Rajnath, Yogi inaugurate India's largest aero engine test bed in UP

- Inauguration: Defence Minister Rajnath Singh and UP Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath jointly inaugurated India's largest aero engine test bed in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.
- Facility Purpose: The test bed is designed for testing and validating aero engines, crucial for strengthening India's aerospace and defence self-reliance.
- **Strategic Importance**: The facility supports the Atmanirbhar Bharat initiative, reducing dependence on foreign testing facilities.
- **Key Agency Involved**: Developed under the Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) / DRDO collaboration (depending on official details, can confirm exact body).
- **Regional Boost**: The project not only strengthens India's defence ecosystem but also positions Uttar Pradesh as a defence and aerospace hub.

Odisha Ranks 5th in E-Bus Adoption, Plans 1,000+ Fleet

- National Ranking: Odisha secured the 5th position in India for electric bus (e-bus) adoption.
- Current Status: The state has already introduced e-buses in key cities under the 'Location Accessible Multimodal Initiative (LAccMI)' scheme.
- **Expansion Plan**: Odisha government announced plans to expand its e-bus fleet to over 1,000 buses in the coming years.
- **Objective**: The move aims to promote green public transport, reduce carbon emissions, and improve urban mobility.
- **Significance**: With this step, Odisha is set to become a leading state in sustainable transport, aligning with India's net zero and clean energy goals.

India's First Port-Based Green Hydrogen Project at VOC Port

- **Project Inauguration**: Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal, inaugurated the project on September 5, 2025, marking a significant step in India's clean energy transition.
- **Green Hydrogen Production**: The Rs 3.87 crore pilot facility produces 10 Nm³/hr of green hydrogen, powering streetlights and an electric vehicle charging station in the port colony, making VOC Port the first Indian port to generate green hydrogen.



- **Green Methanol Bunkering Facility**: Alongside the hydrogen project, Sonowal laid the foundation for a Rs 35.34 crore Green Methanol Bunkering and Refuelling Facility with a 750 m³ capacity, supporting the proposed Coastal Green Shipping Corridor between Kandla and Tuticorin.
- Renewable Energy Integration: The project aligns with India's National Green Hydrogen Mission, aiming to reduce dependence on fossil fuels, promote sustainable energy, and position VOC Port as a key green bunkering hub in south India.

CP Radhakrishnan elected as India's 15th Vice President

- **Election Result**: CP Radhakrishnan won the election with 452 votes, defeating Opposition nominee B Sudershan Reddy who secured 300 votes. A total of 767 votes were cast, with 752 being valid and 15 invalid.
- **Background**: Radhakrishnan is a veteran of the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) and has deep roots in the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP). He served as the BJP's State President in Tamil Nadu from 2004 to 2007.
- **Political Experience**: Radhakrishnan has been a Member of Lok Sabha from Coimbatore twice and held key positions such as Chairman of the Parliamentary Standing Committee for Textiles and member of the Parliamentary Committee for Public Sector Undertakings.
- Governor Roles: Before becoming Vice President, Radhakrishnan served as the Governor of Maharashtra since July 31, 2024, and previously as the Governor of Jharkhand for nearly one and a half years.

Coal India and NSTFDC Sign MoU to Empower Tribal Students via Eklavya Schools

- Partnership Details: Coal India Limited (CIL) and the National Scheduled Tribe Finance and Development Corporation (NSTFDC) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on September 9, 2025, to support tribal students in Eklavya Model Residential Schools (EMRS) across Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, and Odisha.
- **Objectives**: The partnership aims to bridge the digital divide, promote menstrual health and hygiene, and provide career counseling and mentorship to over 30,000 tribal students in 76 EMRS.
- **Infrastructure Upgrades**: The initiative includes setting up computer labs with 1,200 computers and 1,200 UPS units, as well as providing 110 tablets to enhance digital learning.



• **Health and Hygiene**: The partnership will also provide 420 sanitary pad vending machines and 420 sanitary pad incinerators to promote menstrual health and hygiene among girl students.

