1. Mega Industrial Exhibition 'Engiexpo 2020' to be held in Vadodara, Gujarat.

- In a bid to promote 'Made in India' products, the Federation of Small Scale Industries (FSSI) will organise a mega industrial exhibition 'Engiexpo 2020' in Vadodara, Gujarat from February 15.
- Over 10,000 industrial products will be showcased in more than 300 stalls at the sixth edition of the exhibition.
- The exhibition will showcase various products, including weighing, welding and cutting tools, products related to construction work, electronic and solar items, and packaging material. Several companies from Uzbekistan have also shown their interest in participating in the exhibition.

2. MP Governor Lalji Tandon inaugurates Hunar Haat in Indore.

- Madhya Pradesh Governor Lalji Tandon inaugurated Hunar Haat in Indore. Hunar Haat is being organised till 16th February.

- Organised for the first time in the state, the festival has been organised with twin goals in sightconservation of Hornbill and to boost the livelihood of the people through tourism.
- Nagaland celebrates Hornbill Festival in December every year to mark their conservation efforts for the species.
- While Nagaland's Kisama village is known for conserving hornbill birds, the local community of Tripura's Baramura Hills also has a traditional culture of conserving these birds.

5. BSNL, Air India, MTNL highest loss-making PSUs in FY19; ONGC most profitable: Survey

- ONGC, Indian Oil Corporation and NTPC were the top three profitable PSUs in 2018-19, whereas BSNL, Air India and MTNL incurred highest losses for a third consecutive year, according to a survey tabled in Parliament.
- The top three profit making PSUs including Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC), Indian Oil Corporation and NTPC contributed 15.3 per cent, 9.68 per cent and 6.73 per cent, respectively to the total profit earned by all profitable CPSEs.
- Total income of all CPSEs during 2018-19 stood at Rs 24,40,748 crore compared to Rs 20,32,001 crore in 2017-18, showing a growth of 20.12 per cent.

6. Kerala to host global meet on climate change, ocean health.

- ClimFishCon 2020, a three-day international conference on the impact of climate change on 'hydrological cycle, ecosystem, fisheries and food security' will begin in Kerala on 12 February.
- More than 300 delegates from 12 countries including scientists, researchers, administrators, policymakers, academicians, and entrepreneurs will participate in the event.
- Fishers, aqua farmers, students and other stakeholders will also attend.
- The conference is organised jointly by the CUSAT School of Industrial Fisheries and the Department of Fisheries, Kerala.

7. India stands 17th on a list of countries at risk of importing coronavirus.

- According to a mathematical model for the expected global spread of the coronavirus developed by the researchers at Germany's Humboldt University and Robert Koch Institute, India is at number 17 on the list of countries at risk of importing novel coronavirus (nCoV) that originated in China's Wuhan area in December 2019.
- The top 5 countries at risk of importing coronavirus cases include: Thailand, Japan, South Korea, Hong Kong, Taiwan, USA (United States of America).
- The "relative import risk" for India was found to be 0.219 %, while for Thailand it is 2.1 %. So far 3 coronavirus infections have been reported in India. All three patients are in Kerala. In terms of Indian airports, the status of Indira Gandhi International Airport in New Delhi is the most dangerous. It is followed by number of airports such as Mumbai, Kolkata, Bengaluru, Chennai, Hyderabad and Kochi.

8. Haryana Government launched 'Reading Mission' to promote reading habits among students.

- Kanwar Pal, Haryana education minister, launched 'Reading Mission- Haryana' to inculcate reading habits among students.
- The mission has been launched based on the Central Government's "Reading Mission -2022" & aims to address the lost glory of reading books.
- Book review sessions will be organized by students once a month in educational institutions & 45 minute mass- reading programme will be held on 4th saturday of every month.

- The act makes the registration of submersible pumps mandatory. The farmers and domestic users need not pay fees to use the pumps. The act makes rain water harvesting mandatory in all private schools, colleges.
- It also penalizes persons polluting ground water through boring pipes. Also, it is mandatory for the boring companies to register under the act. The companies have to update their information every three months.

15. IRCTC starts booking of ticket for third corporate train "Kashi Mahakal" Express.

- Indian Railway's PSU IRCTC has started booking tickets for the third corporate train Kashi Mahakal Express. This train will run between Varanasi and Indore.

