

1. FELICITOUS(ADJECTIVE): परम सुखी

Pronunciation: fuh·li·suh·tuhs

Meaning: well chosen or suited to the circumstances. Synonyms: well chosen, choice, apt Antonyms: inappropriate, ghastly, horrid Sentence: It was a <u>felicitous</u> phrase.

2. OPACITY(NOUN): अस्पष्टता

Pronunciation: oh·pa·suh·tee
Meaning: the quality of being difficult to see through; the fact of being opaque.
Synonyms: mystery, uncertainity, depth
Antonyms: clarity, brightness, plainness
Sentence: One has to face a lot of difficulty and <u>opacity</u> in Shakespeare's texts.

3. THWART(VERB): विफल

Pronunciation: thvawt
Meaning: to stop somebody doing what he/she planned to do; to prevent something happening.
Synonyms: frustrated,foled, balked
Antonyms: promoted, advanced, aided
Sentence: She did all she could to thwart his plans.

4. IGNOMINY (NOUN): बदनामी

Pronunciation: ig·nuh·muh·nee
Meaning: public shame and embarrassment; a loss of honour.
Synonyms: humiliation, shame, infamy
Antonyms: honour, respect, fear
Sentence: He had to face ignominy due to his son.

5. DISSUADE(VERB): विरत करना



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Pronunciation: duh·svayd

Meaning: to persuade somebody not to do something. Synonyms: discourage, prevent, deter Antonyms: persuade, encourage, urge Sentence: My friends try to <u>dissuade</u> me from flying.

6. OUTGOING(ADJECTIVE): जावक

Pronunciation: awt·goh·uhng Meaning: friendly and interested in other people and new experiences. **Synonyms:** social, frieldly, sociable **Antonyms:** distant, antisocial, aloof **Sentence:** The <u>outgoing</u> PM was honored by all.

7. EXPLICATE(VERB): बयान

Pronunciation: ek·spluh·kayt
Meaning: to explain an idea, a work of literature, theory etc. in a lot of detail.
Synonyms: clarify, spell out, explain
Antonyms: obscure, confuse, cloud
Sentence: An attempt was made to explicate the relationship between crime and justice.

8. EMBRACE(VERB): अपनाना

Pronunciation: eh·brays
Meaning: to put your arms around somebody as a sign of love, happiness, etc.
Synonyms: accept, take up, clasp
Antonyms: reject
Sentence: Besides traditional methods, artists are <u>embracing</u> new technology.

9. ESCHEW(VERB): छोड़ना

Pronunciation: uhs·choo Meaning: deliberately avoid using; abstain from. Synonyms: avoid, evade, shun Antonyms: accept, embrace, seek Sentence: The minister appealed to the crowd to <u>eschew</u> violence.

10. WRECK(VERB): जहाज के मलबे

Pronunciation: rek Meaning: a ship that has sunk or been badly damaged at sea. **Synonyms:** spoil, disrupt, rubble



Antonyms: facilitate, salvage, salvaging Sentence: An eye injury <u>wrecked</u> his chances of a professional career.