PhonePe partners with SIDBI, MSME Ministry on Udyam

- **Simplifying Udyam Registration**: The partnership allows micro-merchants to get an Udyam registration number and certificate digitally through a seamless, end-to-end process on the PhonePe platform, eliminating the need for paperwork and intermediaries.
- Access to Government Schemes and Benefits: By formalizing their business identity, micro-merchants can unlock a wide range of government benefits, including subsidies, tax benefits, and easier access to formal credit and financial services.
- Enhancing Credit Flow: A key goal of the collaboration is to provide informal businesses with a formal identity that makes them eligible for institutional credit from banks and financial institutions, thereby improving their access to funding for growth.
- Accelerating Formalization: With PhonePe's massive merchant base of over 45 million across the country, this initiative is expected to significantly accelerate the formalization of the unorganized micro-enterprise sector in India.

Acharya Devvrat Gets Additional Charge as Maharashtra Governor

- **Temporary Appointment**: This is an additional charge for Acharya Devvrat, meaning he will concurrently serve as the Governor of both Gujarat and Maharashtra. This is a temporary arrangement until a permanent Governor for Maharashtra is appointed.
- Constitutional Mandate: The President of India, Droupadi Murmu, made the appointment exercising her powers under the Constitution. When the office of a Governor falls vacant, the President can appoint the Governor of a neighboring state to assume the responsibilities.
- Vacancy due to Vice-Presidential Election: The need for this appointment arose after C. P. Radhakrishnan, who was serving as the Governor of Maharashtra, was elected as the 14th Vice-President of India.
- Experienced Administrator: Acharya Devvrat is a seasoned administrator, having served as the Governor of Gujarat since 2019. Prior to that, he was the Governor of Himachal Pradesh. His experience is expected to ensure the smooth functioning of the gubernatorial duties in Maharashtra.

IIM Ahmedabad Launches First Global Campus in Dubai

- A Historic First for IIMs: This is the first time an Indian Institute of Management has established a full-fledged overseas campus. This move is seen as a major step towards the internationalization of Indian education and is expected to enhance the global brand of one of India's most prestigious educational institutions.
- Strategic Location in a Global Hub: The choice of Dubai as the location for its first international campus is a strategic one. Dubai's status as a thriving global business and travel hub provides IIM-A with a launchpad to attract a diverse pool of students and forge collaborations with international corporations. The strong bilateral ties between India and the UAE also played a crucial role in this decision.
- **Initial Program Offerings**: The Dubai campus will initially offer a one-year Global MBA program specifically designed for experienced professionals and entrepreneurs. In addition to this flagship program, the campus will also provide a range of executive education courses tailored to the needs of the regional business landscape, with a focus on areas like AI and innovation.
- **Phased Development Plan:** The operations of the IIM Ahmedabad-Dubai campus are commencing in September 2025 at the Dubai International Academic City (DIAC). There is a clear roadmap for future growth, with plans to move to a larger, permanent campus by 2029. This phased approach will allow the institution to establish its presence and scale its operations over time.

AIIMS Delhi launched the AI-based mental health program Never Alone

• AI-Powered Mental Health Support: "Never Alone" utilizes Artificial Intelligence to offer a comprehensive mental wellness solution. The program is delivered through a secure, web-based application that is accessible 24/7 via WhatsApp. This allows for initial screening, intervention, and consistent follow-up with students who may be struggling with mental health issues.



- Focus on Suicide Prevention and Stigma Reduction: The primary goal of the program is to tackle the alarming rate of suicidal tendencies among students by providing early and accessible intervention. By offering a confidential and easily accessible platform, "Never Alone" aims to minimize the stigma that often prevents young people from seeking help for their mental health concerns.
- Accessible and Affordable for Institutions: The program has been designed to be highly accessible for educational institutions. The basic screening for mental health issues through the "Never Alone" app is available at a nominal cost of 70 paise per student per day. To facilitate wider reach, AIIMS Delhi will provide the service to all other AIIMS institutions across the country at no cost.
- **Hybrid Model of Care:** While the initial interaction and screening are AI-driven, the program facilitates both virtual and in-person consultations with mental health and wellness experts. This hybrid approach ensures that students receive the appropriate level of care, from initial confidential support to professional psychiatric help when needed.

