1. PERNICIOUS (adj.): हानिकारक

Pronunciation: puh·ni·shuhs

Meaning: having a harmful effect, especially in a gradual or subtle way.

Synonyms: harmful, damaging, destructive **Antonyms:** anodyne, benign, harmless

Sentence: The business may be troublesome, but idleness is <u>pernicious</u>.

2. FEISTY (adj.): लड़ाक्

Pronunciation: fai-stee

Meaning: feeling or displaying eagerness to fight **Synonyms:** aggressive, agonistic, argumentative **Antonyms:** nonaggressive, nonbelligerent, pacific

Sentence: He's a pretty <u>feisty</u> kid, isn't he?

3. ERUDITION (noun) : पांडित्य

Pronunciation: eh·ru·di·shn

Meaning: the quality of having or showing great knowledge or learning; scholarship.

Synonyms: learning, scholarship, knowledge **Antonyms:** ignorance, illiteracy, illiterateness **Sentence:** His <u>erudition</u> was apparently endless.

4. ASSEVERATION (noun) : दृढ़ वचन

Pronunciation: uh·seh·vuh·ray·shn

Meaning: the solemn or emphatic declaration or statement of something.

Synonyms: affirmation, assertion, avouchment **Antonyms:** disavowal, contradiction, denial

Sentence: You can forget the <u>asseveration</u> of past but want to remember own of sincerely.

5. COMMENSURATE (adj.) : अनुरूप

Pronunciation: kuh·men·suh·ruht

Meaning: corresponding in size or degree; in proportion.

Synonyms: equivalent, equal, corresponding

Antonym: disproportionate

Sentence: Six yards is commensurate with eighteen feet.

6. SCROUNGE (verb) : प्राप्त करना

Pronunciation: skrawnj

Meaning: to get with great difficulty **Synonyms:** earn, procure, wrest **Antonyms:** ebb, arrive, malfunction

Sentence: I managed to <u>scrounge</u> some money off my dad.

7. PREEMINENCE (noun) : प्रमुखता

Pronunciation: pree eh · muh · nuhns

Meaning: the fact of surpassing all others; superiority.

Synonyms: excellency, superiority, eminence **Antonyms:** inferiority, mediocrity, worthlessness

Sentence: No one doubt the preeminence of my father in financial matter.

8. GROUSE (verb) : बड़बड़ाना

Pronunciation: graws

Meaning: complain pettily; grumble. **Synonyms:** grumble, complain, moan

Antonyms: commendation, compliment, plaudit **Sentence:** She heard him grousing about his assistant.

9. APPROPRIACY (noun) : उपयुक्तता

Pronunciation: appropriacy

Meaning: the quality of being suitable or proper in the circumstances.

Synonyms: suitable, proper, acceptable

Antonyms: inappropriate, improper, unsuitable

Sentence: Teachers aim to assess the <u>appropriacy</u> of the language used by their students in

particular contexts.

10. PEREGRINATION (noun) : सफ़र

Pronunciation: peh·ruh·gruhn·ay·shn

Meaning: a journey, especially a long or meandering one.


Synonyms: travels, voyages, journey

Antonyms: remain, stay

Sentence: His <u>peregrinations</u> took him to India.
