

1. GLUTTONOUS (ADJECTIVE): लालची

Pronunciation: glut·ton·ous

Meaning: excessively greedy or indulgent in eating; voracious.

Synonyms: greedy, ravenous, voracious

Antonyms: moderate, restrained, temperate

Sentence: The gluttonous behavior of the character in the movie portrayed his insatiable desire for food.

2. INIMITABLE (ADJECTIVE): अद्वितीय

Pronunciation: uhn·i·muh·tuh·bl

Meaning: very unusual or of very high quality and therefore impossible to copy; unique or unparalleled.

Synonyms: incomparable, unmatched, unparalleled

Antonyms: imitable, ordinary, common

Sentence: The artist's paintings were truly inimitable, showcasing his unique style and creativity.

3. DELVE (VERB): खोदना

Pronunciation: delv

Meaning: to search inside something.

Synonyms: cave, abyss, antre

Antonyms: fill (in), smooth

Sentence: The journalist will delve into the matter to find the truth.

4. ELUDE (VERB): टाल जाना

Pronunciation: uh·lood

Meaning: to escape from or avoid someone or something, typically in a skillful or cunning way.

Synonyms: evade, avoid, escape

Antonyms: confront, face, encounter

Sentence: The thief managed to elude the police by sneaking out through the back door.

5. SPURIOUS (VERB): जाली

Pronunciation: spyoo·ree·uhs

Meaning : false or fake; not genuine or authentic.

Synonyms: false, counterfeit, fake

Antonyms: genuine, authentic, real

Sentence: The salesman tried to sell me a spurious watch claiming it was a luxury brand.

6. AVENGE (VERB): प्रतिशोध लेना

Pronunciation: uh·venj

Meaning: to take revenge or seek retribution for a wrongdoing.

Synonyms: retaliate, revenge, punish

Antonyms: forgive, pardon, excuse

Sentence: He vowed to avenge the death of his brother by bringing the culprits to justice.

7. INCULCATE (VERB): मन में बैठाना

Pronunciation: in·kuhl·kayt

Meaning: to make somebody learn or remember ideas, habits, etc. especially by repeating them often.

Synonyms: instill, implant, indoctrinate

Antonyms: unlearn, forget, neglect

Sentence: Parents play a crucial role in inculcating good values in their children.

8. MYRIAD (NOUN): असंख्य

Pronunciation: mi·ree·uhd

Meaning: countless or extremely great number, a large variety or assortment.

Synonyms: countless, infinite, numerous

Antonyms: limited, few, finite

Sentence: There is myriad of stars in the sky on a clear night.

9. RESPITE (NOUN): राहत

Pronunciation: ri·spite

Meaning: a pause or rest from something difficult or unpleasant.

Synonyms: rest, pause, break

Antonyms: continuation, burden, strain

Sentence: After working for hours, he took a short respite to recharge his energy.

10. AMENABLE (ADJECTIVE): उत्तरदायी

Pronunciation: uh.mee.nuh.bl

Meaning: happy to accept something; willing to be influenced by somebody/something.

Synonyms: acquiescent, biddable, docile

Antonyms: uncooperative, contrary, willful

Sentence: Very few web sites are not amenable to this way of thinking.

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