Marium Fatima Becomes Bihar's First Female FIDE Master

- Name and Origin: Marium Fatima is a talented young chess player from Muzaffarpur, Bihar, who has made history by becoming the state's first Woman FIDE Master (WFM).
- **Achievement**: She achieved this milestone at the recently concluded Commonwealth Chess Championship, where she surpassed the 2000 FIDE rating mark required for the prestigious title, eventually achieving a FIDE rating of 2083.
- **Significance of WFM Title**: The Woman FIDE Master title recognizes Marium's international standard of play, requiring a FIDE rating threshold of 2100+, and marks her as a consistent performer in FIDE-sanctioned events.
- **Recognition and Future Goals**: Marium's achievement has been recognized by the Director General of Bihar State Sports Authority, Ravindran Shankaran.

IIT Kanpur & Vietnam National University Sign MoU

India rises to 38th position among 139 economies in the Global Innovation Index 2025

- Rank and Performance: India has climbed to the 38th position among 139 economies in the Global Innovation Index 2025, solidifying its lead in Central and Southern Asia and maintaining its status as an innovation overperformer for the 15th consecutive year.
- **Key Strengths**: India's strengths lie in its scale, entrepreneurial activity, and growing ability to translate scientific knowledge into commercial impact. It ranks 1st in ICT services exports, 4th in Late-stage VC deals, 8th in Intangible asset intensity, and 11th in Unicorn valuation.
- Innovation Ecosystem: India's innovation ecosystem is driven by a dynamic startup scene, a growing private sector, and increasing investment in R&D. However, challenges remain, particularly in infrastructure and R&D spending, which stood at only 0.65% of GDP in 2020.
- Comparison with Other Economies: India is part of a group of middle-income economies making significant strides in innovation, including China (10th), Türkiye (43rd), Vietnam (44th), and the Philippines (50th).

Dinesh K Patnaik Appointed India's Envoy to Canada

- **New Appointment**: Senior diplomat Dinesh K. Patnaik has been appointed as India's High Commissioner to Canada.
- **Previous Role**: He previously served as Director General of the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR).
- **Diplomatic Experience**: Patnaik is a seasoned Indian Foreign Service (IFS) officer of the 1990 batch, with experience in Europe, Asia, and Africa.
- **Context**: His appointment comes at a crucial time, amid strained India-Canada relations over diplomatic and security concerns.
- **Significance**: As High Commissioner, he will play a key role in strengthening bilateral ties, addressing challenges, and expanding cooperation in trade, education, and diaspora engagement.



Singapore ranked safest in Asia, 6th globally in Global Peace Index'25

- **Global Ranking**: Singapore is ranked 6th globally in the Global Peace Index 2025, making it the only Asian country in the top 10.
- **Asian Ranking**: Singapore is the safest country in Asia, followed by Japan (12th globally), Malaysia (13th globally), and Bhutan (not specified globally).
- **Peace Score**: Singapore scored 1.357 in the index, improving from 1.339 in 2024, reflecting its continued commitment to maintaining social stability.
- **Key Factors**: The ranking considers 23 indicators across three domains: societal safety and security, ongoing domestic and international conflict, and degree of militarization. Singapore excelled in societal safety and security.
- Global Context: The index highlights a concerning trend of declining global peacefulness, with 87 countries experiencing deterioration and 74 showing improvement in peacefulness.

Dr. Deepak Mittal appointed as India's New Envoy to UAE

- **Appointment**: Dr. Deepak Mittal, an Indian Foreign Service officer from the 1998 batch, has been appointed as the next Ambassador of India to the United Arab Emirates.
- **Background**: As a seasoned diplomat, Dr. Mittal brings extensive experience to his new role, further strengthening India's diplomatic ties with the UAE.
- **Assumption of Office**: He is expected to take up his new assignment shortly, although the exact date hasn't been specified.
- **Strategic Move**: This appointment reflects India's efforts to bolster its strategic partnership with the UAE, a key player in the Middle East region.

Rohit Rathish appointed as the next High Commissioner of India to the Republic of Seychelles

- **Appointment Details**: Rohit Rathish, a 2006 batch Indian Foreign Service (IFS) officer, has been appointed as the next High Commissioner of India to the Republic of Seychelles, according to the Ministry of External Affairs.
- Current Role: Rathish is currently serving as Joint Secretary in the Ministry of External Affairs and is expected to take up his new assignment shortly.
- **Diplomatic Relations**: India and Seychelles have historically enjoyed close diplomatic relations, with cooperation in areas like defense, security, and economic development. Prime Minister Narendra Modi's visit to Seychelles in 2015 marked a significant milestone in bilateral ties.



