



1. Justice B.R. Gavai Sworn in as the 52nd CJI

Justice B.R. Gavai has been sworn in as the 52nd Chief Justice of India, marking a significant moment in the history of the Indian judiciary. He succeeds Chief Justice Sanjeev Khanna and will serve a tenure that is expected to uphold the values of justice and constitutional integrity. Justice Gavai is only the second Dalit to become the Chief Justice of India, following in the footsteps of Justice K.G.



Balakrishnan. Known for his deep understanding of constitutional law and a balanced judicial approach, Justice Gavai has had a distinguished career in the legal field. His appointment is seen as a step forward in promoting diversity and representation in the judiciary.

- **Judicial Background**: Justice Gavai began practicing law at 25 and was appointed judge at the Bombay High Court in 2003. He was later elevated to the Supreme Court on May 24, 2019.
- Sub-classification within Scheduled Castes: Justice Gavai advocated for the application of the "creamy layer" principle to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes, ensuring real equality.
- **Protection of Individual Rights**: Justice Gavai declared the arrest of NewsClick founder Prabir Purkayastha as illegal, emphasizing the importance of supplying grounds of arrest to the accused.

• **Prolific Judge**: During his tenure, Justice Gavai has served on over 700 benches and authored around 300 judgments, showcasing his significant contributions to various legal fields.

2. India Ranks Among Top Six Patent Filers in 6G Technology

India has emerged as a significant player in the global race for 6G technology, now ranking among the top six countries in 6G patent filings. This advancement is part of the government's proactive approach under the 'Bharat 6G Vision', aiming to position India at the forefront of 6G design, development, and deployment by 2030. The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has been



instrumental in this progress, funding next-generation testbeds and evaluating numerous proposals to accelerate 6G research. India's goal is to contribute 10% of global 6G patents and one-sixth of the global standards in the next three years. This strategic push is supported by collaborations between the government, academia, and industry leaders, fostering a robust innovation ecosystem.

- Ranking and Potential Impact: India is now among the top six nations globally in 6G patent filings, with the potential to add \$1 trillion to the economy by 2035. This ranking positions India alongside major global players like the US, China, Japan, South Korea, and the European Union.
- **Government Support and Funding**: The government has funded over 111 research projects with 300 crore to support innovation in 6G technology. Initiatives like "Bharat 6G Vision" and "Bharat 6G Alliance" aim to drive technological innovation and collaboration.
- **Research and Development**: India is focusing on key areas like spectrum efficiency, AI integration, and quantum communication to develop 6G technology. The country has also established research centers and partnerships with global universities and tech companies.
- Patent Filings and Global Standards: India could secure 10% of all 6G patents globally and contribute one-sixth to global standards within the next three years. The Department of Telecommunications has launched a patent and IPR support framework to encourage inventors and organizations to file patents.

3. Anita Anand appointed as Canada's Foreign Minister

Anita Anand has been appointed as Canada's new Minister of Foreign Affairs, marking a historic milestone as the first Hindu woman and the first woman of Indian origin to hold this position. Born in Kentville, Nova Scotia, to Indian immigrant parents, Anand

has had a distinguished career as a law professor and politician. She previously served as Canada's Minister of National Defence, where she played a key role in addressing military misconduct and supporting Ukraine during the Russian invasion. Anand took her oath of office on the Bhagavad Gita, reflecting her cultural and religious heritage. Anand's leadership is expected to influence Canada's approach to international affairs, including its relations with India and the United States.

- Background: Anand is a lawyer, academic, and politician. She holds four degrees, including a Bachelor of Arts in political studies from Queen's University and a Bachelor of Laws from Dalhousie University.
- Minister of National Defence: She played a central role in Canada's efforts to provide military aid to Ukraine during the 2022 Russian invasion.
- Minister of Public Services and Procurement: Anand oversaw Canada's procurement of vaccines and personal protective equipment during the COVID-19 pandemic.

4. Neeraj Chopra conferred with Honorary Lt. Colonel Rank in Territorial Army

Neeraj Chopra, India's celebrated javelin thrower and double Olympic medalist, has been conferred the honorary rank of Lieutenant Colonel in the Territorial Army. The Ministry of Defence announced this recognition on May 13, 2025, with the appointment effective from April 16, 2025, as per the Gazette of India. Chopra's military journey began in 2016



when he joined the Indian Army as a Naib Subedar under the sports quota, eventually rising to the rank of Subedar Major by 2024. The honorary rank acknowledges his exceptional contributions to Indian sports and his embodiment of military values such as discipline and dedication.

