



1. Salmon Rushdie Honored with Dayton Peace Prize Award 2025

• Award Details: The Ambassador Richard C. Holbrooke Distinguished Achievement Award, also known as the Lifetime Achievement Award, is a prestigious recognition of Rushdie's work in promoting peace through literature.



- **Literary Merit**: Rushdie's award recognizes his literary merit and commitment to peace, joining past recipients like Jimmy Carter, Elie Wiesel, and Margaret Atwood.
- **Recent Work**: Rushdie's latest work, "The Eleventh Hour," features three novellas and two short stories, marking his 23rd publication.
- **Inspiration for Peace**: In his acceptance speech, Rushdie emphasized the power of literature to promote peace, saying, "A book cannot stop a bullet. A poem cannot intercept a bomb," but writers can express solidarity with those suffering.
- Overcoming Adversity: Rushdie received the award after publishing his first work of fiction since being stabbed on a New York lecture stage in 2022, showcasing his resilience and dedication to his craft.

2. Sergio Gor Sworn In as US Ambassador to India

- Youngest Ambassador: At 38, Sergio Gor is the youngest US Ambassador to India, making him a key player in strengthening US-India relations.
- Strategic Partnership: Gor's appointment highlights the growing significance of the US-India partnership in





- maintaining regional stability and promoting economic collaboration, particularly in countering China's influence in Asia.

- **Diplomatic Experience**: Before becoming Ambassador, Gor served as Director of Presidential Personnel in the Trump administration, overseeing over 4,000 posts, and has met with Prime Minister Narendra Modi and other senior officials.
- **Strengthening Ties:** Gor's swearing-in ceremony, attended by President Donald Trump and Vice President J.D. Vance, underscores the priority Washington places on its relationship with New Delhi, aiming to advance strategic interests and expand trade ties.

3. India Unveils First MWh-Scale Vanadium Flow Battery at NTPC

• India's First MWh-Scale Vanadium Flow Battery: The 3 MWh Vanadium Redox Flow Battery (VRFB) system is a major milestone in India's journey towards long-duration energy storage (LDES) solutions, enhancing renewable energy integration and grid resilience.



- **Advanced Technology**: The VRFB uses vanadium ions in different oxidation states to store chemical energy, offering a longer lifespan (over 20 years), high recyclability, and scalability, making it a promising alternative to traditional lithium-ion batteries.
- **Inauguration and Collaboration**: The system was inaugurated by Power Minister Manohar Lal at NTPC NETRA, with senior officials from the Ministry of Power and NTPC in attendance, showcasing India's capabilities in innovation and technology.
- Renewable Energy Integration: The VRFB will support NETRA's microgrid operations, providing full-day energy autonomy and moving the campus closer to self-sufficiency, aligning with India's vision of increasing renewable energy in its energy mix.
- **Indigenous Technology**: The project demonstrates 100% indigenous technology and a supply chain independent of foreign components, reducing dependence on imported materials and promoting energy security.

4. 6th India-Vietnam Army Exercise VINBAX Begins



• **Objective**: The exercise aims to enhance interoperability and share best practices in UN peacekeeping operations, promoting regional stability and security.



- Participation: The Indian delegation is led by Defence Secretary Rajesh Kumar Singh, while the Vietnamese contingent is headed by Deputy Chief of General Staff Senior Lieutenant General Phung Si Tan.
- **Focus Areas**: The exercise focuses on joint military capabilities, engineering tasks, medical support, and disaster management, aligning with India's Act East Policy.
- **Significance**: VINBAX reinforces India's strategic engagement with Southeast Asia and showcases its commitment to regional security and defence diplomacy.
- **History:** The exercise series, initiated in 2018, alternates between India and Vietnam, with the previous edition held in Ambala, Haryana, in 2024.

- **Olympic Experience**: As a two-time Olympian, Tomar has represented India at the Tokyo 2020 and Paris 2024 Olympics, solidifying his position as a top shooter.
- India's Medal Tally: Tomar's silver medal contributed to India's second position in the medal tally, with three gold, five silver, and three bronze medals.