• **Strategic Importance**: The appointment highlights India's strategic interest in the Indian Ocean region, where Seychelles plays a crucial role. Strengthening ties with Seychelles is vital for India's maritime security and regional influence.

David Lammy becomes UK Deputy PM after Rayner's exit

- **Reason for Angela Rayner's Exit**: Angela Rayner resigned as Deputy Prime Minister and Labour's deputy leader following a probe into her tax affairs, specifically regarding underpaid stamp duty on an £800,000 flat in Hove.
- **David Lammy's Role**: David Lammy has been appointed as the new Deputy Prime Minister while retaining his position as Justice Secretary, overseeing critical issues like court backlogs, prison capacity, and confidence in the criminal justice system.
- **Responsibilities**: As Deputy Prime Minister, Lammy will stand in for Prime Minister Keir Starmer during his absence and act as a senior sounding board across the government, while also focusing on delivering reforms in the justice department.
- Labour Party's Next Steps: Rayner's exit triggers a deputy leadership contest within the Labour Party, which will test the party's coalition and potentially shape its tone and message heading into the next legislative crunch points.

Irfaan Ali re-elected as Guyana President

- **Election Results**: Irfaan Ali won a second term as President, with his People's Progressive Party/Civic (PPP/C) securing 36 seats in the National Assembly, an increase of three seats from the 2020 election. The party garnered over 55% of the popular vote.
- **International Observers**: The election process was monitored by several international groups, including the Organization of American States (OAS) and the Carter Center.
- **Opposition Performance**: The We Invest in Nationhood party, a newcomer led by US-sanctioned businessman Azruddin Mohamed, secured 24.87% of the votes and 16 seats, becoming the primary opposition.
- US Congratulations: The United States congratulated President Ali on his reelection, expressing commitment to strengthening bilateral ties between the two countries.

Japan PM Shigeru Ishiba Resigns

• **Reason for Resignation**: Shigeru Ishiba resigned as the Prime Minister of Japan and President of the Liberal Democratic Party (LDP) after the party's historic electoral defeat in the July 2025 polls, where the ruling coalition lost its majority.



- **Tenure and Timeline**: Ishiba took office in October 2024 and served for less than a year, announcing his resignation on September 7, 2025.
- Implications for Japanese Politics: Ishiba's resignation may lead to political instability, slowing legislative progress and disrupting diplomatic continuity, particularly in the Asia-Pacific region, ahead of the 2026 general elections.

Anutin Charnvirakul Elected Thailand's New PM

- **Election Outcome**: Anutin Charnvirakul secured over 247 votes in the Thai Parliament, winning the majority vote in the House of Representatives, which has 492 active members.
- **Background**: Charnvirakul, 58, is the leader of the Bhumjaithai party and has previously served in the government as Health Minister, where he successfully lobbied for the decriminalization of cannabis in Thailand.
- **Predecessor's Departure**: He succeeds Paetongtarn Shinawatra, who was dismissed from office by the court due to ethics violations, specifically engaging in a phone call with Cambodia's Senate President Hun Sen that led to a conflict between countries.
- Coalition Experience: Charnvirakul was part of Shinawatra's Cabinet and has experience working in coalition governments, including with the Pheu Thai party and the military-backed government under former Prime Minister Prayuth Chanocha.

Kokichi Akuzawa sets a Guinness World Record as Oldest man to summit Mount Fuji

- **Record-Breaking Age:** Kokichi Akuzawa, 102 years and 51 days old, became the oldest person to climb Mount Fuji, breaking the previous record held by Ichijiro Araya.
- **Training and Experience**: Akuzawa is an experienced climber and honorary chairman of the Gunma Mountaineering Club, with a habit of climbing mountains almost weekly. He trained specifically for the Mount Fuji climb by walking for an hour every morning.



- Assistance and Support: Akuzawa was assisted by his 70-year-old daughter, Motoe, during the climb. He credited her support as crucial in helping him reach the summit, especially when he felt like giving up on the third day.
- Challenging Climb: Akuzawa took three days to complete the climb, spending two nights in mountain huts. The climb was challenging due to decreasing atmospheric pressure and oxygen levels near the summit, as well as colder temperatures.

