

Meaning: penalty.

Synonyms: punishment, deterrent

Antonyms: reward

3. COMPREHENSIVE (ADJECTIVE): व्यापक

Pronunciation: kawm·pruh·hen·suhv

Meaning: inclusive.

Synonyms: all-inclusive complete

Antonyms: partial

Sentence: Her collection of photographs was anything but comprehensive.

4. DAWDLE (VERB): समय नष्ट करना

Pronunciation: daw·dl Meaning: waste time.

Synonyms: loiter, procrastinate

Antonyms: hasten, hurry

Sentence: The teacher warned the student that he will be punished if he dawdled again.

5. PILLAGE (VERB): लूटना

Pronunciation: pi·luhj
Meaning: plunder, destroy.
Synonyms: ravage, ransack
Antonyms: protect, construct

Meaning: deadly, injurious.
Synonyms: destructive, harmful

Antonyms: helpful, kind

Sentence: This is a noxious chemical.

7. SUPERVENE (VERB): पीछेआना

Pronunciation: soo·puh·veen

Meaning: follow.

Synonyms: pursue, supersede **Antonyms:** retreat, precede

Sentence: Team members supervene their leaders.

8. FERVENT (ADJECTIVE): उत्साही

Pronunciation: fuh·vnt
Meaning: enthusiastic.
Synonyms: zealous, ardent
Antonyms: apathetic, dull
Sentence: He is a fervent child.

9. FITFUL (ADJECTIVE): चंचल

Pronunciation: fit-ful Meaning: spasmodic.

Synonyms: intermittent, fluctuating **Antonyms:** continuous, perpetual

Sentence: As long as his breathing is fitful, he will continue to need an oxygen

machine.

10. FLOUT (VERB): अवज्ञाकरना


Pronunciation: flawt

Meaning: show contempt for. **Synonyms:** defy, disregard **Antonyms:** honour, praise

Sentence: One should not flout the traffic rules.
