

Here some exceptional English words from the newspaper 'The Hindu' are given with their synonyms/antonyms and usage. Hopefully, this will help you improve your vocabulary. Happy Learning!!!

1. ESCAPADE (noun) - साहस भरा काम; शरारत

Pronunciation: eskuh-peid

Meaning: an act or incident involving excitement, daring, or adventure

Synonyms: stunt, caper, skylarking, mischief, romp

Usage: Frank was nervous about participating in the dangerous escapade.

2. ROOK (verb) - धोखेबाज़ी करना; ठगना

Pronunciation: ruk

Meaning: to cheat someone for money

Synonyms: swindle, defraud, trick, fleece, dupe, deceive

Usage: Police files are overflowing with complaints from people who've been rooked.

3. LAUDATION (noun) – प्रशंसा, स्तृति

Pronunciation: lo-dei-sh(u)n

Meaning: praise

Synonyms: honour, applause, acclaim, acclamation, adulation, commendation, admiration

Antonym: criticism

Usage: This album is really worthy of laudation.

4. HISTRIONIC (adjective, noun) – नाटकीय

Pronunciation: histri-onik

Meaning: excessively theatrical or dramatic in character or style; melodramatic behaviour designed to

attract attention

Synonyms: melodramatic, theatrical, affected, dramatic, exaggerated, stagy, showy, artificial, overacted,

overdone; dramatics, drama, theatrics, theatricality, tantrums, affectation, artificiality

Antonym: unaffected

Usage:

She put on a <u>histrionic</u> display of grief at her ex-husband's funeral. (adjective)

Anna was accustomed to her mother's histrionics. (noun)

5. REPREHENSIBLE (adjective) - निंदनीय

Pronunciation: repri-hensi-b(u)l

Meaning: deserving blame; recognized as bad

Synonyms: deplorable, disgraceful, discreditable, disreputable, despicable

Antonyms: creditable, praiseworthy, good

Usage: I find their behaviour morally <u>reprehensible</u>.

6. GIBBERISH (adjective) – अस्पष्ट भाषण या लेखन

Pronunciation: jib(u)rish

Meaning: unintelligible or meaningless speech or writing

Synonyms: nonsense, rubbish, balderdash, blather, blether, drivel

Antonym: sense

Usage: You were talking gibberish in your sleep.

7. NOOK (noun) – न्क्कड़, कोना

Pronunciation: nuk

Meaning: a corner (offering seclusion or security) **Synonyms**: recess, alcove, cranny, crevice, niche

Usage: We found a seat in a little nook, and had some lunch.

8. LUMBER (verb) – विचलता

Pronunciation: lum-buh

Meaning: move in a slow, heavy, awkward way

Synonyms: lurch, stumble, shamble, shuffle, reel, waddle, trudge

Antonyms: nimble, agile

Usage: The overloaded truck <u>lumbered</u> forward.

9. HULKING (adjective) – भीमकाय

Pronunciation: hul-king

Meaning: (of a person or object) very large, heavy, or clumsy

Synonyms: large, big, heavy, heavily built, well built

Antonyms: light, small

Usage: Two hulking figures guarded the entrance of the club.

10. INSOUCIANT (adjective) – लापरवाह, अलबेला

Pronunciation: in-soo-si-unt

Meaning: showing a casual lack of concern

Synonyms: nonchalant, untroubled, unworried, unruffled, unconcerned

Antonyms: anxious, concerned

Usage: The insouciant waitress did not seem to care that Matt had to wait over an hour for his food.