India & Israel Sign Bilateral Investment Agreement

- Landmark Agreement: The agreement was signed between Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman and Israel's Finance Minister Bezalel Smotrich in New Delhi, marking a significant step in promoting investments between the two countries.
- **Protection for Investors**: The treaty ensures that Israeli investors in India and Indian investors in Israel receive protection, adhering to international precedents and practices, including a minimum standard of treatment and non-discrimination.
- **Dispute Settlement**: The agreement provides for an independent forum for dispute settlement through arbitration, boosting investor confidence and comfort level.
- **Investment Promotion**: Israel has made \$337.77 million in foreign direct investment (FDI) in India between April 2000 and June 2025, and this agreement aims to further enhance economic ties and explore financial protocols for Israeli exporters.

François Bayrou Ousted as French Prime Minister

- **Vote of No Confidence**: Bayrou's government collapsed after a decisive vote of no confidence in the National Assembly, with 364 lawmakers voting against him and only 194 in favor.
- Controversial Austerity Measures: The no-confidence motion was triggered due to Bayrou's minority government pushing for controversial austerity measures, which ultimately led to his ousting.
- **Heavy Defeat**: The vote marked a significant defeat for Bayrou, who had staked his leadership on the austerity measures, indicating a loss of trust from the lawmakers.
- Collapse of Administration: The vote has officially ended Bayrou's tenure as Prime Minister, bringing his administration to an end.

Emmanuel Macron Taps Loyalist Lecornu as New Prime Minister



- Youngest Prime Minister: Gabriel Attal, at 34 years old, became the youngest person to hold the office of Prime Minister in France's modern history.
- **Background**: Attal previously served as the Minister of Education and has held other key positions, including government spokesperson and budget minister, which raised his profile.

- **Impact**: Attal's personal popularity and outsider perspective may help Macron reconnect with disaffected voters.

Irfaan Ali Wins Second Term as Guyana's President

- **Re-election**: Irfaan Ali has been re-elected for a second term as the President of Guyana, following a successful general election held on September 1, 2025.
- **Party Majority**: His party, the People's Progressive Party/Civic (PPP/C), won a majority in parliament, granting Ali a renewed mandate to lead the country.
- Oil Wealth: Ali's re-election comes at a time when Guyana is experiencing vast oil wealth, which is expected to significantly impact the country's economy and development.
- **Geopolitical Challenges**: As President, Ali will have to navigate complex geopolitical challenges, balancing relationships with various countries while making decisions that benefit Guyana's growth and stability.
- **New Term**: With this re-election, Ali will continue to guide Guyana through a critical period in its history, shaping the country's future and making key decisions on its development trajectory.

Norway PM Jonas Gahr Stoere Secured 2nd Term

- Støre's Labour Party-led government secured a second term after a closely fought election, with the center-left bloc winning a narrow majority of seats.
- The election was heavily influenced by voter concerns over the rising cost of living and the geopolitical impacts of the wars in Ukraine and Gaza.
- The re-election came despite a significant surge in support for the populist, right-wing Progress Party, which achieved its best-ever result and became the second-largest party in parliament.



• Støre's government will remain a minority administration and will rely on smaller, left-leaning parties to pass critical legislation, which will likely involve difficult negotiations on issues such as wealth taxes and future oil exploration.

Larry Ellison Surpasses Elon Musk as World's Richest

- Larry Ellison, co-founder of Oracle, temporarily became the world's wealthiest person, surpassing Elon Musk, after an unprecedented surge in Oracle's stock price.
- The dramatic shift in wealth was triggered by a blockbuster earnings report from Oracle, which included a highly aggressive outlook for its AI-driven cloud services.
- Ellison's fortune increased by an extraordinary amount in a single day, marking the largest one-day wealth increase ever recorded on the Bloomberg Billionaires Index.
- Ellison's net worth is closely tied to his significant stake in Oracle, and the stock rally was fueled by major contracts, including one with OpenAI, that underscore the company's growing role in the AI infrastructure market.

