1. REPROACH (verb) : तिरस्कार

Pronunciation: ruh.proche

Meaning: to tell somebody that he/she has done something wrong; to blame somebody

Synonyms : rebuke , rproof , scolding

Antonyms: honor , glory , boast

Sentence: she gave me a look of reproach.

2. INEFFABLE(adj) : अकथ

Pronunciation:uh.neh.fuh.bl

Meaning: too beautiful, great, etc. to describe in words

Synonyms: untold, undefinable , unheard of

Antonyms: communicable , definable , speakable

Sentence : This 'philosophy' replaces the ineffable mystery of God with the ineffable mystery of consciousness.

3. INDOLENT(adj) : आलसी

Pronunciation: in.duh.luhnt

Meaning: not wanting to work; lazy

Synonyms: lazy, idle, torpid

Antonyms: active, energetic, diligent

Sentence: they were too indolent to work when it was hot.

4. PIETY(noun) : शील

Pronunciation: pai.uh.tee

Meaning: a way of behaving that shows a deep respect for God and religion

Synonyms: religion , holiness, sanctity

Antonyms: unbelief, apostasy , lapse

Sentence: Independent political inactivity now went hand in hand with religious quietism and piety.

5. PERTINENT(adj) : उचित

Pronunciation: puh.ti.nent

Meaning: closely connected with the subject being discussed

Synonyms: fit, apt, apropos

Antonyms: little, pointless, trivial

Sentence: it is a pertinent question and one that demands an answer.

6. RESOLUTION(noun) : संकल्प

Pronunciation: reh.zuh.loo.shn

Meaning: a formal statement of decision or opinion

Synonyms: intention, promise, undertaking

Antonyms: tie, draw, halt

Sentence: There was a dispute at the meeting so the resolution was never passed.

7. PRECIPICE(noun): करारा

Pronunciation: preh.suh.puhs

Meaning: a very steep side of a high mountain or cliff

Synonyms: sheer drop, crag, bluff

Antonyms: slope, trough, bottom

Sentence: We stand on the edge of a precipice, staring into the void.

8. INEXORABLE(adj) : निष्ठुर

Pronunciation: uhn.ek.suh.ruh.bl

Meaning: impossible to stop or prevent.

Synonyms: steady, non-stop, continuous

Antonyms: unlikely, uncertain, avoidable

Sentence: Something has got to be done to stop this inexorable rise in expenditure.

9. RESUME(verb) : फिर शुरू करना

Pronunciation: resume

Meaning: to begin again or continue after a pause or interruption

Synonyms: restart, return to, reopen

Antonyms: suspend, abandon, leave

Sentence: he wanted a résumé of the day's events.

10. INDURATE(verb) : कड़ा हो जाना

Pronunciation: in.doo.reyt

Meaning: harden

Synonyms: solid, firm, thick

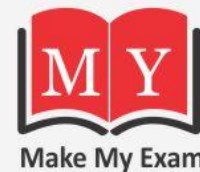
Antonyms: soft, thin, elastic

Sentence: The block was found to consist of an indurated limestone.
