

#### 1. DISSEMINATE (verb) : प्रसार

Pronunciation: duh-seh-muh-nayt

**Meaning:** spread (something, especially information) widely.

**Synonyms:** spread, circulate, distribute **Antonyms:** conceal, enshroud, hide

Sentence: Health authorities should foster good practice by disseminating information.

## 2. OBTRUDE (verb) : हस्तक्षेप करना

Pronunciation: uhb•trood

**Meaning:** become noticeable in an unwelcome or intrusive way.

**Synonyms:** intrude, meddle, interfere **Antonyms:** disregard, ignore, neglect

Sentence: I don't want to obtrude upon her privacy.

## 3. QUANTIFIABLE (adj.) : मात्रात्मक

Pronunciation: kvawn•tuh•fai•uh•bl

Meaning: able to be expressed or measured as a quantity.

Synonyms: calculate, cipher, compute

Antonyms: imperceptible, insignificant, undeterminable.

**Sentence:** The number of websites on the Internet is not <u>quantifiable</u>.

## 4. PROGNOSTICATING (verb) : भविष्यसूचक

Pronunciation: prawg•naw•stuhk•ayt•uhng

**Meaning:** foretell or prophesy (an event in the future).

**Synonyms:** forecast, predict, prophesy **Antonyms:** describe, narrate, recite

**Sentence:** Using current trends to <u>prognosticate</u> what the workplace of the future will be

like.

## 5. TOPPLE (verb) : गिर पड़ना

Pronunciation: taw-pl

**Meaning:** overbalance or become unsteady and fall slowly.

Synonyms: fall, tumble, overturn

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Antonyms: get up, rise, stand

**Sentence:** A stack of plates swayed and began to <u>topple</u> over.

## 6. SUFFICED (verb) : पर्याप्त

Pronunciation: suh-fiset

**Meaning:** be enough or adequate.

**Synonyms:** be enough, be sufficient, be adequate

**Antonyms:** inadequately, insufficiently

**Sentence:** One warning <u>sufficed</u> to stop her from doing it.

## 7. CONTRITE (adj.) : पछताया हुआ

Pronunciation: kuhn•trite

Meaning: feeling or expressing remorse or penitence; affected by guilt.

Synonyms: remorseful, repentant, penitent

Antonyms: impenitent, remorseless, unapologetic

**Sentence:** She was <u>contrite</u> the morning after her angry outburst.

## 8. CONCOCTED (verb) : मनगढ़ंत

Pronunciation: kuhng•kawkt•uhd

**Meaning:** existing only in the imagination. **Synonyms:** artificial, fabricated, imaginary

Antonyms: genuine, natural, real

Sentence: John concocted an elaborate excuse for being late.

## 9. ACCREDITATION (noun) : प्राधिकार

Pronunciation: uh•kreh•duht•ay•shn

Meaning: the granting of power to perform various acts or duties

Synonyms: authorization, delegation, empowerment

Antonyms: prohibition, refusal, veto

**Sentence:** The only body empowered with the <u>accreditation</u> of medical schools in the state.

## 10. FORLORN (adj.): अनाथ

Pronunciation: fuh•lawn

Meaning: pitifully sad and abandoned or lonely.


Synonyms: unhappy, sad, miserable

Antonyms: cheerful, accompanied, hopeful

**Sentence:** She was <u>forlorn</u> when she found out the trip had been canceled.

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
