ISRO Achieves 2nd Successful Satellite Docking Under SpaDeX Mission

ISRO has successfully achieved its second satellite docking under the SpaDeX mission, marking a significant milestone in India's space exploration capabilities. This accomplishment follows the initial docking on January 16, 2025, and subsequent undocking on March 13, 2025. The docking was confirmed by Union Minister Jitendra Singh, who shared the news on social media, expressing satisfaction with the operation's success. ISRO Chairman V Narayanan also praised the smooth execution, highlighting its importance for future missions. The SpaDeX mission, launched on December 30, 2024, involved two satellites, SDX01 and SDX02, demonstrating advanced space docking technology.

- **Successful Docking**: ISRO achieved its second successful satellite docking under the SpaDeX mission on April 21, 2025, marking a significant milestone in India's space research program. Union Minister Jitendra Singh congratulated the ISRO team on this achievement.
- **Mission Objective**: The SpaDeX mission aims to demonstrate India's technological capabilities in spacecraft rendezvous, docking, and undocking. This capability is crucial for future advancements like satellite servicing, space station operations, and interplanetary exploration.
- Satellite Details: The mission involves two small satellites, SDX-01 (Chaser) and SDX-02 (Target), launched on December 30, 2024, using the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV)-C60 from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota.
- **Docking and Undocking**: The first successful docking occurred on January 16, 2025, and the satellites were later undocked on March 13, 2025. These complex maneuvers simulate critical operations for future space missions.
- **Technological Significance**: This achievement positions India as the fourth nation, after the United States, Russia, and China, to demonstrate in-space docking capabilities. This technology is essential for India's space ambitions, including lunar missions, sample returns, and building the Bharatiya Antariksh Station.

Hindi made compulsory as 3rd language in Maharashtra Schools

The Maharashtra government has made Hindi compulsory as the third language in all schools across the state. This decision applies to schools following state, national, and international curriculums. The move aims to promote linguistic diversity and strengthen the national language among students. Hindi will now be taught from Class 1 to Class 10 alongside Marathi and English. While some have welcomed the decision, others have raised concerns about the added academic load. The government believes this step will enhance students' communication skills and national integration.



- **Compulsory Hindi Classes** : Hindi will be compulsory only for students in Classes 1 to 5, aiming to provide a basic understanding of the language. This decision relaxes the previous rule, which made Hindi compulsory from Classes 5 to 7.
- Marathi Remains Mandatory : Marathi will continue to be a mandatory subject in schools, and Hindi will not replace it. The government emphasizes promoting Marathi through initiatives like granting classical language status and building Marathi Bhawan.
- National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 : The decision aligns with NEP 2020, which requires students to learn three languages, with two being Indian languages. This policy aims to promote linguistic diversity and cultural understanding.
- **Similarities between Hindi and Marathi** : Both languages share the Devanagari script, making it easier for students to learn Hindi. This similarity is highlighted as a benefit by Maharashtra's Education Minister, Deepak Kesarkar.
- **Government's Promotion of Marathi** : The Maharashtra government has taken significant steps to promote Marathi, including launching the Marathi International Council and a Marathi encyclopedia. These initiatives demonstrate the government's commitment to preserving the state's language and culture.

Amaravati is the World's First Fully Renewable Powered City

Amaravati has been declared the world's first fully renewable powered city. The city now runs entirely on energy generated from renewable sources like solar, wind, and hydro power. This achievement marks a major milestone in global efforts toward sustainable urban development. Amaravati's model focuses on reducing carbon emissions while promoting green technologies. The city's success is expected to inspire other urban centers to adopt similar renewable strategies. It stands as a symbol of innovation and environmental responsibility on the world stage.

- **Renewable Energy Goal**: Amaravati aims to generate 2,700 megawatts (MW) of clean energy through solar, wind, and hydropower sources, meeting its projected energy demand by 2050 and eliminating fossil fuel reliance.
- **Sustainable Infrastructure**: The city will feature green buildings, rooftop solar installations, and a district cooling system to reduce energy consumption and carbon emissions. Mandatory rooftop solar systems will cover at least one-third of government housing projects.
- Green Transportation: Amaravati's public transportation network, including the Amaravati Metro and electric buses, will operate on renewable energy. An extensive electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure will support EV adoption.
- **Current Progress**: Officials have already installed 415 kW of rooftop solar arrays across community facilities like Anganwadis, public schools, e-health centers, and a multi-faith funeral home.



Government Re-Appoints T. Rabi Sankar as RBI Deputy Governor

The Government of India has re-appointed T. Rabi Sankar as the Deputy Governor of the Reserve Bank of India (RBI). His new tenure will be for three years, starting from May 3, 2025. Sankar, who first assumed the role in 2021, oversees critical areas such as fintech, digital payments, and currency management. His re-appointment reflects the government's confidence in his leadership during a time of rapid technological change in the financial sector. Under his guidance, RBI has made significant strides in initiatives like the Digital Rupee and strengthening cybersecurity frameworks.

