1.INSULATION (noun): रोधन

Pronunciation:ins.yoo.lay.shn

Meaning: material used to insulate something, especially to keep heat in or out

Synonym: solitude, privacy, isolation

Antonym: Exposure, Conductivity

Sentence: The insulation in the attic helps to keep the house warm during winter.

2. IMMINENCE (noun): निकटस्थता

Pronunciation:i.muh.nuhns

Meaning: the state or fact of being about to happen

Synonym: Impending, Nearness

Antonym: Distance, Remoteness

Sentence: The imminence of the storm prompted them to cancel the outdoor event.

3.BIPOLAR (adjective): द्विध्रुवी

Pronunciation:bai.pole.uh

Meaning: having or relating to two poles or extremities

Synonym: Manic-depressive

Antonym: Stable, Unipolar

Sentence: The documentary explored the challenges individuals with bipolar disorder face in their daily lives.

4. INCUMBENT (adjective): पदधारी

Pronunciation:uhng.kuhm.bnt

Meaning: a person who is currently in an official position

Synonym: Current, Existing, present

Antonym: Former, Past, prospect

Sentence: The incumbent president faces tough competition in the upcoming election.

5.PROMINENCE (noun): शोहरत

Pronunciation:praw.muh.nuhns

Meaning: the state of being important, famous, or noticeable

Synonym: Distinction, Fame, rank

Antonym: Obscurity, Insignificance, bottom

Sentence: She came into prominence after her breakthrough role in the movie.

6. CONVULTED (adjective): जटिल

Pronunciation: kawn.vuh.loot.uhd

Meaning: extremely complex and difficult to follow

Synonym: Complicated, Intricate, involved

Antonym: Simple, Straightforward, plain

Sentence: The plot of the novel was too convoluted for casual readers.

7. ABSOLVE (verb): दोषमुक्त

Pronunciation: uhb.zawlvd

Meaning: set or declare (someone) free from blame, guilt, or responsibility

Synonym: Exonerate, Acquit, vindicate

Antonym: Condemn, Accuse, charge

Sentence: The court absolved him of all charges in the absence of solid evidence.

8. TUSSLE (noun): कशमकश

Pronunciation: tuh.sl

Meaning: a vigorous struggle or scuffle, typically in order to obtain or achieve something

Synonym: Scuffle, Fight, scrum

Antonym: Peace, Agreement, truce

Sentence: There was a brief tussle over the last piece of pizza.

9. BENEDICTION (noun): आशीर्वाद

Pronunciation: beh.nuh.dik.shn

Meaning: the utterance of a blessing, especially at the end of a religious service.

Synonyms: blessing, prayer, plea

Antonyms: curse, malediction, anathema

Sentence: she went with Maureen to Benediction.

10. ENGAGE (verb): काम पर लगाना

Pronunciation: en.gayj

Meaning: to interest or attract somebody

Synonyms: capture, catch, gain

Antonyms: bore, weary, tire

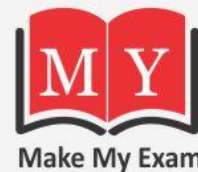
Sentence: I was forced to engage in conversation with a lot of strangers.

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
