2. India's Q2 FY26 GDP to Rise To Nearly 7.2%

• **Private Consumption**: Estimated to grow 8% year-on-year, driven by rising real incomes, steady rural wage growth, and record-low retail inflation.





- **Investment Demand**: Expected to grow 7.5% year-on-year, supported by government infrastructure spending and steady public capex.

3. India Unveils First Quantum Diamond Microscope

• **Indigenous Development**: India's first QDM was developed by IIT Bombay's P-Quest Group under the National Quantum Mission (NQM), earning the country its first patent in this domain.



- **Technology**: The QDM uses nitrogen-vacancy (NV) centers in diamond to detect minute magnetic fields with high precision, enabling 3D magnetic field imaging at the nanoscale.
- **Applications**: The QDM has promising potential in neuroscience, materials research, and semiconductor diagnostics, allowing for non-destructive evaluation of semiconductor chips and mapping of magnetic fields in 3D layers.
- **Advanced Imaging**: The QDM enables widefield imaging of dynamic magnetic activity, analogous to an optical microscope, and can map magnetic fields in real-time.
- **Future Prospects**: The QDM is expected to revolutionize various fields, including neuroscience, materials science, and semiconductor technology, and is aligned with India's National Quantum Mission.

4. Punjab Becomes First State to Implement Amended Bharat Net Scheme Statewide

- **Statewide Coverage**: Punjab has successfully implemented the amended Bharat Net Scheme across its entire territory, ensuring broadband connectivity to all villages, with only one village remaining to be connected.
- **Digital Infrastructure**: The scheme has enabled internet and broadband services in 43 shadow areas, with plans to cover every village by the end of November 2025.



• **Rural Connectivity**: The Bharat Net Scheme aims to provide broadband connectivity to Gram Panchayats, households, and institutions, promoting egovernance, e-health, and digital services in rural areas.



- **Live Monitoring**: The implementation allows for live monitoring of the border state from any location in the country, enhancing security and governance.
- **Model for Other States**: Punjab's success serves as a replicable model for other states to integrate fiber-based broadband in rural settings and enable last-mile connectivity.

5. Union Minister Nirmala Sitharaman Inaugurated India's 1st Modern River Ferry Terminal

- Location and Inauguration: The terminal is located on the Brahmaputra River in Guwahati, Assam, and was inaugurated by Union Minister Nirmala Sitharaman.
- Cost and Development: The project was developed by the Assam Inland Water Transport Development Society (AIWTDS) at a cost of Rs 304.95 crore.



- **Features**: The terminal is designed to handle six modern catamaran vessels simultaneously and features a 100-seat waiting lounge, structured boarding zones, and an observatory deck.
- **Impact**: The terminal aims to ease cross-river traffic, reduce reliance on congested road networks, and promote tourism in Assam.
- Part of Larger Initiative: The terminal is part of a larger initiative to modernize Assam's inland water transport, supported by a USD 88 million loan from the World Bank.

6. RBI Recognised SRPA as SRO for Payment System Operators

• **Recognition**: The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has recognized the Self-Regulated PSO Association (SRPA) as a Self-Regulatory Organisation (SRO) for Payment System Operators (PSOs).



- Role of SRPA: SRPA will serve as a unified representative body for PSOs, aligning members with regulatory priorities, promoting industry coordination, and facilitating transparent dispute resolution.
- **Responsibilities**: SRPA will set and monitor industry standards for data security, compliance, and customer protection, and facilitate grievance redressal and ethical conduct among members.
- **Membership**: Leading payment system operators, including Infibeam Avenues, BillDesk, Razorpay, PhonePe, and others, have joined SRPA.



• **Impact**: The recognition is expected to strengthen governance, compliance, and collaboration across India's digital payments ecosystem.
