

1.GRAPPLED(Verb): हाथापाई करना

Pronunciation:gra·pld

Meaning: to get hold of somebody/something and fight with or try to control him/her/it.

Synonyms: Confront, battle, duel **Antonyms:** Released, relinquishment

Sentence: He briefly grappled with the police officer.

2.VICARIOUS(Adjective) : परोक्ष तौर पर

Pronunciation: vuh·keuh·ree·uhs.lee

Meaning: in a way that is experienced in the imagination through the actions of another

person.

Synonyms: Empathetic

Antonyms: Primary, Unaffected

Sentence: Lots of people use television as their vicarious form of social life.

3.EXHAUSTIVE(Adjective) : संपूर्ण

Pronunciation: uhg·zawst·uhv

Meaning: Complete and including everything

Synonyms: Encyclopedic, Comprehensive, thorough

Antonyms: Incomplete, narrow, limited

Sentence: An <u>exhaustive</u> comparison is outside the scope of the paper.

4.PROBE(Verb) : जांच

Pronunciation: probe

Meaning: to examine or look for something, especially with a long thin instrument.

Synonyms: Inquiry, Scrutiny, study

Antonyms: Abstain

Sentence: Investigators are <u>probing</u> into new evidence in the case.

5.UTTERANCES(Noun) : उच्चारणों

Pronunciation: uh·tuh·ruhns·uhz
Meaning: Something that someone says

Synonyms: voice ,expression,formulation

Antonyms: listening, quiet

Sentence: His <u>utterance</u> was interrupted by frequent coughing.

6.TORT(Noun): अपकार

Pronunciation: tawt

Meaning: A wrongful act, not including a breach of contract or trust that results in injury

to another's person, property, reputation

Synonyms: Atrocity, Felony

Antonyms: Kindness

Sentence: It was a tort on the part of the lawyer to give a verdict.

7.TIGHT-LIPPED(Adjective) : अल्पभाषी

Pronunciation: tite-lipt

Meaning: Refusing to comment on something **Synonyms:** Reticent, Unresponsive, taciturn **Antonyms:** Outspoken, Talkative, vocal

Sentence: He was sitting at the other end of the table, <u>tight-lipped</u> and angry.

8.PERPETRATORS(Noun): अपराधियों

Pronunciation: puh·puh·trayt·uhz

Meaning: A person who carries out a harmful, illegal, or immoral act

Synonyms: Offender, Criminal, perps

Antonyms: Victim, Sufferer

Sentence: The perpetrators of this heinous crime must be found and punished to the fullest

extent of the law.

9.BARGED(Verb): घुसे

Pronunciation: baajd

Meaning: Interrupt by entering suddenly and noisily.

Synonyms : Jostle, force, push **Antonyms :** glided , slid, whisked

Sentence: They <u>barged</u> through the crowds.

10.IMPROVISED(Adjective) : कामचलाऊ

Pronunciation:im·pruh·vized



Meaning: to make, do, or manage something without preparation, using what you have.

Synonyms: Extemporize, Impromptu, ad lib **Antonyms:** Rehearsed, Planned, considered

Sentence: He had to <u>improvise</u> his opening speech when he forgot his notes.
