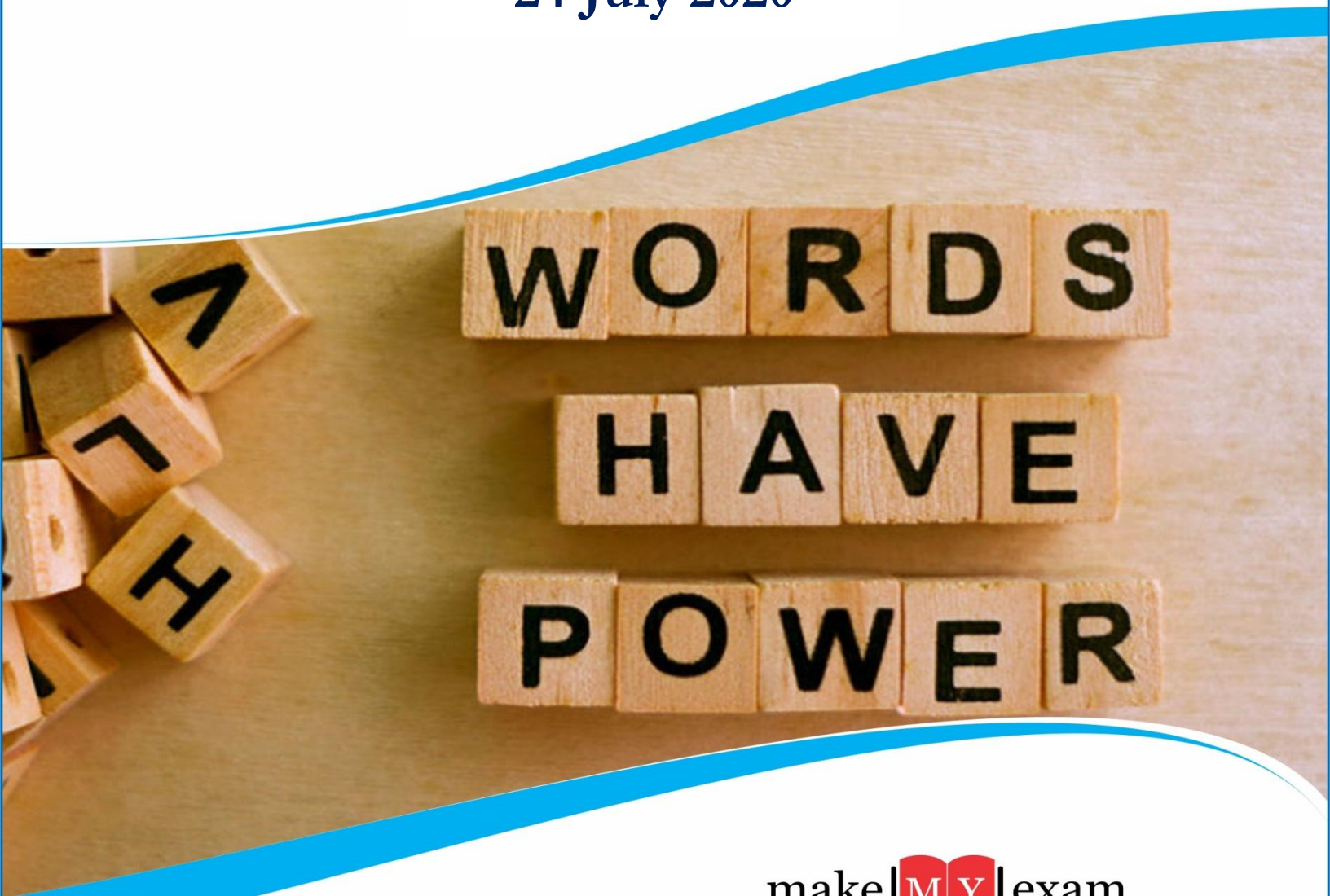

## 1. COERCE (verb) – मजबूर करना

**Pronunciation:** kow•uhs

**Meaning:** persuade an unwilling person to do something by using force or threats

**Synonyms:** pressure, pressurize, constrain, lean on, press, push, force, compel, oblige

**Antonyms:** allow, encourage

**Usage:** The bully tried to coerce the small kids into giving him their lunch money.

## 2. FLURRIED (adjective) – परेशान, उत्तेजित

**Pronunciation:** fluh•reed

**Meaning:** agitated, nervous, or anxious

**Synonyms:** flustered, ruffled, overwrought, perturbed, agitated

**Antonyms:** calm, composed

**Usage:** Keep calm! Don't get flurried.

## 3. TREMOR (noun) – कंपन

**Pronunciation:** treh•muh

**Meaning:** an involuntary quivering movement

**Synonyms:** tremble, shake, quiver, twitch, convulsion, quaver

**Antonyms:** stillness, steadiness

**Usage:** There was a slight tremor in her voice.

## 4. ARCANE (verb) – रहस्यमय

**Pronunciation:** aa•kein

**Meaning:** understood by few; mysterious or secret

**Synonyms:** mysterious, secret, hidden, concealed, covert, esoteric, obscure

**Antonyms:** well known, open

**Usage:** The elderly teacher had an arcane way of teaching mathematics.

## 5. INEPT (adjective) – अयोग्य

**Pronunciation:** uh•nept

**Meaning:** having or showing no skill; clumsy

**Synonyms:** incompetent, unskillful, unskilled, inexpert, amateurish, crude, rough

**Antonyms:** competent, adroit

**Usage:** The inept detective could not see the most obvious clues.

**6. DETEST (verb) – घृणा करना**

**Pronunciation:** duh•test

**Meaning:** dislike intensely

**Synonyms:** abhor, hate, loathe, despise, abominate, execrate

**Antonym:** love, admire

**Usage:** I detest any form of cruelty toward animals.

**7. ORATE (verb) – भाषण देना**

**Pronunciation:** aw•reit

**Meaning:** make a speech, especially pompously or at length

**Synonyms:** declaim, speak, discourse, pontificate, preach, sermonize, spiel

**Antonyms:** whisper

**Usage:** It certainly is a fine thing to be able to orate.

**8. GLISTEN (verb) – चमकना**

**Pronunciation:** gli•sn

**Meaning:** shine with a sparkling light

**Synonyms:** sparkle, twinkle, glint, glitter, glimmer, shimmer, glow

**Antonym:** absorb

**Usage:** The leaves glisten with dew.

**9. GOSSAMER (adjective) – पतला**

**Pronunciation:** go•suh•muh

**Meaning:** a light, thin, and insubstantial or delicate material or substance

**Synonyms:** ultra-fine, diaphanous, transparent, silken, wispy, thin, light

**Antonyms:** heavy, opaque

**Usage:** Jan's white gossamer scarf was practically transparent.

### 10. SUBJUGATE (verb) – अधीन करना


**Pronunciation:** suhb•joo•geit

**Meaning:** bring under domination or control, especially by conquest

**Synonyms:** enslave, conquer, vanquish, defeat, crush, quell, quash

**Antonym:** liberate

**Usage:** Good pet owners are unwilling to subjugate their dogs by placing them in cages.
