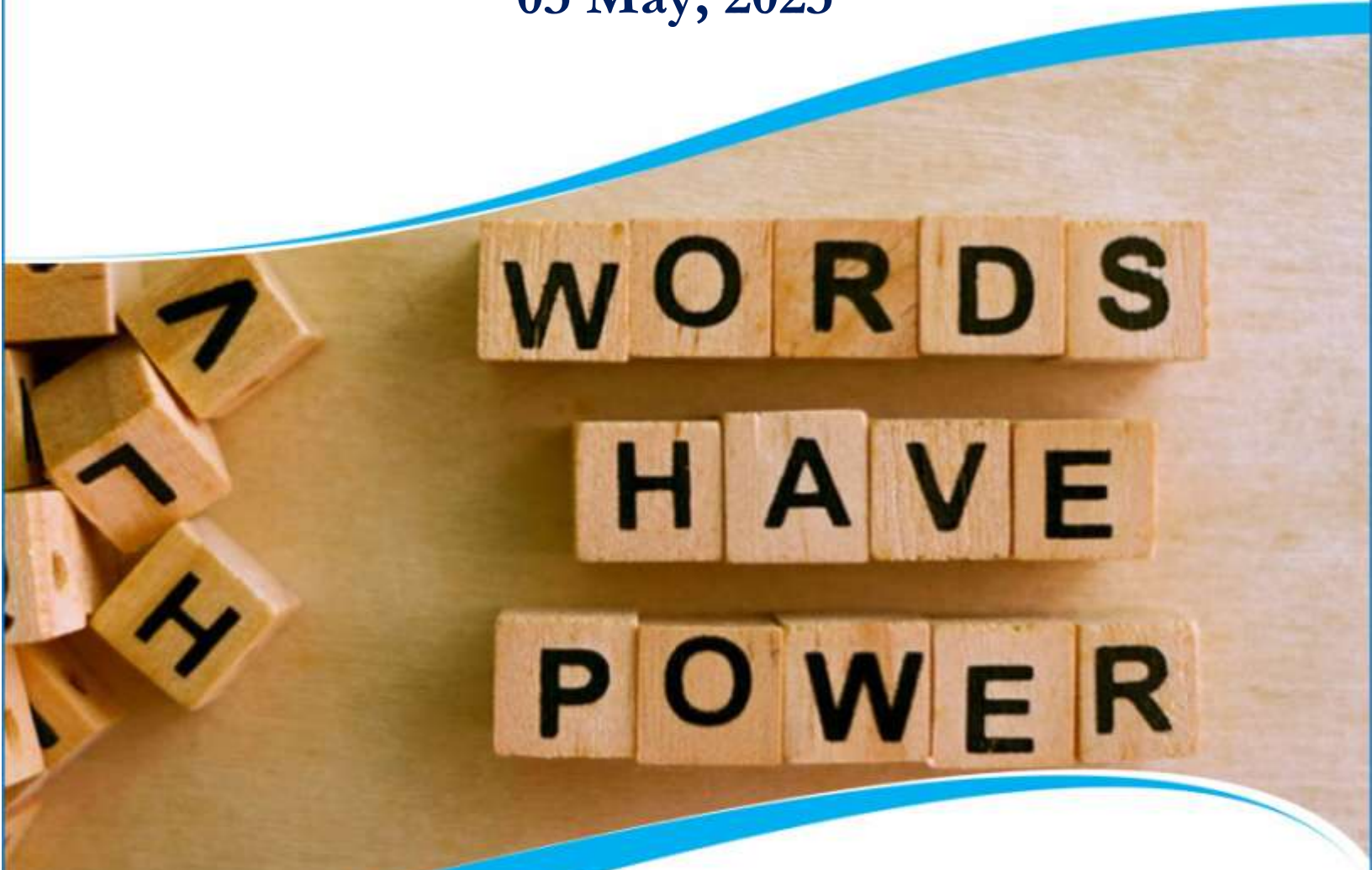

1. DIVULGE (verb) : प्रकट करना

Pronunciation: dai·vuhlj

Meaning: make known (private or sensitive information).

Synonyms: disclose, reveal, make known

Antonyms: conceal, enshroud, hide

Sentence: I do not want to divulge my plans at the moment.

2. SUMPTUOUS (adj.) : वैभवशाली

Pronunciation: suhmp·tyoo·uhs

Meaning: splendid and expensive-looking.

Synonyms: lavish, luxurious, deluxe

Antonyms: austere, humble, spartan

Sentence: The interior is decorated in sumptuous reds and gold.

3. UPBRAID (verb) : फटकारना

Pronunciation: uhp·brayd

Meaning: find fault with (someone); scold.

Synonyms: reprimand, rebuke, reproach

Antonyms: approve, endorse, praise

Sentence: He was upbraided for his slovenly appearance.

4. CESSATION (noun) : समापन

Pronunciation: ses·ay·shn

Meaning: the fact or process of ending or being brought to an end.

Synonyms: end, ending, termination

Antonyms: continuance, continuation

Sentence: Mexico called for an immediate cessation of hostilities.

5. SURMISE (noun) : शंका

Pronunciation: *surmise*

Meaning: suppose that something is true without having evidence to confirm it.

Synonyms: guess, conjecture, suspect

Antonyms: notice, perceive, see

Sentence: He surmised that something must be wrong.

6. GRUELING (adj.) : भीषण

Pronunciation: groo·luhng

Meaning: extremely tiring and demanding.

Synonyms: exhausting, tiring, fatiguing

Antonyms: facile, light, simple

Sentence: The President was working grueling eighteen-hour days trying to save a Great Deal.

7. HASTY (adj.) : तेज़

Pronunciation: hayst·ee

Meaning: done or acting with excessive speed or urgency; hurried.

Synonyms: quick, hurried, fast

Antonyms: deliberate, unhurried, unrushed

Sentence: They shouldn't have made such a hasty decision.

8. GRUESOME (adj.) : भयंकर

Pronunciation: groo·sm

Meaning: causing repulsion or horror; grisly.

Synonyms: frightful, horrid, fearful

Antonyms: cheering, comforting, soothing

Sentence: There has been a series of gruesome murders in the capital.

9. ABOMINABLE (adj.) : घिनौना

Pronunciation: uh·baw·muh·nuh·bl

Meaning: causing moral revulsion.

Synonyms: loathsome, detestable, hateful

Antonyms: innocuous, inoffensive, healthy

Sentence: The uprising was suppressed with abominable cruelty.

10. FLEDGLING (noun) : अनुभवहीन मनुष्य

Pronunciation: flej·luhng

Meaning: a person who is just starting out in a field of activity

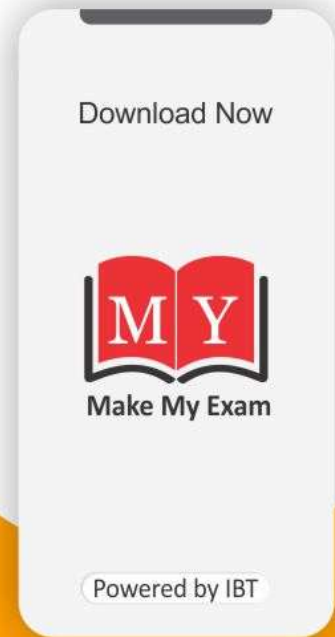
Synonyms: learner, student, trainee

Antonyms: expert, master, veteran

Sentence: In my junior year a friend, a fledgling pilot, taught me the basics of handling a small plane.