- **Previous Tenure**: Sankar was initially appointed as Deputy Governor in May 2021 for a three-year term, which was then extended by another year in 2024.

US Vice President JD Vance Receives Guard of Honour in Delhi

The ceremony took place at the forecourt of Rashtrapati Bhavan, marking a significant moment in India-U.S. diplomatic ties. Senior Indian officials warmly welcomed Vance, highlighting the importance of his visit in strengthening bilateral relations. Vance expressed his appreciation for the honour and emphasized the need for deeper cooperation between the two nations. His visit includes meetings with key Indian leaders to discuss trade, defense, and technology partnerships.

Indian Navy concluded Maiden AIKEYME Exercise in Tanzania



The Indian Navy successfully concluded its inaugural multilateral naval exercise, AIKEYME (Africa-India Key Maritime Engagement), in Dar-es-Salaam, Tanzania, from April 13 to 18, 2025. The harbour phase featured tabletop and command-post exercises focusing on anti-piracy operations, information sharing, and training in seamanship and Visit, Board, Search, and Seizure (VBSS) procedures. The subsequent sea phase included drills in search and rescue, small arms firing, and helicopter operations, fostering interoperability among the participating navies. Additionally, the exercise underscored India's commitment to its MAHASAGAR initiative, promoting mutual and holistic advancement for security and growth across regions. **Foot notes**:

Himanshu Jakhar Wins 1st Ever Gold In U-18 Asian Athletics Championships

Himanshu Jakhar has made history by winning the first-ever gold medal for India at the U-18 Asian Athletics Championships (Para). Competing in the discus throw event, Jakhar delivered a stunning performance to secure the top podium spot. His remarkable throw not only earned him gold but also set a new championship record. This victory highlights Jakhar's immense potential and dedication to para-athletics. It marks a proud moment for India on the Asian stage, inspiring many young athletes across the country. Simranpreet Kaur wins maiden senior international medal with silver in 25m pistol

Simranpreet Kaur Brar has clinched her maiden senior international medal, securing silver in the women's 25m pistol event at the ISSF World Cup in Lima, Peru. The 20-year-old shooter achieved a score of 33 hits over 10 rapid-fire series, narrowly missing the gold to China's Sun Yujie, who finished with 34 hits. Another Chinese athlete, Yao Qianxun, earned the bronze with 29 hits. This accomplishment adds to India's medal tally at the World Cup, which includes two golds and one bronze. Notably, Paris Olympics double medallist Manu Bhaker finished fourth in the same event. Simranpreet's performance underscores her growing prominence in international shooting sports.

Indian Boxers Shine at Asian U-15 & U-17 Championships with Three Dominant Wins on Day 2

On Day 2 of the Asian U-15 & U-17 Boxing Championships in Amman, Jordan, Indian boxers delivered a stellar performance, securing three dominant victories. In the U-15 boys' 43kg category, Hardik Dahiya showcased his prowess by defeating Kyrgyzstan's Kubanychbek Bolushov with a unanimous 5-0 decision. Rudraksh Singh followed suit in the 46kg division, overpowering Mongolia's Ibrakhim Maral, also with a 5-0 scoreline. These victories highlight the emerging talent in India's boxing contingent. The championships serve as a platform for young athletes to gain international experience and further their careers in the sport. India Finish ISSF World Cup Peru Leg In 3rd Place

Oscar Piastri Wins 2025 Saudi Arabian Grand Prix

Oscar Piastri made history at the 2025 Saudi Arabian Grand Prix by claiming his first-ever Formula 1 victory. The McLaren driver executed a flawless race, managing tire degradation and strategic pit stops to fend off challenges from rivals. In a tense final laps showdown, Piastri held off a fast-charging Max Verstappen, whose late push fell just short. The win marks a significant milestone for both Piastri and McLaren, showcasing their progress and growth throughout the season. The race in Jeddah provided thrilling action, with several on-track battles and dramatic



moments, but Piastri's composure under pressure set him apart. His triumph was celebrated by his team and fans alike, propelling him into the spotlight as one of F1's rising stars.

Manika and Sreeja Shine in ITTF World Cup 2025

Manika Batra and Sreeja Akula delivered outstanding performances in the ITTF World Cup 2025. Representing India, both players showcased remarkable skill and determination on the international stage. Manika impressed the audience with her aggressive play and strategic shots. Sreeja also stood out with her quick reflexes and consistent rallies. Nitin Belurkar Leads with Perfect Score at Maharashtra International Open Grandmaster Chess Tournament

Goa's International Master (IM) Nitin Belurkar has taken the sole lead at the 3rd Maharashtra International Open Grandmaster Chess Tournament in Pune. After five rounds, he maintained a perfect score of 5/5, notably defeating Grandmaster Sandipan Chanda in the fifth round. Belurkar's strategic play and consistent performance have positioned him at the top of the leaderboard. However, in the sixth round, his winning streak ended with a draw against Madhya Pradesh's Ayush Sharma, bringing his total to 5.5 points. Despite this, he remains the sole leader, with several competitors closely trailing.

Pope Francis passed away

Former Australian opener Keith Stackpole, passed away