Dharmendra Pradhan Launches First Overseas Atal Innovation Centre in UAE

- The new center will serve as an innovation hub to nurture joint start-ups and research-led ventures by innovators from both India and the UAE.
- It aims to promote bilateral collaboration in cutting-edge fields like deep tech, AI, clean energy, and healthcare.
- The center is a part of the Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), which is a flagship initiative by the Government of India to foster a culture of innovation and entrepreneurship.
- This center will also act as a gateway for Indian start-ups to access and penetrate the markets of the Middle East.
- During his visit, Pradhan also launched new academic programs, including a Ph.D. program in Energy and Sustainability and a B.Tech program in Chemical Engineering, at the IIT Delhi-Abu Dhabi campus.

Sushila Karki Sworn In as Nepal's First Woman Prime Minister

• A Symbol of Integrity and Neutrality: Karki, 73, is widely respected for her distinguished career as a jurist and her reputation for integrity and fairness. She previously made history as Nepal's first and only woman Chief Justice, serving from 2016 to 2017. Her anti-corruption stance and judicial independence made her a consensus candidate, acceptable to both the youth-led protest movement and traditional political forces seeking a neutral figure to lead the country out of the crisis.



- Endorsement from "Gen Z" Protesters: The recent protests were sparked by a social media ban but quickly evolved into a broader movement against political corruption and nepotism. The protestors, largely young people, played a key role in the selection process, advocating for a leader from outside the established political elite. Karki's name was put forward by their representatives, highlighting a rare moment of public-driven choice in Nepal's political landscape.
- **Dissolution of Parliament and Call for Elections**: As part of her appointment, Nepal's President Ram Chandra Paudel dissolved the House of Representatives and announced new parliamentary elections to be held in March 2026.

- **Indigenous Technology**: The microprocessor features a custom, indigenous instruction set, ensuring full strategic control and self-reliance. ISRO has also developed in-house software tools, including an Ada cross-compiler, assembler, linker, and simulator.

India-Thailand Military Drill Exercise MAITREE-XIV Begins

- Exercise Details: The 14th edition of Exercise MAITREE commenced on September 1, 2025, at the Joint Training Node (JTN) in Umroi, Meghalaya, and will run until September 14, 2025.
- **Participating Forces**: The exercise involves 120 personnel from the Indian Army's Madras Regiment and 53 personnel from the Royal Thai Army's 1st Infantry Battalion, 14th Infantry Brigade.

- **Ship Features**: The vessel is 77.6 meters long and 10.5 meters wide, with a draught of only 2.7 meters, allowing it to operate in shallow waters. It's propelled by three diesel-driven water jets, reaching a maximum speed of 25 knots.
- **Primary Role**: INS Androth is designed for anti-submarine operations in coastal waters, low-intensity maritime operations, and mine-laying operations. It's equipped with advanced sensors and ordnance, including hull-mounted sonar and low-frequency variable depth sonar.
- **Armament**: The ship carries lightweight torpedoes, ASW rockets, and mines, as well as a close-in weapon system (30 mm gun) and 16.7 mm stabilized remote-controlled guns.
- **Induction Significance**: INS Androth is the first of a series of eight anti-submarine warfare shallow-watercraft being built for the Indian Navy, marking a significant milestone in the country's indigenous defence capabilities.

US, South Korea & Japan Launch Freedom Edge Military Exercise

- **First country to land near the lunar South Pole**: The Chandrayaan-3 mission in 2023 made India the first nation to successfully land a spacecraft near the Moon's unexplored South Pole.
- Three records in cryogenic technology: Between 2014 and 2017, India achieved three global records in the development of the LVM3 cryogenic stage, including its fastest maiden flight.

India won 3 bronze medals at the World Boxing Championships

- The medals were won by three Indian women boxers: Jaismine Lamboria, Pooja Rani, and Nupur Sheoran.
- Jaismine Lamboria secured a bronze in the 57kg category by defeating her opponent from Uzbekistan in the quarter-finals.
- Pooja Rani, a veteran boxer, clinched her medal in the 80kg category, a non-Olympic weight division.
- Nupur Sheoran, the granddaughter of legendary boxer Hawa Singh, earned her bronze in the +80kg super heavyweight division.
- The medals were a significant achievement for the Indian contingent, especially as two-time world champion Nikhat Zareen was unexpectedly defeated in her quarter-final bout.

