1.APPAREL (noun) : कपड़ा

Pronunciation: uh·pa·ruhl

Meaning: covering for the human body; as in clothing

Synonyms: clothes, attire, garments

Antonyms: underdress, undress, overdress.

Sentence: She looked lovely, despite her strange apparel.

2.UNAPOLOGETIC (adj.) : अप्राप्य

Pronunciation: uhn·uh·paw·luh·jeh·tuhk

Meaning: not acknowledging or expressing regret.

Synonyms: aggressive, insolent, belligerent

Antonyms: docile, submissive, compliant

Sentence: He was unapologetic about his remarks.

3.SNUBBING (verb) : तुच्छ समझना

Pronunciation: snuhb·uhng

Meaning: rebuff, ignore, or spurn disdainfully.

Synonyms: rejecting, isolating, repulsing

Antonyms: respecting, valuing, admiring

Sentence: He snubbed faculty members and students alike.

4.PANG (noun) : पीड़ा

Pronunciation: pang

Meaning: a sudden sharp pain or painful emotion.

Synonyms: pain, sting, discomfort

Antonyms: aid, assist, comfort

Sentence: He experienced a sudden pang of conscience.

5.QUINTESSENTIAL (adj.) : सर्वोत्कृष्ट

Pronunciation: kvin·tuh·sen·shl

Meaning: representing the most perfect or typical example of a quality or class.

Synonyms: typical, archetypal, classic

Antonyms: substandard, normal

Sentence: He was the quintessential tough guy.

6.PURPORT (noun) : अभिप्राय

Pronunciation: *purport*

Meaning: the idea that is conveyed or intended to be conveyed to the mind by language, symbol, or action

Synonyms: meaning, sense, intent

Antonyms: deny, negative, reject

Sentence: I do not understand the purport of your remarks.

7.BUGBEAR (noun) : डरावना

Pronunciation: buhg·beuh

Meaning: something or someone that causes fear or dread especially without reason

Synonyms: dread, bogey, terror,

Antonyms: bravery, calmness, courage, ease.

Sentence: Communism was once the nation's biggest bugbear.

8.AWHILE (adv.) : कुछ समय

Pronunciation: uh·vile

Meaning: for a short time.

Synonyms: for a moment, for a while, for a bit

Antonyms: endless, unending

Sentence: Stay awhile and rest.

9.PESTILENT (adj.) : विनाशक

Pronunciation: peh·stuh·luhnt

Meaning: likely to cause or capable of causing death

Synonyms: lethal, deadly, harmful

Antonyms: salubrious, beneficial, salutary

Sentence: Smallpox is a pestilent disease.

10.BOOMERANGED (verb): प्रतिक्रम

Pronunciation: boo·muh·rangd

Meaning: (of a plan or action) return to the originator, often with negative consequences.

Synonyms: reverse, rebound, backfired

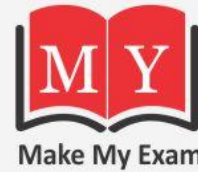
Antonyms: succeeded, flourished

Sentence: The plan boomeranged when they were trapped instead of their victim.