• Honorary Rank: Neeraj Chopra, the Olympic gold medalist and javelin ace, has been bestowed with the honorary rank of Lieutenant Colonel in the Territorial Army, effective April 16, 2025. This prestigious title recognizes his outstanding achievements in sports and his prior service in the armed forces.





- **Previous Military Service**: Chopra had previously held the rank of Naib Subedar in 2016 and was later promoted to Subedar and Subedar Major in 2021 and 2024, respectively. He was due for retirement this year, making the honorary commission a notable recognition of his contributions.
- **Presidential Endorsement**: The honorary title was conferred by the President of India under Para 31 of the Territorial Army Regulations, 1948.
- **Achievements**: Neeraj Chopra has etched his name in history with a gold medal at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics and a silver medal at the 2024 Paris Olympics. He has also won gold at the 2023 World Athletics Championships in Budapest, solidifying his legacy in javelin throwing.

6. DST & DRDO Join Hands to Strengthen India's Space Surveillance

India is intensifying its focus on space surveillance and situational awareness through strategic collaborations between key scientific and defense institutions. The Aryabhatta Research Institute of Observational Sciences (ARIES), under the Department of Science & Technology (DST), has partnered with Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL) to develop technologies aimed at tracking space objects,



including near-Earth objects and artificial satellites. These concerted efforts underscore India's commitment to strengthening its space infrastructure and ensuring the safety and security of its assets in the increasingly contested space domain.

- DRDO's Naval Technology Advancements: DRDO has inaugurated a state-of-the-art facility called the Submersible Platform for Acoustic Characterisation and Evaluation (SPACE) at the Underwater Acoustic Research Facility in Kulamavu, Idukki, Kerala.
- Enhancing Anti-Submarine Warfare Capabilities: The SPACE facility is designed to evaluate complete sonar systems, allowing for quick deployment and easy recovery of scientific packages.
- Advanced Research and Development: DRDO is working on various projects, including aerodynamics and materials research. They are also focusing on developing technologies that can be used for defense and space applications.
- **Exporting Defense Technology**: DRDO believes that exporting defense technology to friendly countries can strengthen India's strategic position globally, secure international partnerships and create high-tech industry and employment opportunities.

7. ONDC appoints Vibhor Jain as acting CEO

The Open Network for Digital Commerce (ONDC) has appointed Vibhor Jain as its acting Chief Executive Officer (CEO), effective immediately. Previously serving as the Chief Operating Officer (COO) and a member of the eightmember Executive Committee, Jain's elevation comes in the wake of several top-level departures, including that of



founding CEO Thampy Koshy, Chief Business Officer Shireesh Joshi, and Non-

Executive Chairperson R.S. Sharma. This move aims to provide cohesive execution and stability as ONDC continues its mission to democratize digital commerce across India.

- **Leadership Role**: Jain, who previously served as the Chief Operating Officer (COO) of ONDC, will now lead the organization during this interim phase, overseeing key strategic decisions and driving cohesive execution.
- Executive Committee: Prior to Jain's appointment, an 8-member executive committee, which included Jain, managed ONDC's responsibilities. The committee's interim role has now concluded, with Jain taking over as the single point of leadership.
- **Transaction Milestone**: ONDC has crossed over 200 million transactions since its inception in 2021, showcasing its growth and impact in the digital commerce sector. The platform connects sellers and buyer apps across sectors like mobility, food delivery, logistics, ecommerce, and fashion.

8. BillDesk M N Srinivasu appointed as IAMAI chairperson

M.N. Srinivasu, co-founder of BillDesk, has been appointed as the new chairman of the Internet and Mobile Association of India (IAMAI) for the 2025–2027 term. He succeeds Harsh Jain, co-founder and CEO of Dream Sports, who held the position from 2023 to 2025. Joining Srinivasu on the executive council are Harshil Mathur, CEO and co-founder of Razorpay,



as Vice Chairman, and Sameer Nigam, founder and CEO of PhonePe, as Treasurer. This leadership transition reflects the growing influence of India's fintech sector within the digital ecosystem.

9. Shri Rajeev Kalra appointed as Director of Finance, Yantra India Ltd.

Mujica's passing has prompted an outpouring of grief and tributes from around the world. In



Montevideo, thousands gathered to honor his legacy, with a funeral procession that included his widow, Lucía Topolansky, and President Orsi, who draped the national flag over his coffin. The government declared three days of national mourning, and



his body was cremated and interred near his farmhouse in Rincón del Cerro, as per his wishes.

- **Legacy**: He is remembered for his personal ethics, integrity, and commitment to social justice, inspiring many in Uruguay and across Latin America.
