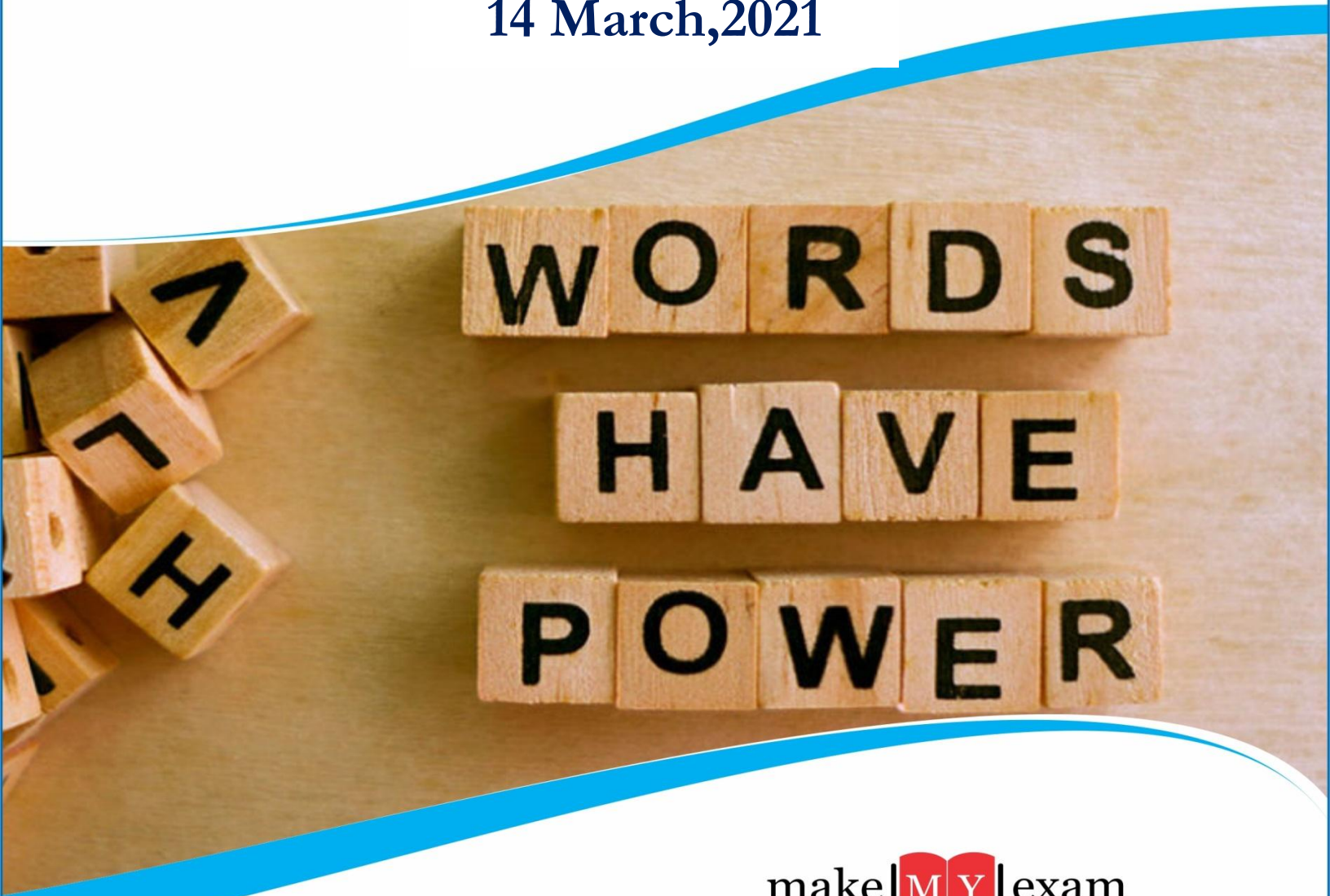


1. ELITE (noun) - विशिष्ट वर्ग

Pronunciation: uh·leet

Meaning: individuals who are viewed as the finest in a group or society

Synonyms: best, pick, nonpareil, elect, aristocracy, nobility, gentry, upper class

Antonym: ordinary

Usage: An elite group of surgeons will perform the complex surgery on the president.

2. INDISPENSABLE (adjective) – अनिवार्य

Pronunciation: in·duh·spen·suh·bl

Meaning: absolutely necessary

Synonyms: essential, crucial, necessary, key, vital

Antonyms: dispensable, inessential, secondary

Usage: Computer is indispensable to modern life.

3. ACQUITTAL (noun) – दोषमुक्ति, रिहाई

Pronunciation: uh·kwi·tl

Meaning: setting free from the charge of an offense or verdict

Synonyms: absolution, amnesty, clearance, freeing, exemption, exoneration

Antonyms: conviction, retention, denunciation

Usage: After the defendant learned of his acquittal, he jumped for joy.

4 LAUDATORY (adjective) – स्तुतिवाद, प्रशंसायुक्त

Pronunciation: law·duh·tree

Meaning: expressing praise and commendation

Synonyms: congratulatory, complimentary, acclamatory, adulatory, approbatory, approving, commendatory

Antonyms: critical, disparaging, blaming

Usage: The president issued a laudatory tweet celebrating the national's team Olympic victory.

5. ORATE (verb) – भाषण देना

Pronunciation: aw·reit

Meaning: make a speech, especially pompously or at length

Synonyms: declaim, discourse, preach, pontificate, sermonize, spiel

Antonym: whisper

Usage: It certainly is a fine thing to be able to orate.

6.POLYMATH (noun) – बहुश्रुत

Pronunciation: po·lee·math

Meaning: a person who knows a lot about many different subjects

Synonyms: accomplished, educated, scholarly, scientific, studied

Antonyms: uninformed, uneducated, inexperienced

Usage: Because she is such a polymath, Rachel seemed to know a little bit about every college subject.

7.FOREMAN (noun) – अधिकर्मी

Pronunciation: faw·muhn

Meaning: a skilled person that supervises and directs other workers or group members

Synonyms: supervisor, overseer, superintendent, manager, boss, controller, foreperson

Antonyms: employee, worker

Usage: A foreman was hired to oversee all of those working at the construction site.

8.CERTITUDE (noun) – यकीन

Pronunciation: suh·tuh·hood

Meaning: absolute certainty or conviction that something is the case

Synonyms: certainty, confidence, conviction, reliability

Antonym: doubt

Usage: The degree to which feigning certitude impressed investors.

9.DEFT (adjective) – चतुर

Pronunciation: deft

Meaning: skillful and clever

Synonyms: gile, clever, adept, adroit, ingenious, proficient, quick

Antonyms: clumsy, awkward, inept

Usage: The politician is a deft speaker who can easily convince people to believe whatever he says.

10.PRESIDE (verb) – अध्यक्षता करना

Pronunciation: pruh·zaid

Meaning: to be in charge of something as the leader

Synonyms: conduct, run, lead, guide, moderate, supervise, govern

Antonyms: follow, obey, serve

Usage: Because he was friends with the defendant, the state attorney wanted someone else to preside over the trial.
