



1. Shambhavi Clinches Gold In Women's 10 Mt Air Rifle Event ISSF Junior World Cup

Indian shooter Shambhavi clinched the gold medal in the Women's 10m Air Rifle event at the ISSF Junior World Cup, showcasing exceptional skill and composure. Competing against top young shooters from around the world, she delivered a stellar performance to secure the top podium spot. Her victory adds to India's growing dominance in junior shooting competitions. This achievement not only highlights



Shambhavi's rising talent but also reflects the effectiveness of India's grassroots sports development programs.

2. India Surpasses Japan to Become the World's 4th Largest Economy

India has officially surpassed Japan to become the world's fourth-largest economy, with its nominal GDP reaching \$4.187 trillion in 2025, slightly ahead of Japan's \$4.186 trillion, according to the International Monetary Fund (IMF). This milestone was confirmed by NITI Aayog CEO B.V.R. Subrahmanyam during the 10th Governing Council meeting, highlighting India's rapid economic ascent. The



achievement has been widely celebrated across the nation, with prominent figures like industrialist Anand Mahindra expressing pride and optimism about India's economic future .

- **India's Economic Ranking**: India now ranks fourth in the global economy, behind the United States, China, and Germany.

3. Star tennis player, Novak Djokovic scripted history by clinching 100th ATP singles title

Novak Djokovic achieved a historic milestone by securing his 100th ATP singles title at the 2025 Geneva Open. In a grueling final, he overcame Poland's Hubert Hurkacz with a scoreline of 5–7, 7–6(2), 7–6(2), marking a significant comeback after previous final losses. At 38 years old, Djokovic became only the third man in the Open Era to reach this century mark, joining legends



Jimmy Connors (109 titles) and Roger Federer (103 titles). This victory also extended his remarkable streak of winning at least one ATP title in 20 consecutive seasons, a testament to his enduring excellence. As he prepares for the upcoming French Open, Djokovic continues to solidify his legacy as one of tennis's all-time greats.

Foot notes:



- **Comeback Victory**: Djokovic trailed 4-2 in the deciding set but managed to pull a break back in the eighth game, converting one of five break points.
- **Tiebreaker Mastery**: In the second set tiebreaker, Djokovic dominated 7-2, forcing the match into a decider.
- **Crucial Break**: Hurkacz initially broke Djokovic's serve in the final set, but the Serbian tennis star broke back to level the set at 4-4, eventually winning the tiebreaker 7-2.
- Third Man to Reach 100 Titles: Djokovic joins Jimmy Connors (109 titles) and Roger Federer (103 titles) as the only men to have won 100 ATP titles in the Open era.
- **First Man to Win Titles in 20 Different Seasons:** This achievement showcases Djokovic's enduring talent and dedication to the sport.

4. Indian Junior Women's Hockey Team Triumphs at Four Nations Tournament

The Indian Junior Women's Hockey Team secured a thrilling 3-2 victory over Uruguay in their second match of the Four Nations Tournament held in Rosario, Argentina, on May 26, 2025. Uruguay took an early lead in the 3rd minute through a penalty corner converted by Milagros Seigal. India equalized in the 21st minute with a penalty corner goal from Sonam, but Uruguay regained the lead shortly after



with Agustina Mari's goal in the 24th minute. In the final quarter, Kanika Siwach turned the game around for India by scoring twice—first from a penalty corner in the 46th minute and then a decisive field goal in the 50th minute—securing the win for her team.

- Match against Uruguay: In their second match, India edged out Uruguay 3-2. Sonam equalized with a penalty corner goal in the 21st minute, while Kanika Siwach scored twice in the final stretch once through a penalty corner in the 46th minute and again with a decisive field goal in the 50th minute.
- **Upcoming Match**: India is set to face host Argentina on May 28 (Wednesday as per IST) in their next match.

5. Shubman Gill Becomes Team India's New Test Captain

Shubman Gill has been appointed as the new captain of India's Test cricket team, succeeding Rohit Sharma following his retirement from the format. At 25, Gill becomes India's 37th Test captain and will lead the team in the upcoming five-match series against England, starting June 20 at Headingley, Leeds . Expressing his sentiments, Gill described the role as the "ultimate honour,"



emphasizing the significant responsibility that comes with leading the national side . He aims to lead by example, drawing inspiration from the leadership styles of his predecessors, Virat Kohli and Rohit Sharma .

6. Iranian Director Jafar Panahi Takes Top Honour at Cannes Film Festival

Iranian filmmaker Jafar Panahi achieved a significant milestone by winning the Palme d'Or at the 78th Cannes Film Festival for his film It Was Just an Accident. This marks his return to the international stage after a 15-year travel ban was lifted in 2023. The film, a satirical drama inspired by stories Panahi heard in Evin Prison, critiques the Iranian regime and centers on a group seeking justice



for past torture . Panahi, known for his defiance of government censorship, has faced travel bans, prior arrests, and imprisonment due to his critical stance. In his acceptance speech, he urged national unity and emphasized freedom of expression in Iran .


