

1. CRASS (ADJECTIVE): अनाडी

Pronunciation: kras

Meaning: not intelligent; irresponsible.

Synonyms: stupid, gross **Antonyms:** sharp, smart

Sentence: They have behaved with crass insensitivity.

2. CREDENCE (NOUN): प्रत्यय

Pronunciation: kree·dns

Meaning: acceptance or belief. Synonyms: trust, assurance Antonyms: denial, disbelief

Sentence: I cannot give credence to his account.

3. CREED (NOUN): पंथ

Pronunciation: kreed

Meaning: belief.

Synonyms: principles, doctrine **Antonyms:** disbelief, doubt

Sentence: The centre is open to all, no matter what race or creed.

4. CORRODE (VERB): जंग लगना

Pronunciation: kuh·rode

Meaning: to become weak or to be destroyed by chemical action

Synonyms: erode, deteriorate **Antonyms:** build, construct

Sentence: Engineers found that the structure had been corroded by moisture.

5. SCORCHING (ADJECTIVE): ज्वलंत, तपता ह्आ

Pronunciation: skawch·uhng

Meaning: very hot.

Synonyms: Searing, Burning **Antonyms:** Freezing, Chilly

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Sentence: The scorching sun made it unbearable to be outside.

6. MELANCHOLY (NOUN/ADJECTIVE): उदासी, द्ख

Pronunciation: meh·luhng·kuh·lee

Meaning: a feeling of pensive sadness, typically with no obvious cause.

Synonyms: Sadness, Sorrow **Antonyms:** Joy, Delight

Sentence: The old photograph brought back a wave of melancholy memories.

7. CONTENTMENT (NOUN, VERB): संतोष, संत्ष्ट

Pronunciation: kuhn·tent·muhnt

Meaning: a state of happiness and satisfaction.

Synonyms: Satisfaction, Fulfilment **Antonyms:** Discontent, Dissatisfaction

Sentence: After years of hard work, he finally found contentment in his career.

8. MAGNIFY (VERB): बढाना, वस्तार करना

Pronunciation: mag·nuh·fai

Meaning: make (something) appear larger than it is, especially with a lens or microscope.

Synonyms: Amplify, Enlarge **Antonyms:** Reduce, Decrease

Sentences: The microscope allowed us to magnify tiny organisms and study them in detail.

9. AVARICIOUS (ADJECTIVE): लोभी

Pronunciation: a·vuh·rish·uhs

Meaning: having or showing an extreme greed for wealth or material gain.

Synonyms: Greedy, Grasping **Antonyms:** Generous, Selfless

Sentence: His avaricious nature led him to exploit others for his own financial gain.

10. SEETHE (VERB): उबलना

Pronunciation: seedh

Meaning: to be in a state of intense agitation or anger.

Synonyms: be angry, be furious, be enraged


Antonyms: Placate, Relax

Sentence: The politician's controversial remarks caused the public to seethe with outrage,

leading to heated debates and discussions.

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
