

### 1.DESTITUTE (adj.): निराश्रित

Pronunciation: deh-stuh-tyoot

**Meaning:** lacking money or material possessions **Synonyms:** penniless, penurious, pauperized **Antonyms:** affluent, prosperous, opulent

**Sentence:** The floods left thousands of people destitute.

#### 2.PANEGYRIC (noun): प्रशंसात्मक

**Pronunciation:** pa·nuh·ji·ruhk

Meaning: a public speech or published text in praise of someone or something.

Synonyms: accolade, citation, commendation

Antonyms: admonition, harangue

**Sentence:** She delivered a <u>panegyric</u> on the President-elect.

# 3.RETRIBUTION (noun): प्रतिदण्ड

**Pronunciation:** reh·truh·byoo·shn

Meaning: punishment inflicted on someone as vengeance for a wrong or criminal act.

**Synonyms:** punishment, penalty, nemesis **Antonyms:** forgiveness, pardon, remission

**Sentence:** People are seeking <u>retribution</u> for the latest terrorist outrages.

# 4.DULCET (adj.): आनंदकर

**Pronunciation:** duhl-suht

**Meaning:** giving pleasure or contentment to the mind or senses.

**Synonyms:** delightful, enjoyable, felicitous **Antonyms:** unpalatable, unpleasant, disturbing

**Sentence:** She recorded the <u>dulcet</u> tones of her family and friends.

#### 5.AUGMENT (verb): बढ़ाना

Pronunciation: aug·ment

**Meaning:** make (something) greater by adding to it; increase.

**Synonyms:** increase, make larger, make bigger

Antonyms: decrease

**Sentence:** He <u>augmented</u> his summer income by painting houses.

### 6.CONSCIENCE (noun): अंतरात्मा की आवाज

**Pronunciation:** kawn·shns

Meaning: an inner feeling or voice viewed as acting as a guide to the rightness or

wrongness of one's behavior.

Synonyms: sense of right, moral sense, inner voice

Antonyms: unconscious, unaware, oblivious

**Sentence:** Her conscience told her to find the lost wallet's owner.

# 7.SEETHING (adj.): क्रोध में

Pronunciation: seedh·uhng

**Meaning:** filled with or characterized by intense but unexpressed anger.

Synonyms: blazing, raging, rankling

Antonyms: cool, calmness

**Sentence:** He marched off, seething with frustration.

#### 8.EFFETE (adj.): अशक्त

**Pronunciation:** uh-feet

**Meaning:** (of a person) affected, overrefined, and ineffectual.

Synonyms: affected, over-refined, ineffectual

**Antonyms:** unpretentious

**Sentence:** People said the aristocracy was effete.

# 9.ALLEGIANCE (noun): निष्ठा

**Pronunciation:** uh·lee·jns

Meaning: loyalty or commitment of a subordinate to a superior or of an individual to a

group orcause.

Synonyms: loyalty, faithfulness, fidelity

Antonyms: disloyalty, faithlessness, falseness

Sentence: FBI demands its employees' absolute <u>allegiance</u> to this bureau.

# 10.INVETERATE (adj.): जिद्दी

**Pronunciation:** uhn·veh·tuh·ruht

Meaning: having a particular habit, activity, or interest that is long-established and


unlikely to change.

**Synonyms:** ingrained, stubborn **Antonyms:** unaccustomed, unused

**Sentence:** The man is an <u>inveterate</u> liar who only rarely tells the truth.