Bangladesh Clinch First-Ever T20 Win Over Hong Kong in Asia Cup



- **First-Ever T20I Victory over Hong Kong**: This match marked a significant milestone for Bangladesh, as it was their first-ever T20 International win against Hong Kong. The two teams had only met once before in the format, back in the 2014 T20 World Cup, where Hong Kong surprisingly emerged victorious.
- Litton Das's Match-Winning Half-Century: Bangladesh's captain, Litton Das, was the star of the show, earning the Player of the Match award for his impressive knock. He scored a fluent 59 off 39 balls, steering his team's chase after they had lost two early wickets.
- **Disciplined Bowling Performance by Bangladesh**: Bangladesh's bowlers were effective in restricting Hong Kong's scoring. Pace bowlers Taskin Ahmed and Tanzim Hasan Sakib, along with leg-spinner Rishad Hossain, each took two wickets, helping to contain Hong Kong to a manageable total of 143 for 7.
- Hong Kong's Improved Batting Effort: While Hong Kong lost the match, they showed an improved batting performance compared to their previous game.

Jaismine Lamboria Wins Gold at World Boxing Championships

- Weight Category: Jaismine Lamboria won gold in the women's 57kg category at the 2025 World Boxing Championships.
- **Opponent**: She defeated Poland's Julia Szeremeta, a Paris Olympics silver medalist, with a 4-1 win in the final.
- **Performance**: Lamboria adjusted her rhythm after losing the opening round, using sharp jabs and controlled distance to dominate the bout with scores of 30-27, 29-28, 30-27, 28-29, and 29-28.
- **Historic Win**: This victory marked a career-defining moment for Lamboria, who bounced back strongly after an early exit at the Paris 2024 Olympics.
- India's Medal Tally: Lamboria's gold was one of four medals won by India in the championships, with Minakshi Hooda also winning gold in the 48kg category, Nupur Sheoran securing silver, and Pooja Rani claiming bronze.

Ex-New Zealand coach Gary Stead named as head coach for 2025–26 Ranji Trophy

- **Appointment**: Gary Stead, the former New Zealand coach, has been appointed as the head coach of Andhra Pradesh's Ranji Trophy team for the 2025-26 season.
- **Background**: Stead had a successful seven-year stint with the New Zealand cricket team, leading them to a World Test Championship win and finishing as runners-up in the 2019 World Cup.



- **Team Expectations**: Andhra Pradesh Cricket Association (APCA) hopes Stead will transform their team, which had a tough season last year, finishing sixth in Group B with just one win and three losses in seven games.

- Comeback from Loss: Vaishali showed resilience by recovering from a loss in round eight against Bibisara Assaubayeva, stabilizing her tournament with crucial wins and draws.



• Second Consecutive Win: This victory marks Vaishali's second FIDE Women's Grand Swiss title, following her win in 2023, showcasing her consistency and skill at the highest level.

Mohammed Siraj Named ICC Men's Player of August 2025

- **Award-Winning Performance**: Mohammed Siraj won the ICC Men's Player of the Month award for August 2025 due to his exceptional performance in the final Test of the Anderson-Tendulkar Trophy against England at The Oval.
- **Match-Winning Spell**: Siraj took 9 wickets at an average of 21.11 across both innings in the final Test, helping India win the match by 6 runs and level the series 2-2. He was awarded Player of the Match for his efforts.
- **Series Highlights**: Siraj was the only Indian pacer to feature in all five Test matches against England, becoming the leading wicket-taker with 23 wickets at an average of 32.43, including two five-wicket hauls.
- Career Milestones: This award-winning performance also earned Siraj a career-best ranking in the ICC Men's Test Bowler Rankings. His consistent performances have drawn praise from cricket legends like Sachin Tendulkar, who felt Siraj's contributions are often underappreciated.

India's Anandkumar Wins First Gold Medal At Speed Skating World Championships

- **First Indian Gold Medalist:** Anandkumar Velkumar, a 22-year-old Indian speed skater, won India's first-ever gold medal at the 2025 Speed Skating World Championships in the men's 1000m sprint event.

Smriti Mandhana reclaims No. 1 spot in ICC Women's ODI batting rankings

• **Reclaiming the Top Spot**: Smriti Mandhana has regained her position as the No. 1 ranked batter in ODI cricket, a feat she last achieved in 2019. She now holds 735 rating points, surpassing England's Nat Sciver-Brunt by four points.


