



1. DIG Ashish Mehrotra assumed office as Commander of the Indian Coast

DIG Ashish Mehrotra has officially assumed office as the Commander of the Indian Coast Guard. He brings with him extensive experience in maritime operations and coastal security. His appointment comes at a crucial time when coastal surveillance and maritime law enforcement are of increasing national importance. As Commander, he will be responsible for overseeing operations, safety, and strategic preparedness along India's vast coastline. 3. IAS Vinod Kumar Gunjiyal Assumes Charge as the Chief Electoral Officer of Bihar

IAS officer Vinod Kumar Gunjiyal has been appointed as the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO) of Bihar by the Election Commission of India, ahead of the state's Assembly elections scheduled for October-November 2025. A 2007-batch officer from the Bihar cadre, Gunjiyal succeeds H R Srinivas, a 1996-batch IAS officer. Born on January 4, 1979, he holds a Bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering. Throughout his administrative career, Gunjiyal has held several key positions, including Secretary of the Prohibition, Excise & Registration

Department, where he was instrumental in strengthening regulatory frameworks and enhancing departmental efficiency.

4. FTII Pune Declared 'Deemed to be University' by Union Ministry of Education

8. IndusInd Bank CEO Sumant Kathpalia Resigns

IndusInd Bank CEO Sumant Kathpalia has officially resigned from his position. His resignation comes after serving the bank in a key leadership role for several years. Under his tenure, the bank saw steady growth and expansion across various financial sectors. The resignation has been submitted to the board and is currently under review. - **Tenure**: Kathpalia's term as MD & CEO was recently extended by one year by the RBI in March 2025, despite the bank's board clearing him for a three-year extension.
- Career Background: Kathpalia, a chartered accountant, joined IndusInd Bank in 2008 and was instrumental in developing the bank's consumer loans portfolio. He took over as MD & CEO in March 2020.

10. PR Sreejesh, coach of the Indian Junior Men's Team, honoured with Padma Bhushan award

PR Sreejesh, the former Indian hockey goalkeeper and current coach of the Indian Men's Junior Hockey Team, has been conferred with the Padma Bhushan, India's third-highest civilian award, for his outstanding contributions to sports. The award was presented by President Droupadi Murmu at a ceremony held at Rashtrapati Bhavan on April 28, 2025. Sreejesh's illustrious career includes 336 international caps and pivotal roles in securing bronze medals for India at the Tokyo 2020 and Paris 2024 Olympics. Notably, he is the only







hockey goalkeeper globally to have won the FIH Goalkeeper of the Year award three times. Following his retirement after the Paris Olympics, Sreejesh transitioned to coaching, leading the Indian junior team to victory at the Junior Asia Cup in November 2024.

- **Award Ceremony**: PR Sreejesh received the Padma Bhushan award from President Droupadi Murmu at Rashtrapati Bhavan in New Delhi on April 27, 2025.

- Achievements: He won two Asian Games gold medals (2014 and 2022), an Asian Games bronze medal (2018), and two Commonwealth Games silver medals (2014 and 2022).
