




# **DAILY VOCAB DOSE**

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Exceptional words of English vocabulary from the newspaper 'The Hindu' are listed here. ### 1. PATRON (noun) – ग्राहक

Pronunciation: pei•truhn

**Meaning**: a customer of a shop, restaurant, etc., especially a regular one

Synonyms: sponsor, financier, customer, client, frequenter, supporter, subscriber

**Antonyms**: boycott

**Usage**: Because Laura is an avid reader, she is a frequent <u>patron</u> at my bookstore.

### 2. UPROAR (noun) - कोलाहल

**Pronunciation**: uhp•raw

Meaning: a loud and impassioned noise or disturbance

Synonyms: turmoil, disorder, confusion, chaos, commotion, disturbance, mayhem

**Antonyms**: calm, peace

**Usage**: She could hear the <u>uproar</u> in the room.

#### 3. COVET (verb) – लालच करना

Pronunciation: kuh•vuht

**Meaning:** yearn to possess something, especially something belonging to another

**Synonyms**: desire, crave, want, fancy, long for, yearn for

**Antonyms**: abhor, despise, dislike

Usage: Mr. Bruce does not covet power.

## 4. NIBBLE (noun, verb) – कुतरना

Pronunciation: ni•bl

Meaning: take small bites out of

Synonyms: bite, gnaw, peck, taste, toy with

**Antonyms**: gobble, guzzle

**Usage**:

- I felt a <u>nibble</u> on the end of my line. (noun)
- He started to nibble his biscuit. (verb)

## 5. ARTICULATE (noun, verb) – स्पष्ट; साफ़ साफ़ बोलना

**Pronunciation**: aa•ti•kyoo•leit

**Meaning**: having or showing the ability to speak fluently and coherently

Synonyms: eloquent, fluent, communicative, effective, persuasive, coherent, lucid

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Antonyms: inarticulate, hesitant

**Usage**:

- She's unusually <u>articulate</u> for a ten-year-old. (noun).
- The pupil <u>articulated</u> each word carefully. (verb)

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## 6. STINT (noun) – कार्यकाल

**Pronunciation**: stint

**Meaning**: a person's fixed or allotted period of work **Synonyms**: period, session, term, time, turn, run

Antonym: discontinuation, time off

**Usage**: Mark did a three-year <u>stint</u> in the army.

## 7. OPINE (verb) – राय देना

Pronunciation: ow-pain

Meaning: hold and state as one's opinion

Synonyms: suggest, submit, advance, propose, comment, remark

**Antonyms**: know, ascertain

**Usage**: The headmistress opined that the trip would make a nice change.

## 8. MILITATE (verb) - विरोध करना

Pronunciation: mi•luh•teit

**Meaning**: be a powerful or conclusive factor in preventing

**Synonyms**: resist, hinder, discourage, oppose, counter, foil, prejudice

Antonyms: reinforce, harmonize

**Usage**: Environmental factors <u>militate</u> against building the power station in this area.

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## 9. IMPECUNIOUS (adjective) - दरिद्र

**Pronunciation**: im•puh•kyoo•nee•uhs **Meaning**: having little or no money

Synonyms: penniless, penurious, poor, impoverished, indigent, broke

Antonyms: wealthy, rich

Usage: Since Janice grew up in an impecunious household, she knew a great deal about surviving on very

little.

## 10. EXODUS (noun) - निष्क्रमण, क्च

Pronunciation: ek•suh•duhs

Meaning: a mass departure of people

Synonyms: evacuation, leaving, exit, migration, emigration, hegira

**Antonyms**: arrival, inrush

**Usage**: There has been a mass <u>exodus</u> of workers from the villages to the towns.



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
