




DAILY VOCAB DOSE

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Exceptional words of English vocabulary from the newspaper 'The Hindu' are listed here. 1. VAINGLORIOUS (adj.) : गुमानी

Pronunciation: vayn·glaw·ree·uhs

Meaning: excessively proud of oneself or one's achievements; overly vain.

Synonyms: assured, biggety, complacent **Antonyms:** egoless, humble, modest

Sentence: The vainglorious trainer spent more flexing his muscles than he did helping

build his clients.

2. STEADFASTLY (adv.): लगातार

Pronunciation: sted-faast-lee

Meaning: in a resolutely or dutifully firm and unwavering manner.

Synonyms: continuously, ploddingly, steadily **Antonyms:** indolently, desultorily, tiredly

Sentence: She was <u>steadfastly</u> in support of women's rights.

3. STUTTER (verb) : हकलाना

Pronunciation: stuh-tuh

Meaning: talk with continued involuntary repetition of sounds, especially initial

consonants.

Synonyms: stammer, stumble, speak haltingly **Antonyms:** enunciate, pronounce, articulate **Sentence:** I used to <u>stutter</u> when I was a child.

4. CAGEY (adj.) : गुप्त

Pronunciation: kay-jee

Meaning: reluctant to give information owing to caution or suspicion.

Synonyms: secretive, guarded, noncommittal

Antonyms: disposed, open, frank

Sentence: Manufacturers are <u>cagey</u> about the recipes they use to create a wine.

5. AVOWAL (noun) : घोषणा-पत्र

Pronunciation: uh·vau·uhl

Meaning: a solemn and often public declaration of the truth or existence of something

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Synonyms: affirmation, assertion, asseveration

Antonyms: disavowal, denial

Sentence: The press carried his <u>avowal</u> throughout the country.

6. UNBRIDLED (adj.): निरंकुश

Pronunciation: uhn brai dld

Meaning: uncontrolled; unconstrained.

Synonyms: unrestrained, unconstrained, uncontrolled

Antonyms: bridled, constrained, controlled

Sentence: This case was solved only because of one detective's <u>unbridled</u> determination to

bring the killer to justice

7. NONPLUSSED (adj.) : भौचक

Pronunciation: nawn.pluhst

Meaning: (of a person) surprised and confused so much that they are unsure how to react.

Synonyms: confused, bewildered, bemused

Antonyms: undaunted, unfazed

Sentence: I was completely <u>nonplussed</u> by his sudden appearance.

8. CONFLAGRATION (noun) : भीषण आग

Pronunciation: kawn·fluh·gray·shn

Meaning: an extensive fire that destroys a great deal of land or property.

Synonyms: fire, blaze, flames

Antonyms: demilitarization, demobilization, disarmament

Sentence: A <u>conflagration</u> in 1947 reduced 90 percent of the houses to ashes.

9. PRATTLING (verb) : बकवास

Pronunciation: pra·tuhl·uhng

Meaning: talk at length in a foolish or inconsequential way.

Synonyms: chatter, babble, prate

Antonyms: articulating, enunciating, pronouncing

Sentence: The villagers are <u>prattling</u> on about the village gossip.

10. INUNDATION (noun) : सैलाब

Pronunciation: i.nuhn.day.shn


Meaning: a great flow of water or of something that overwhelms.

Synonyms: overflow, deluge, torrent **Antonyms:** drought, dribble, drip

Sentence: The family's shed was washed away in the last <u>inundation</u>.

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
