

1.LASH (verb):- जोर से मारना

Pronunciation: lashMeaning: strike (someone) with a whip or stick.Synonyms: whip, flog, beatAntonyms: compliment, unleash, honor.Sentence: We had to lash the cargo to the ship's deck during the storm.

2.INSIPID (adj.) :- फीका

Pronunciation: uhn·si·puhd
Meaning: lacking flavor.
Synonyms: tasteless, flavorless, unflavored
Antonyms: flavorful, flavorsome, sapid
Sentence: There is a mug of <u>insipid</u> coffee on the table.

3.FELICITY (noun) :- परम सुख

Pronunciation: fe·lic·i·ty
Meaning: intense happiness.
Synonyms: euphoria, rapture, ecstasy
Antonyms: unhappiness, infelicity
Sentence: Some people find felicity only by reciting the name of the lord.

4.DELUGE (noun) :- बाढ़

Pronunciation: deh·lyooj
Meaning: a severe flood
Synonyms: flood, surge, spate
Antonyms: drought, dribble, drip
Sentence: This may be the worst <u>deluge</u> in living memory.

5.CONTRAVENE (verb) :- अवहेलना करना

Pronunciation: kawn·truh·veen **Meaning:** violate the prohibition or order of (a law, treaty, or code of conduct). **Synonyms:** break, breach, defy **Antonyms:** obey, follow, comply with



Sentence: Because your actions <u>contravene</u> school policy, you're being suspended for ten days.

6.NOTABILITY (noun) :- प्रसिद्धि

Pronunciation: note·uh·bil·uh·tee
Meaning: the fact or quality of being notable.
Synonyms: noteworthiness, prominence, memorability
Antonyms: nobody, noncelebrity, mediocrity
Sentence: An opening night that was attended by some of Broadway's biggest <u>notabilities</u>.

7.ENMITY (noun) :- शत्र्ता

Pronunciation: en·muh·tee
Meaning: the state or feeling of being actively opposed or hostile to someone or something.
Synonyms: hostility, animosity, antagonism
Antonyms: amity, friendship, civility
Sentence: Enmity had existed between the two families for generations.

8.BABEL (noun) :- कोलाहल

Pronunciation: ba·bl
Meaning: a confused noise made by a number of voices.
Synonyms: clamor, tumult, uproar
Antonyms: quiet, silence, calm
Sentence: She hushed the <u>babel</u> of her thoughts and tried to sleep.

9.EXUBERANT (adj.) :- विपुल

Pronunciation: uhgz·yoo·buh·ruhnt
Meaning: filled with or characterized by a lively energy and excitement.
Synonyms: ebullient, buoyant, cheerful
Antonyms: low-spirited, sullen, surly
Sentence: Exuberant crowds rushed to greet the returning national champions in collegiate basketball.

10.FELONIOUS (adj.) :- दुष्ट

Pronunciation: fuh·lone·ee·uhs
Meaning: relating to or involved in crime.
Synonyms: illegal, illicit, unlawful
Antonyms: lawful, legal, legitimate
Sentence: They turned their <u>felonious</u> talents to the smuggling trade.