- The announcement was made by the Ministry of External Affairs on the eve of the birth anniversary of Mrs Swaraj. During her four decade long career, Sushma Swaraj was elected to the Lok Sabha four times and thrice to Rajya Sabha.
- She served as Minister for External Affairs, Information and Broadcasting, Parliamentary Affairs, Health and Family Welfare. She also served as Leader of Opposition in the Lower House.

18. Aviation security regulator BCAS has banned e-cigarettes on flights and airports.

- India's Aviation security regulator BCAS has announced the ban on e-cigarettes in both domestic and international flights and at airports.
- BCAS in a circular said that e-cigarettes will not be allowed in both domestic and international flights as well as at airports. It also proposed a jail term for offenders up to one year and a fine of Rs 1 lakh.
- In September last year, the Central government banned production, sale and import of e-cigarettes and similar products citing health risk to people, especially the youth.

1. India to host COP13 UN Summit on conservation of migratory birds from Feb 17.

- The 13th Conference of Parties (COP) of the Convention on the Conservation of Migratory Species of Wild Animals (CMS), is going to be hosted by India during 17 to 22 February at Gandhinagar, Gujarat.
- As the host, India shall be designated the President for the next three years. The Government of India is Signatory to the Convention on Conservation of Migratory Wild Animals since 1983.
- The theme of CMS COP13 in India is, "Migratory species connect the planet and we welcome them home". The CMS COP 13 logo is inspired by 'Kolam', a traditional artform from southern India.
- The mascot for CMS COP13, "Gibi The Great Indian Bustard" is a critically endangered species which has been accorded the highest protection status under the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972.

2. African Union summit held in Addis Ababa.

- The 33rd African Union (AU) summit was held in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. The theme of the summit was "Silencing the Guns: Creating conducive conditions for Africa's development".
- The summit highlighted three challenges namely eradicating poverty, tackling the climate crisis and silencing guns in Africa.
- The Democratic Republic of the Congo will replace South Africa as AU chair in 2021. The African Union is a continental union consisting of 55 member states located on the continent of Africa.

After the reshuffle, three Indian origin Members of Parliament are now a part of Britain's most diverse cabinet led by UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson.
- The 47-year-old Priti Patel has been appointed as the Home Minister. The 51-year-old Alok Sharma has been appointed as the Business Secretary in the British Cabinet. Along with these three, 15 Indian-origin MPs are among 65 non-whites elected to the new 650-member House of Commons, reflecting 10 percent of its strength.

7. MakeMyTrip founder Kalra steps down as group CEO, Magow to take over

- **U** Deep Kalra, group chief executive of Nasdaq-listed MakeMyTrip, has stepped down.

8. Former India all-rounder "Robin Singh" appointed as UAE's Director of Cricket

- Former India all-rounder Robin Singh was appointed director of cricket of the United Arab Emirates. The 56-year-old's appointment comes following the sacking of Dougie Brown as head coach.
- Singh, who had represented India in one Test and 136 ODIs between 1989 and 2001, has over the years made a name for himself in coaching.
- He was associated with the Indian Premier League's highly successful Mumbai Indians franchise, Caribbean Premier League's Barbados Tridents since 2013 and T10 franchises in the T10 league here.

1. PFRDA doubles minimum net worth for pension fund managers to Rs 50 cr from Rs 25 cr.

- The Pension Fund Regulatory and Development Authority (PFRDA), the regulator of the National Pension System (NPS), has doubled the minimum net worth criterion for pension fund managers to 50 crore from the 25 crore stipulated earlier. Now, pension funds are on par with mutual funds which have to meet a minimum net worth requirement of ₹50 crores, under SEBI (Securities and Exchange Board of India) rules.
- Provision has also been made for licenses to have indefinite validity. Earlier, the licenses of pension fund managers were granted for a period of 5 years. But now, the license will remain valid until cancelled by the regulator.
- A pension fund or its sponsor cannot acquire equity stake in another pension fund. Existing pension funds that have such cross holdings can continue with the same but cannot increase them without the permission of the regulator.

2. Padma Shri awardee fashion designer, Wendell Rodricks passed away


