




DAILY VOCAB DOSE

1. FUDGING (verb) : हेरफेर

Pronunciation: fuhj·uhng

Meaning: present or deal with (something) in a vague, noncommittal, or inadequate way,

especially so as to conceal the truth or mislead.

Synonyms: evade, dodge, shuffle

Antonyms: clarifying, explaining, illustrating

Sentence: Fudging the numbers on an expense report might be considered fraud in some

circles.

2. FRITTERING (verb) : व्यर्थ नष्ट करना

Pronunciation: fri·tuh·ruhng

Meaning: waste time, money, or energy on trifling matters.

Synonyms: squander, waste, misspend **Antonyms:** penurious, acquisitive

Sentence: I seem to fritter my time away in coffee mornings.

3. PROMULGATE (verb) : घोषणा करना

Pronunciation: praw·muhl·gayt

Meaning: promote or make widely known

Synonyms: make known, make public, publicize

Antonyms: silence, suppress, criticize

Sentence: The actor makes use of social media to promulgate the release of his film

projects.

4. AVARICE (noun) : लोभ

Pronunciation: a · vuh · ruhs

Meaning: extreme greed for wealth or material gain.

Synonyms: greed, acquisitiveness, cupidity

Antonyms: fulfillment, satisfaction, selflessness

Sentence: <u>Avarice</u> blinds our eyes.

5. CHAGRIN (verb) : चिढ़ाना

Pronunciation: sha·gruhn

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Meaning: feel distressed or humiliated. **Synonyms:** annoyed, irritated, irked

Antonyms: felicity, gladness

Sentence: He was <u>chagrined</u> when his friend poured scorn on him.

6. FERVOR (adj.) : जोश

Pronunciation: fuh · vuh

Meaning: intense and passionate feeling.

Synonyms: passion, ardor, zeal

Antonyms: impassiveness, impassivity, aloofness **Sentence:** The speech aroused nationalist fervor.

7. CONSONANCE (noun) : समझौता

Pronunciation: kawn·suh·nuhns

Meaning: agreement or compatibility between opinions or actions.

Synonyms: agreement, concord, accord

Antonyms: discordance, conflict, disagreement

Sentence: This type of democracy is in <u>consonance</u> with our own African heritage.

8. THAW (verb) : पिघलना

Pronunciation: thaw

Meaning: (of ice, snow, or another frozen substance, such as food) become liquid or soft

as a result of warming.

Synonyms: liquefy, melt, fuse **Antonyms:** harden, set, solidify

Sentence: The snow started to <u>thaw</u> as the temperature kept up.

9. EXPLICABLE (adj.) : समझाने के योग्य

Pronunciation: uhk·spli·kuh·bl

Meaning: able to be accounted for or understood. **Synonyms:** explainable, interpretable, definable **Antonyms:** inexplicable, insoluble, insolvable

Sentence: The sudden increase in sales is easily <u>explicable</u>.

10. FANATICAL (adj.) : কছৰ

Pronunciation: fuh·na·tuhk·uhl

Meaning: filled with excessive and single-minded zeal.

Synonyms: zealous, extremist, rabid

Antonyms: nonmilitant, nonrevolutionary, liberal

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Sentence: As a boy, he was a <u>fanatical</u> patriot.



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
