1.PENCHANT (noun): लगन

Pronunciation: pawn.shawn

Meaning: a strong or habitual liking for something or tendency to do something

Synonym: Inclination, Predilection , tendency

Antonym: Dislike, Aversion,allergy

Sentence: He has a penchant for fine dining that keeps him searching for new restaurants.

2.PROXIES (noun): प्रतिनिधि

Pronunciation: prawk.seez

Meaning: a person authorized to act on behalf of another

Synonym: Representatives, Delegates , agent

Antonym: Principals, Opponents

Sentence: They voted through proxies at the annual shareholders' meeting.

3.VESTED (adjective): निहित

Pronunciation: vest.uhd

Meaning: secured in the possession of or assigned to a person

Synonym: Established, Conferred

Antonym: Conditional, Unsecured

Sentence: After years of service, she finally has a vested interest in the company's profit-sharing plan.

4.COMPRISE (verb): समावेश

Pronunciation: kuhm.prize

Meaning: consist of; be made up of

Synonym: Include, Encompass , consist of

Antonym: Exclude, Omit

Sentence: The committee was comprised of experts from various fields.

5. SYNDICATE (noun): संघ

Pronunciation: sin.duh.kuht

Meaning: a group of individuals or organizations combined to promote some common interest

Synonym: Clique, pack , ring

Antonym: Individual, Single, censor

Sentence: The media syndicate owns several radio stations and newspapers across the country.

6. ALLAY (verb): शांतकरना

Pronunciation: uh.lay

Meaning: diminish or put at rest (fear, suspicion, or worry)

Synonym: Reduce, Alleviate , soothe

Antonym: Aggravate, Intensify , injure

Sentence: The report helped to allay investors' fears about economic instability.

7. CONSPICUOUS (adjective): विशिष्ट

Pronunciation: kuhn.spi.kyoo.uhs

Meaning: easily seen or noticed

Synonyms: noticeable , striking , visible

Antonyms: subtle, hidden, faint

Sentence: the male, with its bright plumage, is quite conspicuous.

8. PROWESS (noun): कौशल

Pronunciation: prau.uhs

Meaning: great skill at doing something

Synonyms: courage, bravery, valor

Antonyms: timidity, softness, cowardice

Sentence: Confident in their military prowess, they preferred to try the arbitrament of war.

9. SANGUINE (adjective): आशावादी

Pronunciation: sang.gvn

Meaning: cheerful, hopeful and confident about the future

Synonyms: fierce, vicious, cruel

Antonyms: pacific, kind, benign

Sentence: he is sanguine about prospects for the global economy.

10. CHAGRIN (noun): चिढ़

Pronunciation: sha.gruhn

Meaning: a feeling of being disappointed, annoyed or humiliated

Synonyms: frustration, sadness, sorrow

Antonyms: joy, bliss, satisfaction

Sentence: He has adopted the one by the radiator, much to Tess's chagrin.

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
