

VOCABULARY

1. MAGNANIMOUS (ADJECTIVE):उदार

Pronunciation: mag•na•nuh•muhs

Meaning: generous or forgiving, especially toward a rival or less powerful person.

Synonyms: generous, charitable, benevolent

Antonyms: vicious, sordid, hateful

Sentence: He was *magnanimous* in defeat and praised his opponent's skill.

2. REFUGE (NOUN):शरण

Pronunciation: ruh•fyooj

Meaning: a condition of being safe or sheltered from pursuit, danger, or trouble.

Synonyms: shelter, sanctuary, haven

Antonyms: baffle, balk, peril

Sentence: These people are seeking/taking *refuge* from persecution.

3. INTERSTICE (NOUN):अन्तराल

Pronunciation: uhn•tuh•stuhs

Meaning: an intervening space, especially a very small one.

Synonyms: space, gap, interval

Antonyms: continuity, continuation

Sentence: The *interstices* between the bricks let in cold air.

4. MORSEL (NOUN):निवाला

Pronunciation: maw•sl

Meaning: a small piece or amount of food; a mouthful.

Synonyms: mouthful, bite, nibble

Antonyms: chunk, gob, hunk

Sentence: The prisoners ate every last *morsel*.

5. LANGUOR (NOUN):शिथिलता

Pronunciation: lang•guh

Meaning: the state or feeling, often pleasant, of tiredness or inertia.

Synonyms: lassitude, lethargy, listlessness

Antonyms: vigor, enthusiasm, vivacity

Sentence: He remembered the *languor* and warm happiness of those golden afternoons.

6. FORBORNE (VERB):रोकना

Pronunciation: faw•bawn

Meaning: politely or patiently restrain an impulse to do something; refrain.

Synonyms: refrain, abstain, desist

Antonyms: bow (to), give in (to), submit (to)

Sentence: He modestly *forbears* to include his own work.

7. LITIGANT (NOUN):विवादी

Pronunciation: li•tuh•gnt

Meaning: a person involved in a law suit.

Synonyms: litigator, opponent in law, disputant

Antonyms: friend, helper, associate

Sentence: Both *litigants* chose to represent themselves in court.

8. UNRULY (ADJECTIVE):अनियंत्रित

Pronunciation: uhn•rool•ee

Meaning: disorderly and disruptive and not amenable to discipline or control.

Synonyms: disorderly, wild, uncontrollable

Antonyms: controllable, governable, manageable

Sentence: Kate tried to control her *unruly* emotions.

9. PARRY (NOUN):बचाव

Pronunciation: pa•ree

Meaning: ward off (a weapon or attack) with a countermove.

Synonyms: ward off, fend off, stave off

Antonyms: face, deal with, encounter

Sentence: He *parried* the blow by holding his sword vertically.

10. EMBELLISH (VERB):संवारना

Pronunciation: uhm•beh•luhsh

Meaning: make (something) more attractive by the addition of decorative details or features.

Synonyms: decorate, adorn, beautify

Antonyms: blemish, deface, disfigure

Sentence: The walls of the French restaurant are *embellished* with scenes of Parisian life.
