swindle, defraud, cheatAntonyms: undeceive, discloseSentence: Tried to <u>con</u> me into thinking that he had won the lottery.

## 10. CLUTTER (noun) : ढेरी

**Pronunciation:** kluh·tuh **Meaning:** an unorganized collection or mixture of various things



**Synonyms:** agglomerate, agglomeration, mixed bag **Antonyms:** order, organization, singularity **Sentence:** Sorry about the <u>clutter</u> in the kitchen
