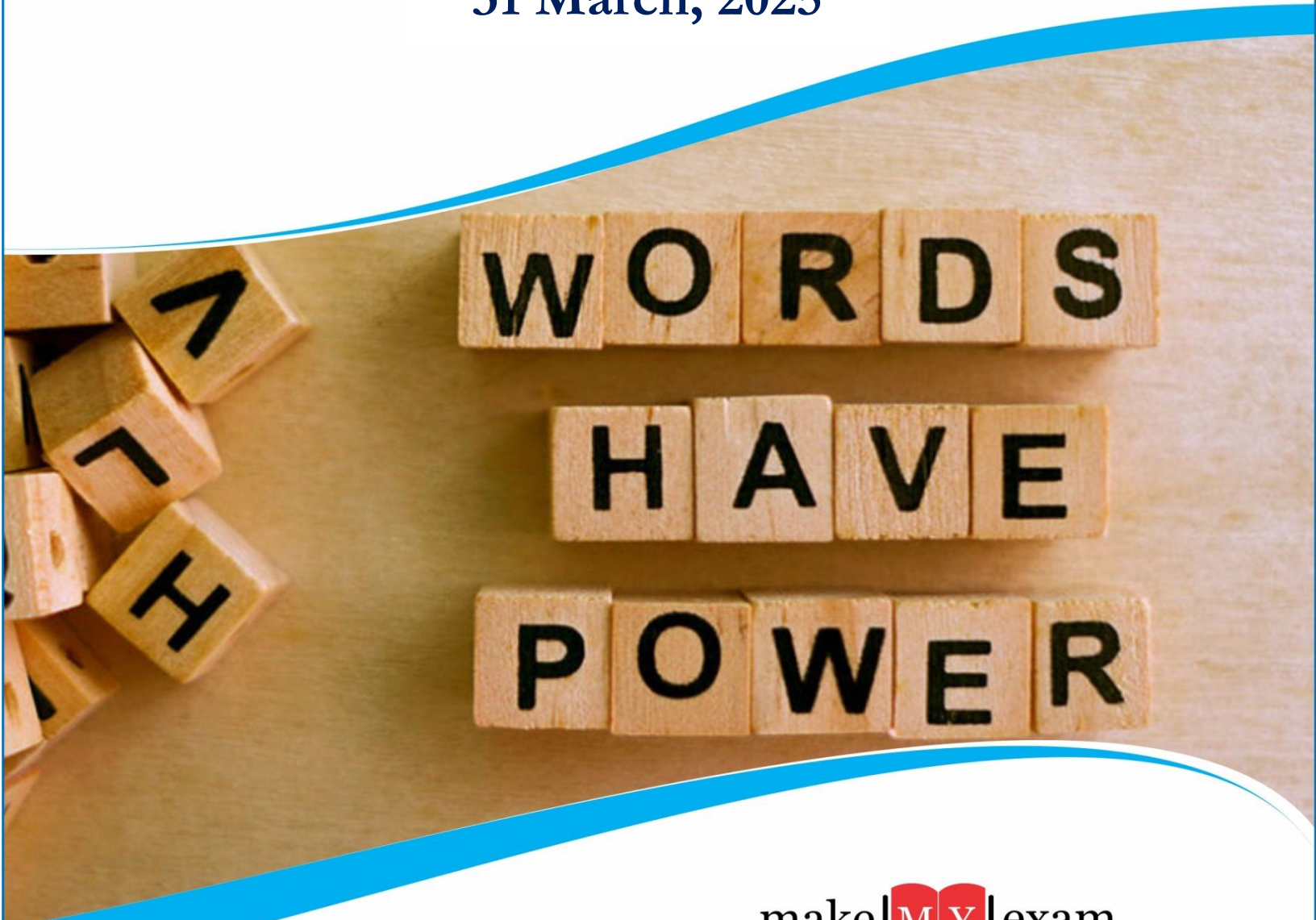


1. CHOPPY (ADJECTIVE): तड़का हुआ

Pronunciation:chawp•ee

Meaning: (used about the sea) having a lot of small waves, slightly rough.

Synonyms: turbulent, heavy, stormy

Antonyms: calm, constant, steady

Sentence: Sea conditions are often very choppy.

2. DISTORT (VERB): बिगाड़ना

Pronunciation:duh•stawt

Meaning: to change the shape or sound of something so that it seems strange or is not clear.

Synonyms: misrepresent, pervert, twist

Antonyms: accurate, explain, clarify

Sentence: Many facts in the newspaper were distorted.

3. RESOLUTE (ADJECTIVE): दृढ़

Pronunciation:reh•zuh•loot

Meaning: having or showing great determination.

Synonyms: purposeful, purposive, fixed

Antonyms: irresolute, hesitant, skeptical

Sentence: She was resolute and unswerving.

4. BIZARRE (ADJECTIVE): विचित्र

Pronunciation:bi•zaa

Meaning: very strange or unusual.

Synonyms: peculiar, odd, funny

Antonyms: ordinary, reasonable, realistic

Sentence: I can't believe we're getting involved in something so bizarre.

5. RELEGATE (VERB): बाहर निकाल देना

Pronunciation:reh•luh•gayt

Meaning: to put somebody/something into a lower level or position.

Synonyms: lower, put down, declass

Antonyms: upgrade, accept, admit

Sentence: They aim to prevent women from being relegated to a secondary role.

6.INVOKE (VERB): आह्वान

Pronunciation:uhn·voke

Meaning: to mention or use a law, rule etc. as a reason for doing something.

Synonyms: adduce, instance, turn to

Antonyms: waive, restrict, limit

Sentence:The antiquated defence of insanity is rarely invoked in England.

7.EXTREMISM (NOUN): उग्रवाद

Pronunciation:uhk·stree·muh·zm

Meaning: fanaticism

Synonyms: radicalism, zealotry, zeal

Antonyms: moderation, temperance, moderateness

Sentence: The dangers of racist extremism are present everywhere.

8.CONGLOMERATE (NOUN) : संगुटिका

Pronunciation:con·glom·er·ate

Meaning: a company that owns several smaller businesses whose products or services are usually very different.

Synonyms: combination, amalgamation, multinationals

Antonyms: disband, disperse, split up

Sentence: The billionaire's conglomerate includes restaurants, convenience stores, and a chain of hotels.

9. MALA FIDE (ADJECTIVE) : बुरे इरादे से

Pronunciation:maa·laa fide

Meaning: carried out in bad faith or with intent to deceive.

Synonyms: deceptive, disingenuous, duplicitous

Antonyms: sincere, honest, credible

Sentence:The judge concluded that the company had acted mala fide in concealing the information.

10.CHARY (ADJECTIVE): सावधान

Pronunciation:cheuh·ree

Meaning: uncertain and frightened to take risks, or unwilling to take action.

Synonyms: wary, cautious, circumspect

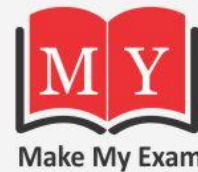
Antonyms: careless, unmindful, heedless

Sentence: Banks were chary of lending the company more money.

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
