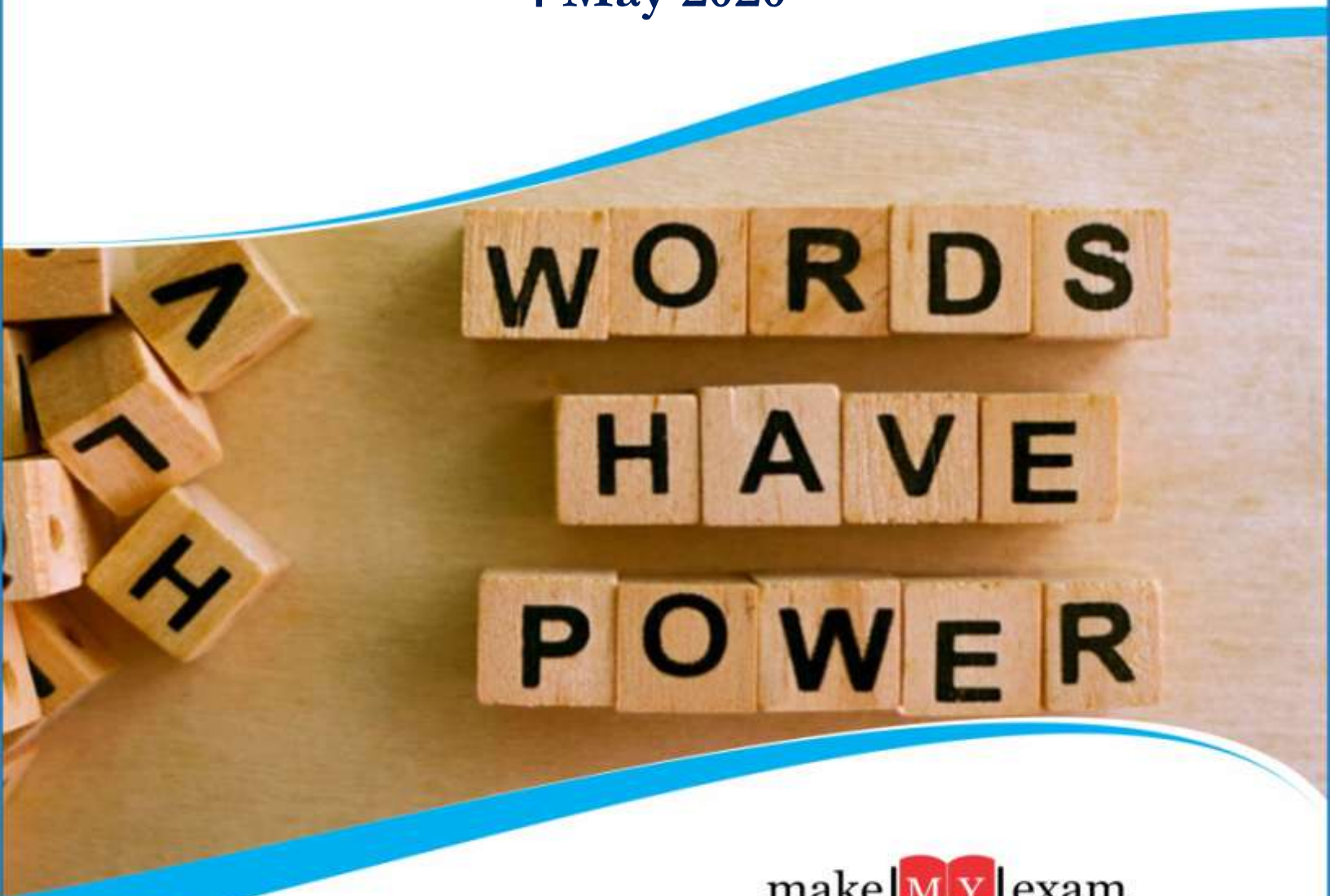

1. FRINGE (noun, verb) – किनारा

Pronunciation: frinj

Meaning: the outer, marginal, or extreme part of an area, group, or sphere of activity; form a border around something

Synonyms: border, borderline, margin, rim, edge, extremity, limit, limits, borders, bounds, outskirts

Antonyms: mainstream, middle

Usage:

There house is there on the fringe of an enormous field. (noun)

Wild flowers fringed the river. (verb)

2. HARD LINE (adjective) – कठोर, कड़ा

Pronunciation: haad-lain

Meaning: uncompromising; strict

Synonyms: diehard, extreme, tough, inflexible, immoderate, intransigent, intractable, unyielding, undeviating

Antonym: moderate

Usage: The president has taken a hardline action against abortion.

3. INCLEMENT (adjective) – ठंडा या गीला मौसम

Pronunciation: inklem(u)nt

Meaning: unpleasantly cold or wet weather

Synonyms: chilly, wintry, freezing, snowy, icy, rainy, drizzly, damp, stormy

Antonyms: fine, mild, sunny

Usage: Predictions of inclement weather proved to be wrong

4. ABASE (verb) – अपमानित करना, मानहानि करना

Pronunciation: ub-eis

Meaning: behave in a way that belittles or degrades someone

Synonyms: humiliate, belittle, demean, lower, degrade, disgrace

Usage: He has abased himself by stealing from a poor old woman.

5. INCORRIGIBLE (adjective, noun) – असुधार्य

Pronunciation: in-korijib(u)l

Meaning: (of a person or their behaviour) not able to be changed or reformed; an incorrigible person

Synonyms: inveterate, habitual, unreformable, irreformable

Antonyms: corrigible

Usage: His dark soul was too incorrigible to feel sorry about his wrongdoing, even at his execution.

6. WARMONGER (noun) – जंगबाज़, युद्ध की आग भड़कानेवाला

Pronunciation: wo-munguh

Meaning: a person who encourages or advocates aggression towards other countries or groups

Synonyms: militarist, hawk, aggressor, belligerent

Antonym: pacifist

Usage: We are not warmongers, but freedom fighters.

7. LINEAMENT (noun) – विशेष मुख रेखाएँ

Pronunciation: lini-um(u)nt

Meaning: a distinctive feature or characteristic, especially of the face

Synonyms: features, properties, traits, outline, lines, contours, configuration

Usage: For comedic effect, the sketch artist exaggerated each lineament of our faces.

Pronunciation: monuh-theez(u)m

Meaning: the doctrine or belief that there is only one God

Synonym: deism

Antonyms: polytheism, pantheism

Usage: Christianity centers on the concept of monotheism, the view there is only one higher power.**9. STIFLE (verb) – दम घुटना; रोकना; दबाना**

Pronunciation: stai-f(u)l

Meaning: make (someone) unable to breathe properly; restrain a reaction or stop acting on an emotion; prevent an activity or idea

Synonyms: suffocate, choke, asphyxiate; suppress, smother, keep back, hold back; hinder, hamper, impede, curb

Antonyms: let out; encourage, promote

Usage:

Those in the streets were stifled by the poisonous gas.She managed to stifle her yawn.They hope the new rules will not stifle creativity.**10. INCORPOREAL (adjective) – अमूर्त, निराकार, अशरीरी, अभौतिक**

Pronunciation: inko-po-ri-ul

Meaning: not composed of matter; having no material existence

Synonyms: intangible, impalpable, non-material, non-physical, bodiless

Antonyms: corporeal, tangible

Usage: Plato, an ancient Greek philosopher, demonstrated the incorporeal nature of the soul.
