

1.BALMY (adj.) : शान्तिदायक

Pronunciation: balm⋅y
Meaning: (of the weather) pleasantly warm.
Synonyms: calm, tranquil, gentle
Antonyms: harsh, wintry
Sentence: It is easy to be blinded by the brilliance of that balmy Melbourne night.

2.OBLIVION (noun) : विस्मरण

Pronunciation: uh·bli·vee·uhn
Meaning: the state of being unaware or unconscious of what is happening.
Synonyms: unconsciousness, insensibility, stupor
Antonyms: consciousness, awareness
Sentence: Alcoholics often suffer from periods of <u>oblivion</u>.

3.MORPH (verb) : परिवर्तन

Pronunciation: mawf
Meaning: to take on a different shape, appearance, or state
Synonyms: transform, change, transfigure
Antonyms: maintain, stagnate, keep
Sentence: When it emerged from its chrysalis, the caterpillar had morphed into a striking butterfly.

4.ENVISION (verb) : कल्पना करना

Pronunciation: uhn·vi·zhn
Meaning: imagine as a future possibility; visualize.
Synonyms: visualize, imagine, envisage
Antonyms: disregard, ignore, look away
Sentence: They didn't <u>envision</u> any problems with the new building.

5.SURREPTITIOUS (adj.) : छल से किया हुआ

Pronunciation: suh·ruhp·ti·shuhs
Meaning: kept secret, especially because it would not be approved of.
Synonyms: secret, stealthy, clandestine
Antonyms: overt, public, open
Sentence: She carried out a surreptitious search of his belongings.



6.PERENNIALLY (adv.) : निरंतर

Pronunciation: puh·reh·nee·uhl·ee
Meaning: in a way that continues for a long or apparently infinite time; permanently.
Synonyms: long, enduringly, perpetually
Antonyms: never, once, nevermore
Sentence: Both services are <u>perennially</u> short of staff.

7.GALE (noun) : आंधी

Pronunciation: galeMeaning: a very strong wind.Synonyms: storm, hurricane, windstormAntonyms : calmSentence: It was blowing a gale outside.

8.LINEAGE (noun) : वंशावली

Pronunciation: li•nee•uhj
Meaning: lineal descent from an ancestor; ancestry or pedigree.
Synonyms: ancestry, parentage, pedigree
Antonyms: progeny, seed
Sentence: She's very proud of her ancient royal <u>lineage</u>.

9.THEREIN (adv.) : यहां

Pronunciation: dheuh·rinMeaning: in that place, document, or respect.Synonyms: here, hither, thereAntonyms: out, after allSentence: It shall be sufficient evidence of the facts <u>therein</u> contained.

10.HELTER-SKELTER (adj.): अस्त व्यस्त

Pronunciation: helter-skelter
Meaning: acting or done with excessive or careless speed
Synonyms: hurried, rushed, hasty
Antonyms: unhurried, deliberate, unrushed
Sentence: They ran away <u>helter-skelter</u>, but the police gained ground upon them.
