

1.DIASPORA (noun): प्रवासी

Pronunciation: dai.a.spuh.ruh

Meaning: the dispersion of any people from their original homeland

Synonym: Emigration, Dispersion, exoduses

Antonym: comings, entrances, arrivals

Sentence: The Indian diaspora across the world plays a significant role in the cultural

exchange between countries.

2.ASSSIMILATED (verb): आत्मसात

Pronunciation: uh.si.muh.layt.uhd

Meaning: absorbed and integrated into a wider society or culture

Synonym: knew, recognized, saw **Antonym**: missed, misresd, mistook

Sentence: Over the years, the immigrants have assimilated into the local community very

well.

3.ADAPT (verb): अनुकूल बनाना

Pronunciation:uh.dapt

Meaning: to become familiar with a new situation and to change your behaviour

accordingly

Synonym: Adjust, Conform, suit **Antonym**: Resist, Reject, misadjust

Sentence: Animals must adapt to their environment in order to survive.

4.THRIVE (verb): फलना-फूलना

Pronunciation: thrive

Meaning: grow or develop well or vigorously

Synonym: Flourish, Prosper, bloom **Antonym**: Decline, Fail, struggle

Sentence: The company continues to thrive despite the economic downturn.

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5. LAUDATORY (adjective): सराहने योग्य

Pronunciation: lawd.uh.tree

Meaning: (of speech or writing) expressing praise and commendation

Synonym: Complimentary, Praiseful, favorable

Antonym: Critical, Blaming, captious

Sentence: The reviews for the new book were overwhelmingly laudatory.

6.ACUTE (adjective): तीव्र

Pronunciation:uh.kyoot

Meaning: present or experienced to a severe or intense degree

Synonym: Severe, Sharp, keen **Antonym**: Mild, Blunt, dull

Sentence: The patient was suffering from acute pain in his chest.

7.REPRIEVE (noun): दण्डविराम

Pronunciation:ruh.preev

Meaning: a cancellation or postponement of a punishment

Synonym: Respite, Pardon, recess

Antonym: Penalty, Punishment, progress

Sentence: The governor granted a reprieve to the death row inmate just hours before the

scheduled execution.

8.FELONY (noun): गुंडागर्दी

Pronunciation: feh.luhn.ee

Meaning: the act of committing a serious crime such as murder; a crime of this type

Synonym: Crimes, Offenses, debts

Antonym: non crimes, moralities, virtues

Sentence: Convicted of a felony, he faced several years in prison.

9.HUSH-MONEY (noun): मुँह भराई

Pronunciation: huhsh.muh.nee

Meaning: money paid to someone to prevent them from disclosing information that is

potentially damaging or embarrassing

Synonym: Bribe, Payoff

Antonym: Exposure, Disclosure

Sentence: He offered hush-money to the witnesses to prevent them from testifying in

court.

10. INDICTMENT (noun): अभियोग

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Pronunciation: uhn.dite.muhnt

Meaning: a formal charge or accusation of a serious crime

Synonym: Charge, Accusation, beef

Antonym: Acquittal, Exoneration, defend

Sentence: The grand jury returned an indictment against the politician for corruption.



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
