



### 1. Government Appoints Former Finance Secretary Ajay Seth as IRDAI Chief

- **Current Role**: Ajay Seth is currently serving as the Finance Secretary in the Ministry of Finance, Department of Economic Affairs.
- **Experience**: He has over three decades of experience in shaping India's economic policies and spearheading financial reforms, notably leading infrastructure financing and public-private partnerships.



- **IRDAI Appointment**: Seth is emerging as a frontrunner for the IRDAI Chairman position, given his experience and expertise, although a final decision is yet to be announced by the government.

- **AI Investments**: Under Pichai's leadership, Alphabet has invested heavily in AI infrastructure, spending nearly \$50 billion in 2023 alone, and raising its 2025 capital expenditure forecast by \$10 billion to \$85 billion.

# 3. Vikramaditya Chaufla named captain of the Indian squad for the World Racketlon Championship

- Leadership Role: Vikramaditya Chaufla has been named captain of the Indian squad for the World Racketlon Championship, showcasing his leadership skills and expertise in the sport.
- Experience: Chaufla is a former badminton player with significant experience, having led the Indian team at last year's World Championship and winning a silver medal in the individual category in 2022.

### 4. DRDO Successfully Test-Fires Drone-Launched Missile ULPGM-V3

- Successful Test-Firing: The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully conducted flight trials of the UAV-Launched Precision Guided Missile (ULPGM)-V3 at the National Open Area Range (NOAR) in Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh.
- **Precision Strike Capability**: The ULPGM-V3 is designed for high-precision strikes from unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), enhancing India's defence capabilities with advanced indigenous technologies.







- Advanced Features: The missile features imaging infrared (IIR) seekers for advanced target acquisition, dual-thrust propulsion systems for extended range and speed, and lightweight construction for compatibility with various UAVs.
- **Industry Partnership**: The project showcases India's growing defence-industrial ecosystem, with private players, MSMEs, and start-ups working alongside DRDO, highlighting the nation's progress towards self-reliance in critical defence technologies.

### 5. BCCI to host Asia Cup in UAE in Sept

- **Tournament Venue**: The Asia Cup 2025 will be held in the United Arab Emirates (UAE), with India likely to play its matches in Dubai and Abu Dhabi.
- **Tournament Dates:** The tournament is scheduled to take place from September 5 to 21, spanning over 17 days.



- India-Pakistan Clash: India and Pakistan are likely to be drawn into the same group, potentially facing each other three times in the group stage, Super Four, and possibly the final.
- **Tournament Format**: The Asia Cup will be in the T20 format, aligning with the upcoming ICC World Cup, set to be held in India and Sri Lanka in February 2026.
- **Participating Teams:** Eight teams are expected to participate in the tournament, which will serve as a preparatory event for the T20 World Cup.

#### 9. ICAR-SBI Coimbatore bags national award

 Award Details: The ICAR-Sugarcane Breeding Institute (SBI) in Coimbatore has been conferred with the prestigious Rashtriya Krishi Vigyan Puraskar 2025 for Innovation & Technology in Agriculture & Allied Sciences.



- Soil Moisture Indicator: The award-winning team developed the Soil Moisture Indicator (SMI), a portable device that optimizes irrigation by monitoring soil moisture using electrical conductivity principles.
- Water Conservation: SMI-based irrigation has shown a 15% reduction in water use while increasing sugarcane yields from 55.8 to 60.4 tonnes per acre per year.
- **Team Members**: The award-winning team consists of scientists K Hari, D Puthira Prathap, P Murali, A Rameshsundar, and B Singaravelu.
- **Impact**: The SMI is priced at Rs 2,000 and has been integrated into national farming guidelines and subsidy programs, benefiting farmers across the country.

### 10. Hulk Hogan, WWE Icon and Global Pop Culture Phenomenon, passed away

- **Hulk Hogan's Death**: WWE legend Hulk Hogan passed away at 71 after suffering a cardiac arrest at his Clearwater, Florida home on July 24.
