

#### 1. DELVE (verb) : खोजना

**Pronunciation:** delv

**Meaning:** reach inside a receptacle and search for something. **Synonyms:** rummage (around) in, search (through), hunt through

**Antonyms:** fill, find, ignore

**Sentence:** It's not always a good idea to <u>delve</u> too deeply into someone's past.

#### 2. IMPINGE (verb): प्रभावित करना

Pronunciation: im-pinj

Meaning: have an effect or impact, especially a negative one.

**Synonyms:** affect, have an effect on, influence

Antonyms: leave alone, avoid, dodge

**Sentence:** She didn't allow her personal problems to <u>impinge</u> on her work.

## 3. TRENCHANT (adj.) : कटु

**Pronunciation:** trench·uhnt

**Meaning:** vigorous or incisive in expression or style.

**Synonyms:** rapierlike, vigorous **Antonyms:** dull, soft, vague

**Sentence:** He was shattered and bewildered by this <u>trenchant</u> criticism.

#### 4. REPUDIATE (verb): अस्वीकार करना

**Pronunciation:** ruh·pyoo·dee·ayt

Meaning: refuse to accept or be associated with.

Synonyms: reject, renounce, abandon Antonyms: accept, affirm, embrace

**Sentence:** She has <u>repudiated</u> policies associated with previous party leaders.

# 5. POMP (noun) : वैभव

**Pronunciation:** pawmp

**Meaning:** ceremony and splendid display, especially at a public event.

Synonyms: ceremony, grandeur, pageantry

**Antonyms:** simplicity, severity

**Sentence:** The coronation was conducted with great <u>pomp</u>.

### 6. SUNDRY (adj.) : विविध

**Pronunciation:** suhn · drai

Meaning: of various kinds; several

**Synonyms:** various, varied, miscellaneous

**Antonyms:** alike, identical, like

**Sentence:** This cream can be used to treat <u>sundry</u> minor injuries.

#### 7. SCINTILLATE (verb) : चमकना

**Pronunciation:** sin·tuhl·ayt

Meaning: emit flashes of light; sparkle.

Synonyms: spark, sparkle, shine

Antonyms: dark, dim

**Sentence:** The diamond ring is <u>scintillated</u> in the sunlight.

#### 8. ANNULLED (verb) : रद्द करना

Pronunciation: uh · nuhld

Meaning: declare invalid (an official agreement, decision, or result).

**Synonyms:** declare invalid, nullify, invalidate **Antonyms:** allowed, approved, authorized

Sentence: His second marriage was annulled because he never divorced his first wife.

#### 9. ENTHUSE (verb) : अति उत्साहित करना

**Pronunciation:** uhn thyooz

Meaning: say something that expresses one's eager enjoyment, interest, or approval.

**Synonyms:** rave, be enthusiastic, gush **Antonyms:** averse, disinclined, hesitant

**Sentence:** A good retailer will <u>enthuse</u> his stock and tempt you to try new foods.

## 10. PROVENANCE (noun) : उत्पत्ति

**Pronunciation:** praw·vuh·nuhns


**Meaning:** the place of origin or earliest known history of something.

**Synonyms:** origin, source, place of origin **Antonyms:** conclusion, effect, result.

**Sentence:** The <u>provenance</u> of the paintings is unknown.
