


1. OBSOLETE (adj.) : पुराना

Pronunciation: awb·suh·leet

Meaning: no longer produced or used; out of date.

Synonyms: out of date, outdated, outmoded

Antonyms: new-fashioned, modern, recent

Sentence: Gas lamps became obsolete when electric lighting was invented.

2. OUTSKIRTS (noun) : उपनगर

Pronunciation: awt·skuhts

Meaning: the outer parts of a town or city.

Synonyms: outlying districts, purlieu, suburb

Antonyms: inner city, midtown

Sentence: They live on the outskirts of Bangalore.

3. TACTLESS (adj.) : उद्दंड

Pronunciation: takt·luhs

Meaning: having or showing a lack of adroitness and sensitivity in dealing with others or with difficult issues.

Synonyms: insensitive, inconsiderate, thoughtless

Antonyms: judicious, prudent, tactful

Sentence: His tactless words had incurred his father's deep displeasure.

4. BIVOUAC (noun) : शिविर

Pronunciation: bi·voo·ak

Meaning: a temporary camp without tents or cover, used especially by soldiers or mountaineers.

Synonyms: tent, encamp, cantonment

Antonyms: tasteful, dead, inanimate

Sentence: Soldiers setting up a bivouac by the stream.

5. CONCOMITANT (adj.) : सहगामी

Pronunciation: kuhng·kaw·muh·tnt

Meaning: naturally accompanying or associated.

Synonyms: attendant, accompanying, associated

Antonyms: unrelated, unconnected

Sentence: Any increase in students meant a concomitant increase in funding.

6. INANE (adj.) : मूर्खतापूर्ण

Pronunciation: uh·nayn

Meaning: having or showing a lack of common sense or judgment; absurd and foolish

Synonyms: silly, foolish, stupid

Antonyms: meaningful, significant, eloquent

Sentence: Penny began an inane conversation about the book she was reading to fill the silence.

7. ELEVENTH HOUR (noun) : अंतिम क्षण

Pronunciation: ELEVENTH HOUR

Meaning: the latest possible time

Synonyms: last minute, zero-hour, last moment

Antonyms: punctual, early, delayed

Sentence: He postponed his trip at the eleventh hour.

8. CONVIVIALITY (noun) : प्रफुल्लता

Pronunciation: kuhn·vi·vee·al·uh·tee

Meaning: the quality of being friendly and lively; friendliness.

Synonyms: friendliness, geniality, affability

Antonyms: misery, grief, mourning

Sentence: Gatherings of friends bring joy with conviviality and celebration.

9. GUILE (noun) : छल

Pronunciation: gile

Meaning: the inclination or practice of misleading others through lies or trickery

Synonyms: deception, cunning, slyness

Antonyms: sincerity, guilelessness, ingenuousness

Sentence: With a little guile he might get what he wanted.

10. ABORTIVE (adj.) : निष्फल

Pronunciation: uh·bawt·uhv

Meaning: failing to produce the intended result.

Synonyms: failed, unsuccessful, futile

Antonyms: effective, effectual, efficacious

Sentence: He made an abortive attempt to recover the sunken pirate ship.
